Men's Basketball

- No. 14 Baylor hosts No. 18 BYU in its conference home opener at 8 p.m. on Tuesday night on ESPN+.
- This is BU's first Big 12 home-opener where both teams are ranked since Jan. 7, 2015 (vs. No. 12 Kansas).
- The Bears enter the contest a nation's-best 27-12 vs. AP top-25 teams over the last five years, with 16 of those wins coming away from home.
- BU is 13-7 in conference home openers in the Drew era, including 13 of its last 16 (started 0-4).
- Last time out, BU outlasted a feisty Oklahoma
 State squad 75-70 in overtime for its ninthstraight win at Gallagher-Iba Arena.
- Despite only hitting two three-pointers, the nation's leading 3-point shooting team out-rebounded the Pokes on the offensive glass 16-5, giving them a 12-6 advantage in second-chance points.
- The win was Baylor's first overtime victory since it won 66-64 in Stillwater on Feb 21, 2022.
- Yves Missi recorded his fourth double-double of the season against the Pokes, the most by a BU player since Freddie Gillespie had 10 in 2019-20.

Women's Basketball

- The Bears are off to their best start (14-0) in program history outside of the perfect 40-0 season by the 2012 national championship team.
- Baylor joins No. 1 South Carolina and No. 2 UCLA as the final three undefeated teams in Division I women's basketball. Of the three teams, Baylor is tied with South Carolina with 10 20-plus point victories this season while UCLA has seven.
- With the final point in Saturday's 87-58 win over Houston, Yaya Felder became the fifth player on the active roster to reach 1,000-career points. Baylor is the only program in the country with five 1,000-point scorers on its current team.
- Baylor is one of only four teams in NCAA Division I women's basketball that have three or more AP Top 25 wins this year.
- Baylor cracked the top-five of the AP Top-25 Poll in Week 10, sitting at No. 4 heading into the road swing at Kansas and Iowa State. The ranking is the highest for the Bears since sitting at No. 4 in Week 17 of the 2021-22 poll.

Men's Tennis

- BU begins the spring tennis campaign with a doubleheader on Saturday. The squad faces ACU at Noon before a nightcap against Lamar at 6 p.m.
- Fans that attend the matches can pick up the 2024 team poster.
- Both matches are currently scheduled to be played indoors at the Hawkins Tennis Center.

Track & Field

- The Bears open the 2024 season at Texas A&M's McFerrin-12 Degree Invitational on Saturday afternoon.
- This meet christens the brand new Fasken Indoor Track facility in College Station.
- The meet will be streamed on SEC Network+ with live results provided by FlashResults.
