- No. 1 Baylor wrapped up Senior Day with a 3.53 point win over No. 2 Oregon at the Ferrell Center, the 23rd straight win for the Bears.
- Baylor concludes the regular-season at Hawaii Pacific on Saturday in the Shark Tank.
- Ranked No. 1 in the NCATA Championship Rankings for the 9th time in program history
- Kamryn Kitchens and Jordan Gruendler earned Athlete of the Week and Specialist of the Week honors, respectively, for the second week in a row

Baseball

- The Bears completed a four-game week with a series at Kansas, falling in three games after an 11-inning midweek loss to Abilene Christian.
- Freshman infielder Kolby Branch is batting a robust .345 with 10 doubles, four homers and 22 RBI, with Hunter Teplanszky adding a .329 average with three bombs and 15 RBI. John Ceccoli has cranked four homers.

Equestrian

- Baylor earned the No. 8 seed in the NCEA National Championships in Ocala, Fla., April 13-15. The Bears will face No. 1 SMU in the quarterfinals on April 13 in a singleelimination bracket.
- Dominika Silvestri and Madison Mitchell earned All-America honors. A total of 41 student-athletes earned NCEA All-Academic and Academic Honor Roll selections.

Softball

- The Bears moved to No. 24 in the latest D1Softball.com top-25 after posting a series win over Kansas at Getterman Stadium over the weekend, part of a 4-1 stretch.
- Baylor Shaylon Govan has hit .415 with seven homers and 38 RBI through 34 games in 2023 and Dariana Orme owns an 11-4 record with a 1.06 ERA in 21 outings.

Men's Tennis

- No. 47 Baylor opened conference play with a 5-2 win over No. 31 Texas Tech. The Bears are red-hot on a six match win streak, including three wins over top-60 opponents.
- Tadeas Paroulek went 3-0 in singles play over the past week with wins over No. 28 and No. 42, while also finishing 3-0 in doubles play paired with freshman Zsombor Velcz.
- BU continues Big 12 play with No. 3 TCU in Fort Worth on Thursday and No. 1 Texas on Saturday at the Hurd Tennis Center. Finn Bass and Juan Pablo Grassi Mazzuchi will be recognized as seniors following Saturday's match.
- Grassi Mazzuchi recorded career singles win No. 100 in Saturday night's match against Tech.

Women's Tennis

- No. 40 women's tennis split a pair of road contests in Big 12 play over the week, posting a 4-2 win at No. 61 TCU on Sunday after falling on Friday at No. 33 Texas Tech, 4-3.
- The Bears earned singles points from Alina Shcherbinina, the nation's No. 124 player, on court one, No. 94 Isabella Harvison on court three, Liubov Kostenko on court four and Daniella Dimitrov on court six.

Track & Field

- BU relay squads had a great showing at the 95th Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays over the weekend. Women's 4x200 set a new program record, women's 4x400 ran a season-best time and the men's 4x400 ran the fourth-fastest mark in program history.
- Annamaria Kostarellis set a program record in the 10,000 meters at the Stanford Invitational, while Ryan Day won two bronze medals (5,000m, 1 mile) and Ryan Hodge took silver (10,000m) back in Austin.
