Cross Country

- The cross country women won the seasonopening UIW Invitational behind Hayden Gold, Rosanna Pugh, Jordan Ledington and Anna Garner's top-10 individual finishes.
- The men's team took third in the team rankings, led by Ryan Hodge in seventh.
- The Bears have the weekend off before competing at the Texas A&M Invitational on Sept. 15.

Football

- Baylor opened its 10th season at McLane Stadium with a 42-31 loss vs. Texas State.
- The Bears rolled to 524 yards of total offense, including outstanding games from QB Blake Shapen, who threw for 303 yards and two TDs, and rushed for a score.
- Drake Dabney became the first Baylor tight end to eclipse 100 yards receiving since 1968
- The Bears host No. 12/12 Utah on Saturday at 11 a.m. on ESPN.

Men's Golf

- Baylor opens its 2023-23 season on Saturday at the Valero Texas Collegiate, hosted by UTSA at the TPC San Antonio.
- The Bears are receiving votes in the Golfweek/Bushnell preseason poll.
- Baylor returns 100% of its rounds played from last year.

Soccer

- The Bears are off to their best start to a season since the 2019 campaign, sporting a 3-1-1 record.
- Baylor opens a six-game homestand on Thursday, hosting SMU before welcoming Abilene Christian on Sunday.
- With consecutive shutouts in wins over Butler and Louisiana Tech, the Bears have not allowed a goal in 195 minutes and on the year, sports a 0.60 goals-against average, ranking second in the Big 12.

Volleyball

- Baylor climed to No. 14 in the AVCA top-25 poll following a 3-1 win over No. 18 Rice last week.
- The Bears are on a four-match road swing this week which will feature a test at SMU on Wednesday before playing in the Ram Classic, hosted by Colorado State over the weekend.
- Manuela Bibinbe earned Co-Defensive Player of the Week honors by the Big 12 Conference, after totaling seven blocks in the win over Rice.
