#### **STORY LINES**

#### STARTING FIVE

- Baylor enters Saturday's contest with a perfect 8-0 record matching its best start to a season since the 2018-19 campaign.
- The Bears' bench outscored Delaware State's bench, 53-10, in Thursday's 62-point win over the Hornets. On the year, the Baylor reserves have outscored their opponents', 278-84.
- Baylor scored 62 of its 99 points in the second half on Thursday, marking the first time since 2020 that the Bears have scored 60-plus points in the second half of a game.
- The Bears have scored 80-plus points in seven of their first eight games to start the year for the first time since the 2017-18 campaign.
- Saturday's game is just the second game away from Waco for Baylor and kickstarts a three-game swing of contests at neutral sites.

#### **SHARING THE SUGAR**

- Baylor ranks second in NCAA Division I and first in the Big 12 in assists per game, averaging 24.3.
- The Bears have a league-best 1.75 assist/turnover ratio the sixth-best average in the country.
- Baylor has 194 assists on 272 made baskets this season (71%).
- Jada Walker (32), Sarah Andrews (32) and Jana Van Gytenbeek (28) lead the Bears in the category while all 13 players have recorded an assist.

#### **KEEPIN' IT 100**

- Baylor used an 80-point win to take down McNeese on Nov. 24 at the Ferrell Center.
- The 124 points scored by the Bears in the 124-44 victory were the most in a game in the **Nicki Collen** era and most since notching 136 against Northwestern State on Dec. 18, 2020. Additionally, it ranked fifth all-time in points recorded in a game by BU.
- It was just the eighth time in program history Baylor had put up 120-plus points, including overtime games.
- The team combined for 17 3-pointers, surpassing the previous record of 15 made 3-pointers set against Arkansas State on Dec. 18, 2019. The Bears were 17-for-32 (53.1%) and moved to a perfect 7-0 in the Collen era when shooting 50% or better from range.
- Baylor dished out 43 assists as a team the second-most in program history and were led by senior **Jana Van Gytenbeek** in the category with a career-high 12 dishes.
- As a team, Baylor grabbed 68 rebounds, which sits just outside the top-five all-time in program history. Of the 68 boards, 34 of them were offensive, marking the most since at least the 2014-15 campaign when the Bears recorded 35 in a win over Prairie View A&M.

#### **NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED**

- After Baylor's wins over Utah and Harvard, the Bears were recognized as the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Team of the Week on Nov. 21.
- The Bears were recognized for the second-straight year and second time under the direction of head coach Nicki
  Collen. In 2022-23, Baylor was recognized as the USBWA National Team of the Week after a pair of ranked road wins
  at Oklahoma and Kansas.

#### **NUMBERS TO WATCH**

- Newcomer Yaya Felder is 65 points shy of reaching 1,000 in her career. When she hits that milestone, the Bears will have five players with at least 1,000 points in their career on the roster (Blackwell, Bartley, Edwards, Andrews). Baylor, Tennessee and Clemson are the only teams in the country with four 1,000-point scorers.
- Graduate senior Aijha Blackwell is the only player on the roster with more than 800 career rebounds and needs just 95 boards to reach 1,000.
- Newcomer Madison Bartley is 70 rebounds shy of 500 career boards.

#### STORY LINES

#### **SCOUTING THE CANES AND THE SERIES**

- Miami enters Saturday's game with an identical record to Baylor, sitting at a perfect 8-0.
- The Canes rank first in the ACC in scoring defense, holding teams to just 52.9 points per game.
- Saturday's meeting will be just the third all-time between the two programs and the third time the game has been played at a
  neutral site. The first meeting was in the 1985-86 season and the last meeting was during the 2015-16 campaign and went in favor
  of the Bears.
- Miami has two players averaging double figures in Jasmyne Roberts (12.1) and Shayeann Day-Wilson (10.6) while Lazaria Spearman is averaging a team-high 7.1 rebounds per contest.

#### **CLIMBING THE CHARTS**

- Baylor cracked the top 10 in the AP poll on Dec. 4 marking the first time in the AP Top 10 since the 2021-22 season and the Bears remained in that position in week six of the poll (Dec. 11).
- In week three (Nov. 20) of the AP Top 25 Poll, the Bears jumped seven spots to No. 14 after their wins over Utah and Harvard. The climb marked the largest jump in the poll and the highest ranking for the Bears since finishing the 2021-22 season at No. 7.
- Additionally, it was the largest jump for BU in one week to the next since going from 19 to 10 at the beginning of the 2008-09 campaign.

