# TALKING POINTS

#### THE DUCKS vs. THE BEARS

Saturday evening will be the 34th meeting between Oregon and Baylor and the second between the schools this season. The two powerhouses are the only two prgrams to claim a NCATA national title, with the Ducks capturing the first four and the Bears winning the last seven. Oregon trails in the overall series, 13-20, with Baylor having won the last five meets between the two sides. The Ducks are the only program to defeat the Bears during their title run, last beating the Bears on March 6, 2021. Baylor is off to a 3-0 start this year and is led by former Oregon head coach Felecia Mulkey.

#### **DUCKS PUT TOGETHER SEASON-BEST MEET AGAINST BAYLOR**

Despite suffering their first defeat of the 2023 season, Oregon produced a season-best score of 278.910 against Baylor. The Ducks posted season-high scores in five of the six events following a season-low in overall score against Gannon the meet prior. Karly Nowak received NCATA Athlete of the week honorable mention recognition for her contributions while Rachel Furlong finished with a careerbest 9.875 in the six element pass of the tumbling event.

#### SUSNARA OFF AND RUNNING IN YEAR TWO

Former Oregon All-American and assistant coach Taylor Susnara was named the head coach of the acrobatics and tumbling program in June of 2021. In the first season under Susnara, the Ducks went 2-5 against a daunting schedule and earned the No. 5 seed at the 2022 NCATA Championships held in Eugene. Oregon has gotten off to a 3-1 start in year two with Susnara at the helm, once again taking on a challenging schedule. Susnara earned her second upset victory over Azusa Pacific on Feb. 17 and avenged last season's home defeat in an upset over Gannon last Friday. Susnara was a three-time NCATA All-American for the Ducks from 2015-18 before working as an assistant for three seasons under then-head coach Keenyn Won. In three seasons as an assistant, Susnara helped Oregon compile a 13-7 record. During those three years, the Ducks had at least one student-athlete earn an NCATA weekly honor after 10 of its 15 regularseason meets while maintaining a No. 2 national ranking in all 15 meets of Susnara's first two seasons as an assistant.

# NOWAK NAMED NCATA ATHLETE OF THE WEEK

Senior Karly Nowak was awarded for her efforts against Azusa Pacific on Feb. 22 with her first career NCATA Athlete of the Week award. The Howell, N.J., native became the first Duck since Addie Lacewell in 2021 to take home the honor. The senior helped the Ducks earn season-best scores in eight of the 10 events in which she competed in, with notable performances in the aerial tumbling heat and the pyramid and toss sections of the compulsory event. Nowak's recognition is the 14th NCATA Athlete of the Week award in program history as she becomes the eighth UO athlete to win the weekly honor.

### **DUCKS BRING BACK EXPERIENCED CORE**

The 2023 Acrobatic & Tumbling team returns a wealth of experience and a core group of contributors from a season ago. A combined 23 juniors and seniors make up nearly two-thirds of the 2023 returners. Headlining the list of returning Ducks is sophomore Blessyn McMorris. Last season's NCATA Freshman of the Year, McMorris was the first athlete in program history to take home the award after earning freshman of the week honors three times. Junior Lindsey Tarr is also slated to be an impactful contributor throughout the season. McMorris (twice) and Tarr have each received NCATA Specialist of the Week honorable mention recognition following the first four meets.
