- Baylor is ranked No. 8 in Week 3 poll and are coming off a loss in the conference opener to No. 5 Oklahoma State 10-8.
- Seven athletes opened conference play with a win.
- The Bears will return to action Thursday, Nov. 2, at the Willis Family Equestrian Center against Fresno State.

Football

- Baylor broke for an idle week last week and returns to action at Cincinnati on Saturday, with kickoff slated for 11 a.m. CT on ESPN+.
- Baylor will host Iowa State on homecoming on Oct. 28 at 2:30 p.m. on ESPN+.

Men's Golf

- No. 24 Baylor finished second at the Big 12 Match Play last week in Hockley, Texas.
- It was BU's best finish in Hockley since 2020.
- Zach Heffernan went 5-0 on the week, becoming just the fifth player, and third Bear, to go a perfect 5-0 at the event since its inception in 2018.
- BU will close out the fall semester at the Kapolei Invitational Oct. 30- Nov. 1

Women's Golf

- No. 69 Baylor finished 12th at the Ruth's Chris Tar Heel Invitational.
- Silje Ohma recorded her first top-20 finish of the season, leading the Bears with a +4, 220.
- The Bears close down the fall semester at The Rainbow Wahine Invitational Oct. 23-25. BU won the event in its last appearance in Kapolei in 2021.

Men's Tennis

- Baylor will compete Thursday-Tuesday at TCU in the ITA Texas Regional Championships.
- There are currently 107 players registered for the six-day tournament from DI collegiate tennis programs across the state.

Women's Tennis

- The Bears had four individuals compete in the ITA Texas Regionals at the Hurd Tennis Center this weekend.
- Isabella Harvison advanced to the semifinal round on Sunday before falling.

Soccer

- Baylor recorded a draw against Cincinnati this week, before falling 1-0 against No. 21 TCU.
- The Bears have one regular-season contest remaining on Monday, Oct. 23, at Houston.
- BU will need a result vs. Houston or an lowa State loss to advance to the Big 12 Tournament in Round Rock.

Volleyball

- No. 21 Baylor had its first season sweep of the year against Cincinnati in the Queen City.
- Coach Ryan McGuyre is now 16-1 on the second day when playing back-to-back matches against the same opponent.
- BU went 3-1 in both matches and host redhot No. 24 UCF this weekend on Saturday and Sunday