#### **UPSETTING THE UTES**

- Baylor, ranked No. 21 in the AP Top 25 Poll at the time, defeated the then-No. 4 Utah Utes, 84-77, at the Ferrell Center on Tuesday, Nov. 14.
- The victory marked the first Big 12 win versus a top-four opponent since Kansas State topped No. 4 lowa, 84-83, on Nov. 17, 2022, and the Wildcats have since had one, knocking off No. 2 lowa on Nov. 16.
- Baylor's win over the Utes marked the Bears' first top-four win since beating No. 1 UConn, 74-58, on Jan. 9, 2020, and it was the first top-four win at home since beating the Huskies, 68-57, on Jan. 3, 2019.
- The 84 points scored by the Bears are the most against a top-10 opponent in a regular-season, non-overtime game since scoring 87 at No. 9 lowa State on Feb. 28, 2022. Additionally, it's the most points scored against a top-five opponent in the regular season since netting 94 against No. 2 Notre Dame on Nov. 20, 2011.
- The win marked the highest-ranked victory for head coach **Nicki Collen** in her head coaching career and she moved to 3-3 all-time against top-10 foes.

#### ANOTHER WEEK, ANOTHER WATCH LIST

- Sarah Andrews and Darianna Littlepage-Buggs made their way onto another preseason watch list on Nov. 14, being two of 50 named to the Wooden Award Preseason Watch List.
- With a spot on the Wooden Award watch list, Andrews is making her third appearance on a preseason list this year. Additional preseason honors for Andrews include a unanimous all-conference selection and a spot on the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List and Naismith Trophy Women's Watch List.
- Additional preseason honors for Littlepage-Buggs include an All-Big 12 Team nod and a spot on the Katrina McClain Award Watch List.

#### **SEASONED SARAH**

- Sarah Andrews was a unanimous preseason All-Big 12 selection and brings back the most experience in a Baylor uniform.
- She is the only Bear to have played more than two seasons at BU.
- The two-time all-conference pick averaged a team-leading 14.7 points per game in 2022-23 and eclipsed 1,000-career points in Baylor's win over Southern on Nov. 6 to start the year, becoming the 40th player in program history to accomplish this feat.
- She ranks third all-time in BU women's basketball history with 184 made 3-pointers and needs just 12 more to stand alone in second.

#### STARTING STRONG

- The Bears earned their 14th-straight season-opening victory on Nov. 6 against Southern, powering past the Lady Jaguars, 85-53, at the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor's matchup with Southern marked the 14th-consecutive year the Bears started their season at home. Baylor has won 19-straight home openers, dating back to the 2005-06 campaign.

#### **STORY LINES**

#### **BACK IN THE RANKS**

- Baylor entered the 2023-24 season as the 19th-ranked team in the country, as announced by the Associated Press, and No. 20 in the WBCA/USA Today Top-25 Poll.
- The Bears' appearance in the preseason AP poll marks the 19th-straight season BU has been ranked to start the year.
- The Bears have been ranked in 366 of the last 375 AP Top-25 weekly polls, including 10-straight weeks to start the 2022-23 campaign.
- Baylor was one of just two Big 12 schools to be ranked in the preseason poll, with Texas joining the Bears as the No. 13 team.

#### **NOTHIN' NEW**

- Jada Walker was voted the league's Preseason Newcomer of the Year by the conference's head coaches.
- Her selection marks the fifth-straight year a Baylor Bear has earned the preseason distinction.
- Walker joins Jordan Lewis (2021-22) and Aijha Blackwell (2022-23) as selections under the direction of third-year head coach Nicki Collen.

#### **PLAYERS TO WATCH**

- Four Bears were named to preseason watch lists published by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) as part of the Women's Starting Five.
- For the first time in her career, Sarah Andrews landed a spot on the Nancy Lieberman Award Watch List, which recognizes the top point guards in women's NCAA Division I basketball.
- Additionally, Aijha Blackwell and Dre'Una Edwards were selected to the Cheryl Miller (small forward) and Katrina McClain (power forward) Award Watch Lists, respectively, for the second-straight year.
- Darianna Littlepage Buggs joined Edwards on the McClain Award list, marking the first-career preseason award for the returning all-conference performer.

#### A LEAGUE OF HER OWN

- Lety Vasconcelos is the lone freshman on the 2023-24 Baylor women's basketball roster.
- With that, BU is one of just eight Division I schools with a solo rookie, while an additional five programs in the country don't have a single freshman.
- Baylor and Houston are the only two Big 12 women's basketball programs with one or no freshmen.
- Being the only freshman on a team is not new to Vasconcelos, as she was the lone rookie at Hamilton Heights Christian Academy in Chattanooga, Tennessee.
- She comes to Baylor after winning back-to-back GEICO High School National Championships with Montverde Academy (Florida) as a junior and senior.

#### **ROOKIES? MORE LIKE VETS**

- A trio of Bears played significant minutes as freshmen during the 2022-23 season, as returners **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** and **Bella Fontleroy** joined newcomer **Denae Fritz** on the Big 12 All-Freshman Team a year ago.
- The three combined for 923 points, averaging 28.0 points per game as a group.
- Littlepage-Buggs led the way with eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week honors, while Fontleroy and Fritz each earned a pair to account for 12 of the 17 weekly awards handed out by the league during the 2022-23 season.

#### ON THE BIG SCREEN

- The Bears were selected for eight national TV broadcasts this season, including a non-conference battle against Oregon at the Ferrell Center on Dec. 3.
- Baylor will make its national debut at SMU on Nov. 30, playing on ESPNU.
- The regular-season finale at home against Oklahoma State is slated for ESPN 2.

