STORY LINES

- No. 13 Baylor hosts No. 23 Texas Tech on Tuesday for an 8pm tip on ESPN.
- Saturday is the 147th all-time series meeting with Tech holding an 82-64 series advantage, while Baylor holds a 24-15 edge in the **Scott Drew** era including eight of the last 11 meetings.
- The Bears are 39-30 against the Red Raiders in Waco, including six of the last seven and nine of the last 11 games in Central Texas.
- Drew is facing his former assistant coach and former Baylor guard, Grant McCasland for the first time.
- A 1999 graduate of Baylor University, McCasland earned Academic All-Big 12 honorable mention honors in 1999 after playing for four years under head coach Harry Miller.
- Four current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff (McCasland, Jerome Tang (K-State), Paul Mills (Wichita State) and Matthew Driscoll (North Florida).
- Baylor and Tech have played a home-and-home series every year since Tech joined the Southwest Conference in 1958.
- Six of Baylor's 10 remaining games are against teams currently ranked in the top-25.
- The Bears are 3-3 when facing Texas Tech in matchups when both teams are ranked.
- Baylor is 29-12 against ranked teams over the last five seasons, the best record in the country during that span, with 13 of those wins coming at home.
- In the last meeting, Baylor had a season-low three turnovers and scored 89 points, its most against Tech since 2002 (Feb. 4, 2023).
- BU has scored 80 + points in back-to-back games against Tech for the first time since 2010.
- Last time out, the Bears overcame a 20-0 lowa State run and a last-second shot by the Cyclones' Milan Momcilovic to snap a three-game losing streak for the Bears against lowa State.
- Jayden Nunn became the first Baylor player since Jo Lual-Acuil in 2018 to make a game-winning shot in the final 10 seconds, when his lay-up dropped with 2.0 seconds to play in the game.
- Despite trailing for 30:58 and getting down by as many as 10-points, the Bears snapped a three-game losing streak with a 77-69 win at UCF.
- Baylor's 10-point deficit against UCF is the largest deficit overcome in a win this season, and its largest since erasing a 14-point first-half deficit in a win over Texas last season (2/25/24).
- BU's three overtime games are its most in a season since 2013-14, and has not played three overtimes games in regular-season conference play since 1994.
- The Bears lead the nation in 3-point FG% (40.8), fourth in offensive efficiency (122.6) and second in the Big 12 in points per game (84.0).
- Baylor's 311-122 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (350-90) among Big 12 teams.
- BU's 59-21 Big 12 record over the last five seasons is the second best record of any power-conference team during that span.
- The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a fifth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.

QUICK HITS

- With back-to-back Big 12 titles in 2020-21 & 2021-22, BU became one of just three Big 12 teams to win back-toback conference titles
- Selected 16th overall by the Utah Jazz in June's NBA Draft, Keyonte George gave BU three-straight top-16 picks for the first time in program history (Jeremy Sochan 9th overall to San Antonio in 2022 Davion Mitchell 9th overall to Sacramento in 2021).
- The Bears have had 11 picks in the last 11 drafts, which is the most in the state of Texas and second-most in the Big 12 since 2012
- Baylor is one of two schools to have three-straight top-20 picks in the NBA Draft (Duke).
- The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a fifth-straight year, one of just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 11-consecutive postseason appearances, the nations fifth-longest active streak
- The Bears have gone to nine NCAA Tournaments and two National Invitation Tournaments since 2012.
- BU is 64-7 in home games over the last five seasons.
- Baylor played its final games at the famed Ferrell Center this season, before opening up brand new Foster Pavilion in January.
- The Ferrell Center was home to Baylor basketball from 1988-2023
- Baylor finished with a 402-169 record with over 3.2 million men's basketball fans coming through the turnstyles in the building's 35-year history.
- Baylor has reached the 25-win milestone in three of the last four seasons and in 7 of the last 14 years. Prior to that, BU reached 25 wins just once in the program's first 103 years (25-5 in 1945-46).
- Baylor is 29-12 against ranked teams over the last four seasons, including a 16-5 mark away from home.
- Baylor's 58-21 Big 12 record over the last five seasons is the second best record of any Power-5 team in that span.
- Head coach Scott Drew is in his 21st season at Baylor with a school-record 435 career victories.
- Drew is tied for the eighth longest-tenured head coach in Division I men's college basketball.
- Baylor is playing its 674th game of the 21-year Drew era more than half (369) have been as a ranked team.
- Over the last five seasons, Baylor is 92-11 when leading at the half and 114-17 when taking a 2nd-half lead.
- Baylor spent a school-record 54-straight weeks ranked in the top-10 of the AP Poll, from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec 5, 2022.
- BU set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).
- Baylor has been ranked in all 25 spots in the AP Top 25 at some point in the last 8 years.
- Baylor has been No. 1 ranked in 4 of the last 7 seasons (Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas are only others).
- Baylor and Kansas are the only Power-6 schools to win 18+ games every year since 2008.
- BU has built double-digit leads in 108 of 143 games over the last four seasons (102-6).
- Baylor has won 89% of its games when leading at the half since 2011-12 (241-28).
- Entering 2023-24, Baylor is 296-117 over the last 12 seasons, averaging 24.5 wins per season since 2011-12.
- Baylor's 311 wins since 2011-12 are second-most in the Big 12 behind only Kansas (350).
- Baylor is 402-169 since 2007-08, the first year Drew's staff had a full allotment of scholarships.
- Twelve of Baylor's 13 starting point guards under Drew have earned All-Big recognition (17 of last 18 seasons).
- Baylor is 120-29 over the last five seasons, the nation's second-best winning percentage among Power-6 teams in that span (.804%).

