- Baylor wrapped up the season at the NCAA South Central Regional on Friday morning with the men finishing 20th as a team.
- Ryan Hodge led the men for the final time in his last collegiate race and senior Jackie Addy led the women.

**Equestrian**

- No. 8 Baylor heads into its final week of the fall season, facing off against Delaware State and No. 10 UT Martin in a pair of meets this weekend in the Diamond State.
- BU welcomed nine class of 2024 signees last week.
- Three Bears remain undefeated in conference play through three Big 12 matchups.
- BU fences has won each of its last three meets.

**Football**

- Baylor lost its first road game of the 2023 season on Saturday at No. 25 Kansas State, the defending Big 12 Champions, 59-25.
- The Bears got a career-high four TDs from QB Blake Shapen and a career-high 105 yards receiving from TE Drake Dabney.
- Freshman RB Dawson Pendergrass caught his first two TDs of the year.
- Baylor will wrap up its road slate at TCU on Saturday in Fort Worth.

**Men's Basketball**

- No. 15/13 Baylor is set for fourth game in seven days, hosting Kansas City at 9 pm on Tuesday Night.
- Ja'Kobe Walter was named Big 12 Player of the Week on the strength of 28-points against Auburn in the season opener, it was the most points by a freshman in their BU debut and the fourth-most by a freshman in their debut in Big 12 history.
- Walter is the first freshman in program history to be named Big 12 Player of the Week.
- The Bears will spend the week of Thanksgiving in Brooklyn for the NIT season tip-off at Barclays Center. They will open the event against Oregon State, a 6 pm tip-off Wednesday Nov. 22 on ESPN2.

**Women's Basketball**

- No. 21/23 Baylor WBB returns to action tonight against No. 4/4 Utah marking the first top-five opponent to come to the Ferrell Center since 2018-19.
- Sarah Andrews and Darianna Littlepage-Buggs were named to the Wooden Award Preseason Top 50 Watch List on Tuesday.

**Men's Tennis**

- Baylor finished out the fall slate on Sunday with a 16-2 weekend at the Big 12/Pac-12 Challenge in Stillwater, Okla.
- One of three Bears to go undefeated, Oskar Brostrom Poulsen took home the Big 12 MVP honor.
- The schedule for the spring 2024 season will be released on Wednesday.

**Women's Tennis**

- Baylor wrapped up its fall season this weekend with the Big 12 Fall Invite in Waco.
- Zuzanna Kubacha made it to the gold draw finals before falling 6-1, 6-2.

**Volleyball**

- No. 23 Baylor lost a pair of home tilts vs. TCU on Friday and Saturday at the Ferrell Center.
- The Bears lost 3-1 on Friday night, bouncing back to win the third set before falling 29-27 in the fourth.
- On Saturday, the Bears jumped out to a 2-0 lead before the Frogs rallied back to claim the final three sets.
- Three matches remain in the regular-season, with BU traveling to face Kansas on Wednesday, before returning home to face West Virginia on Saturday at 2 p.m. and hosting Houston on Nov. 22 at 6 p.m.