#### **FAREWELL TO FERRELL**

- The Ferrell Center has been home to Baylor basketball for the last 35 years and the Bears are finishing up construction on a new facility, Foster Pavilion, set to open in January 2024.
- Thursday's game against Delaware State marked the final regular season contest in the Ferrell Center for the BU women's basketball program.
- The women's basketball team is 437-100 all-time in the Ferrell Center.
- The building will remain the primary home for Baylor volleyball and acrobatics and tumbling after basketball's departure.

#### **HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 3RD SEASON**



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth head coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021. She enters her third season at the helm in 2023-24.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded the most wins by a rookie head coach in the country with 28. She helped lead the Bears to their 12th-straight Big 12 regular-season title and their

11th-straight top-two seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Collen implemented her system, which featured more perimeter shooting. Baylor went from the bottom of the list nationally to just outside the top 50 in 3-pointers made. In her first season, the Bears set new program records for 3-pointers made (233) and attempted (678).

From her introductory press conference, the Naismith Coach of the Year semifinalist said the Bears would be playing their best basketball late in the season, and she was right. Baylor became the first team to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span since 1999 when the Bears downed Texas two times to open the month of February. Two weeks later, exactly a month after sitting at the bottom of the conference standings with an 0-2 record, BU was back atop the league's leaderboard.

Collen implemented the 1-0 mentality that paid off with a 25-point win at No. 8 lowa State in front of a nearly soldout crowd of 13,000 raucous fans which clinched the conference crown. Baylor became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start a Big 12 season 0-2 and go on to win the league.

After her first season ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Collen saw three of her players be selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. Two of them - NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) marked the first duo to be taken in the top 10 in program history.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

In year two, Collen mentored two all-conference selections, two unanimous Big 12 All-Freshman Team picks and the unanimous Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs. Littlepage-Buggs earned eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week awards during the 2022-23 campaign, becoming the first BU rookie to earn it eight-or-more times in program history. Additionally, she ranked second in the Big 12 all-time in freshman of the week honors.

The Bears secured 20 wins for the 23rd-straight year, which is the second-longest active streak among Division I programs behind UConn's 30-straight 20-plus win seasons. Collen led Baylor to its 19th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022-23 and 21st overall, as the Bears erased an 18-point deficit to win their opening-round game against Alabama.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta franchise, where she spent the last three seasons at the helm for the Dream. Her rookie season in Atlanta resulted in a 23-11 season in 2018, where she earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and helped the franchise to the WNBA Playoff Semifinals.

Prior to her arrival in Atlanta, she spent two seasons under former head coach Curt Miller of the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth in the East Division to second from 2016 to 2017, respectively.

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned for nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State from 2000-2002, one season at Ball State from 2002-2003, one at Louisville from 2003-2004, three at Arkansas from 2011-2014 and two at Florida Gulf Coast from 2014-2016.

Her teams' combined record in nine seasons as an NCAA Division I assistant was 214-74, good for a .743 win percentage. As an assistant, Collen guided four different squads to the NCAA Tournament, reaching the second round in three of those seasons.

She spent six of her nine seasons as an assistant under

her husband, Tom Collen's head-coaching tenures at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also discipled under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Collen helped the FGCU program to a 64-9 record and the school's first NCAA Tournament win in her two-year tenure.

In her nine seasons at the collegiate level, Collen coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Collen's collegiate playing career began at Purdue in 1993-94, when the Boilermakers made an NCAA Final Four run with a 29-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in the Big Ten. Her sophomore season, Purdue made another deep run with an Elite Eight appearance to go with a 24-8 overall record. She transferred to Marquette, where she tallied 421 assists in her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game in her last 60 collegiate games. She helped the Golden Eagles to two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband, Tom, have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan. Connor and Reese are currently freshmen at Baylor.

#### **TEAM NOTES**

- Baylor has out-rebounded its opponents in 213 of the last 240 games and six of its eight games this season.
- Baylor is 263-2 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 40-0 when shooting 60 percent or higher. The Bears' last loss when shooting over 50 percent was to No. 22 Michigan on 11/27/22.
- 355 of Baylor's wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 24 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.
- Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 45-9 vs. Top 25 opponents at the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor is 348-108 (.770) vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season all-time.

#### THE BAYLOR BEARS REGIME

#### **2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament champoinship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

#### **2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns, **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

#### **2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS**

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

#### **NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE & 11-PLUS YEAR DOMINANCE**

- The Bears have made 19-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 21 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 14 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Bears are 24-time Big 12 Champions— most in Big 12 history—capturing 12 of the last 13 regular season titles, 13 overall & 11 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 424-47 (.898) over the past 12 seasons while posting a 212-20 mark in Big 12 play and 29-3 in Big 12 Tournament play.
- 355 of Baylor's 424 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 24 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.

#### **BIG 12 DYNASTY**

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 15 times in program history.
- The Bears have won nine of the last 12, and seven of the last 10 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.