ONE OF THE GREATEST REBUILDS IN NCAA HISTORY

- Scott Drew became Baylor's head coach in 2003, starting of one of the greatest rebuilds in NCAA history.
- Drew is one of 10 active men's Division I coaches with at least 400 wins at their current school.
- Drew is one of 2 active coaches to have won an NCAA Title and an NIT Title. He is the only active coach to have won both at the same school (John Calipari NCAA: Kentucky, NIT: Memphis).
- Drew was named 2020 NBC Sports National Coach of the Year and 2017 Basketball Times National COY.
- Drew is now in his 21st season at Baylor and is the school's all-time wins leader (436).
- Baylor has a .704 winning percentage (402-169) since Drew's first year with no scholarship restrictions in 2007-08 and a .718 winning percentage (311-122) over the last 12 seasons since 2011-12.
- Drew (52) is the second-youngest active collegiate head coach to win a National Championship.
- In Drew's first 20 seasons at Baylor, 54 players have gone on to professional careers.
- Was announced as a member of the Texas Sports Hall of Fame Class of 2023.
- He is the 23rd BU player or coach to be inducted into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame

NATION'S-BEST 29-12 VS. RANKED TEAMS OVER LAST FIVE SEASONS

- Baylor is a nation's-best 29-12 against AP Top-25 ranked teams since 2019-2020.
- BU is 13-3 at home vs. ranked teams in the last five seasons wins vs. #12 Arizona (Dec. 2019), #18 Butler (Dec. 2019), #14 West Virginia (Feb. 2020), #9 Kansas (Jan. 2021), #17 Oklahoma State (March 2021), #18 Texas Tech (March 2021), #6 Villanova (Dec. 2021), #20 Texas (Feb. 2022), #5 Kansas (Feb. 2022), #9 Kansas (Feb. 2023), #8 Texas (Feb. 2023), #18 BYU (Jan. 2024) and #12 Iowa State (Feb.2024), and losses by 3 points to #3 Kansas (Feb. 2020) and #19 Texas Tech (Jan. 2022).
- The record includes 16-7 away from home, with neutral wins vs. #17 Villanova (Nov. 2019), vs. #5 Illinois (Nov. 2020), vs. #18 Villanova (March 2021), vs. #10 Arkansas (March 2021), vs. #6 Houston (April 2021), #1 Gonzaga (April 2021), #8 UCLA and #14 Gonzaga, with road wins at #22 Texas Tech (Jan. 2020), at #4 Kansas (Jan. 2020), at #15 Texas Tech (Jan. 2021), at #6 Texas (Feb. 2021), at #6 West Virginia (March 2021), at #8 Iowa State (January 2022), at #21 Texas (Feb. 2022) and at #17 TCU (Feb. 2023).

BAYLOR-TEXAS TECH SERIES HISTORY

- The first meeting between there two teams came on Jan. 2, 1937, a 38-28 Texas Tech win and the two have played a home-and-home series every year since Tech joined the Southwest Conference in 1958.
- •Tech leads the overall series 82-64, but the Bears hold the 39-30 edge in Waco.
- Saturday is the 147th all-time series meeting with Tech holding an 82-64 series advantage, while Baylor holds a 24-15 edge in the **Scott Drew** era including eight of the last 11 meetings.

