- The Bears competed at the Gans Creek Classic in Missouri on Friday morning. The men's squad finishing 10th in the team standings, led by Ryan Hodge in 13th. Hayden Gold led the women's team to a 21st-place finish.
- BU has one final regular-season meet scheduled for Oct. 13th at the Arturo Barrios Invitational in College Station.

Equestrian

- The Bears are ranked No. 7 in Week 1 poll.
 Baylor dropped season opener to No. 4 Texas A&M 16-3 last Friday and opens their
- home slate this Friday vs. No. 2 Auburn.
 A total of 13 of last year's 19 point winners return this season.
- Two BU student-athletes scored their first career points in the season opener.

Football

- Baylor completed an epic comeback with 29 unanswered points at UCF on Saturday, clipping the Knights in their home Big 12 debut, 36-35.
- The Bears rallied from down 35-7 to stage the largest comeback win in program history, getting a late field goal from Isaiah Hankins to post the win.
- Baylor got 293 yards passing from Blake Shapen, who returned from injury, and 150 yards and a TD receiving from Monaray Baldwin. Freshman CB Caden Jenkins was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week after an interception and a 72-yard fumble return for a TD.
- The Bears will look to win their third straight vs. Texas Tech on Saturday, hosting the Red Raiders at 7 p.m. on ESPN2.

Men's Golf

- No. 17 men's golf will return to action on Monday, Oct. 9 at the Big 12 Match Play in Hockley, Texas, at the Clubs at Houston Oaks.
- Baylor has won the Big 12 Match Play twice, joining Texas Tech as the only other team with multiple tittles.

Women's Golf

- The Bears will return to action on Monday, Oct. 9, at the Ruths Chris Tar Heel Invite.
- Ashleen Kaur is the first freshman to lead the team in its first two events since Hayley Davis in 2011-2012.

Men's Tennis

- The Bears are competing throughout the week at the ITA All-American Championships in Tulsa, Okla.
- Luc Koenig and Marko Miladinovic battled through four rounds of pre-qualifying play to advance to the qualifying bracket. The main draw begins on Wednesday.

Women's Tennis

- The Bears hosted the annual H-E-B Invitational at the Hurd Tennis Center, earning eight combined wins in a field that featured SMU, Lamar, Tennessee, Illinois, Denver, Missouri and Nebraska.
- Baylor saw Daniella Dimitrov, Liubov Kostenko, Zuzanna Kubacha and Brooke Thompson compete.
- BU returns to action on Oct. 12-16, hosting the ITA Regionals at the Hurd Tennis Center.

Soccer

- Baylor bounced back from a pair of matches vs. ranked foes to earn four points on the road in Kansas last week, equaling KU 0-0 on Thursday and posting a 2-0 win at Kansas State on Sunday.
- The Bears will host lowa State on Thursday before venturing to Orlando to face UCF on Sunday.
- Tyler Isgrig has four points and six assists to lead the BU offnese, with Ashley Merrill chipping in seven goals on just 23 shots. The Bears have a 1.15 goals-against average on the year, with seven shutouts.

Volleyball

- The Bears continued a three-match road swing with a pair in Ames, Iowa, at Iowa State, splitting the matches.
- Baylor fell 3-2 in the opener on Saturday, before bouncing back in front of a national TV audience with a 3-0 win on Sunday.
- Freshman Kyndal Stowers averages 4.15 kills per set and is hitting .246. She ranks second in the NCAA among freshmen in kills per set.
- BU hosts Kansas State on Thursday and Friday at the Ferrell Center, with both matches on ESPN+.
- Following the match on Thursday, Baylor will honor Coach Ryan McGuyre, who recently became the all-time winningest coach in Baylor history.
