- Baylor opens the season this Friday at No. 4 Texas A&M. Home opener is next week, Oct. 6, vs No. 2 Auburn.
- 13 of last year's 19 point winners returning this season.

Football

- The Bears opened conference play with No. 3/6 Texas on Saturday, falling 38-6 in the final meeting with the Horns as league foes.
- Sawyer Robertson made his third start in filling in for injuried starting QB Blake Shapen and threw for a career-high 203 yards. LB Matt Jones had 3.5 tackles for a loss and a pair of sacks.
- Baylor opens its road slate on Saturday, traveling to face UCF in the first Big 12 home game for the Knights. Kickoff is 2:30 p.m. CT on FS1.

Men's Golf

- No. 15 Baylor achieved its highest ranking since 2020-2021 after a tie for seventh at the Fighting Illini Invitational.
- BU is 8-7-1 against ranked teams through just two tournaments.
- The two-time Big 12 Matchplay champions will return to action at the Big 12 Match Play October 9th at Houston Oaks.

Women's Golf

- Finished 14th at the Mason Rudolph Championship.
- Freshman Ashleen Kaur has been BU's highest finisher in each of the first two events, becoming the first freshman to do so since Hayley Davis in 2011-2012.