FEELING FINE AT FOSTER

- Baylor and the City of Waco have partnered on a \$700 million riverfront development project, headlined by the \$212 million Foster Pavilion, the home of Baylor's national champion basketball programs.
- Foster Pavilion (capacity 7,500) is located along the Brazos River on the opposite side of I-35 from McLane Stadium.
- BU MBB beat Cornell 98-79 in the first game at Foster Pavilion, while the BU women's team beat TCU 71-50 the following night in their first game in the new building.
- Development Centers for both basketball programs are included in the 245k square foot Foster Pavilion project and is expected to be completed in the summer of 2024.

FAREWELL TO FERRELL

- BU played in the Ferrell Center from 1988-2023, and holds a 401-169 record all-time in the building.
- In the final game at Ferrell BU set a program record shooting .762% and hitting 19 three-pointers, the most by a BU team in Ferrell Center History
- LaceDarius Dunn holds the individual scoring record at the Ferrell Center when he scored 43 against Morgan State on 1/4/2011.
- The team record is 118 points by BU against Savannah State on 12/17/2017. The Bears got within one point of that in a 117-52 win over MVSU in the season opener last season (11/7/22).
- Three of the top six crowds in Ferrell Center history have come in the last four seasons (10,628 vs. KU 2/26/22, 10,627 vs. Arkansas 1/28/23 and 10,627 vs. Kansas 2/22/20)

MILESTONE WATCH

- With 15 points against Auburn, **RayJ Dennis** eclipsed the 1,500 point mark for his career (1,768), and dished out his 500th-career assist against Kansas City and his 600th assist against TCU (613).
- Dennis ranks in the top-15 among active players in career games played (150), and his 613 career assists are top-10 among active players.
- Jalen Bridges eclipsed the 1,000-point mark for his career with 12 points against UCF (1/31/24)
- Bridges played his 100th career game on against Oregon State, and started his 100th-straight game against OSU.
- Caleb Lohner played in his 100th-career game against Kansas City (11/14/23) (117-straight games)
- Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua played in his 100th career game against Kansas City after making his careerfirst start at BU in the season-opener against Auburn.
- Tchatchoua is 21 points away from 500 in his Baylor career (479).

NOTABLE STREAKS

- BU has won 90-straight when shooting a higher percentage than its opponent (last loss March 2, 2019 at K-State).
- Baylor has won 52-straight games when shooting 50% or higher (last loss March 18, 2018 vs. Mississippi State).
- BU has appeared in 23-straight AP Polls, the 8th-longest active streak in the nation, and the third-longest in the Big 12 and the fourth-longest in program history.

WALKED THE WALK, NOW TALKING THE TALK

- Former BU Player Pat Nunley (1978-81) is entering his 43rd season as a radio analyst for Baylor men's basketball.
- Nunley was named to the Baylor Hall of Fame class of 2023, enshrined on Nov. 3, 2023.
- Playing alongside Southwest Conference Hall of Famer Terry Teagle and first-round pick Vinnie Johnson, Nunley averaged a career-best 12.3 points per game as a junior in 1979-80.
- Nunley started for four years with the Bears, and was named the Bill Henderson SWC Sportsman of the year in
- His fellow 2023 inductees include J.D. Walton (Football), Ken Quesenberry (football), Max Muncy (baseball), Denes Lukacs (tennis), Stan Curry (track and field), Sandy Forsythe Massey (track and field) and Tiffany Townsend (track

A WILD ONE AT FOSTER

- Baylor survived a 20-0 run by Iowa State and erased a 7-point deficit in the second half to snap a three-game losing streak against Iowa State.
- Jayden Nunn became the first Baylor player since Jo Lual-Acuil in 2018 to make a game-winning shot in the final 10 seconds, when his lay-up dropped with 2.0 seconds to play in the game.
- RayJ Dennis poured in a team-high 18 points, his 16th double-figure scoring game of the season and the sixth time he led the team in scoring this year.
- The senior played in his 150th consecutive game tonight, and ranks in the top-15 among active players in the country in career games played

CAUGHT A SNAPPER IN FLORIDA

- Baylor snapped its three-game losing skind with a 77-69 win over Central Florida in Orlando
- The win snapped a streak of three-straight losses by four points or less, the first time that had happened to the Bears since 1975.
- Despite trailing for for 30:58 and getting down by as many as 10-points, the Bears snapped a three-game losing streak with a 77-69 win at UCF.
- Baylor's 10-point deficit against UCF is the largest deficit overcome in a win this season, and its largest since erasing a 14-point first-half deficit in a win over Texas last season (2/25/24).
- Langston Love established a new career with 24 points to go along with a team-high 7 rebounds

A TRIPLE-OVERTIME THRILLER

- BU played its first game of at least three overtimes since 2008 (a 50T game at Texas A&M).
- It marked Baylor's first triple OT game since Jan. 23, 2008 at Texas A&M and was just the fourth time in program history a game has gone at least three overtimes, with the Bears going 2-2 in those games.
- Saturday's game marked the third-straight game in the series to be decided by four points or less.
- Yves Missi had a career-best 25 points on 10-of-14 shooting with nine rebounds in a career-high 42 minutes.
- It marked the most points out of the center position since Jo Lual-Acuil had 31 points vs. Savannah State in 2017.

DOWNED BY TEXAS AT THE HORN

- Texas' Tyrese Hunter hit a shot at the buzzer to beat the Bears 75-73, handing BU consecutive losses in Austin for the first time since 2014 and 15.
- Ja'Kobe Walter had game highs in points (22) and rebounds (7), while recording his sixth 20-point game of the season.
- After Texas started the game 9-for-11 from three in the first half, Baylor held Texas to 0-for-8 from deep in the second half.
- Baylor shot .800 from the free throw line, tied for it's second-best free throw percentage of the season.

FIRST BIG 12 LOSS OF THE SEASON AT KANSAS STATE

- Kansas State closed the game on a 9.0 run in overtime to hand BU its first Big 12 loss of the season and its thirdstraight against the WIldcats.
- The Bears shot season-lows from the field (.329) and the free throw line (.563).
- BU pulled down a season-high 32 offensive rebounds.
- 47 total rebounds were BU's most since grabbing a season-high 51 against Northwestern State (12/2/23).

BEARS PULL OUT A TIGHT ONE AGAINST CINCY

- Despite their season-low scoring output, the Bears held off a late comeback attempt by Cincinnati 62-59 to remain unbeaten in the league.
- The Bears and Bearcats were tied 27-27 at the half, improving to 12-0 on the season when tied or leading at the half.
- Baylor improved to 3-0 in conference play for the fourth time in the last five years.
- Langston Love led the way with 11 first-half points, while Ja'Kobe Walter scored all 14 of his points in the second half.

BIG 12 BATTLE BETWEEN BYU AND BAYLOR GOES TO THE BEARS

- BU overcame a nine-point second-half deficit to win its fourth conference home-opener in the last five years.
- Baylor shot 43.1 percent in the game but was 14-of-27 in the second half for a 51.9 percent.
- Jalen Bridges had a game-high and season-best 25 points on 7-of-14 shooting, with five rebounds and two
 assists in 36 minutes.
- Ja'Kobe Walter had 16 points with two rebounds in 30 minutes. He has scored in double figures in 11 of his 15
 collegiate games.

SURVIVED IN STILLWATER

- BU outlasted a fiesty Oklahoma State squad 75-70 in overtime for its ninth-straight win at Gallagher-Iba Arena.
- Despite only hitting two three-pointers, the nation's leading 3-point shooting team out-rebounded the Pokes on the
 offensive glass 16-5, giving them a 12-6 advantage in second-chance points.
- The win was Baylor's first overtime victory since it won 66-64 in Stillwater on Feb 21, 2022.
- Yves Missi recorded his fourth double-double of the season, the most by a BU player since Freddie Gillespie had 10 in 2019-20.

HOME SWEET HOME

- BU opened Foster Pavilion with a 58-point first half, the most points in a half for BU since scoring 61 in the first half against Mississippi Valley in the season opener last year.
- Ja'Kobe Walter had a game-high 23 points, his second-straight 20-point outing of the season (5th overall). BU
 improved to 5-0 when he scores 20+.
- Yves Missi scored a career-high 16 points on a perfect 8-of-8 shooting night, becoming he first BU player since
 Flo Thamba in 2021 to shoot 1.000 taking at least eight shots.

SHOOTING THE LIGHTS OUT

- Baylor started the game on a 20-0 run its longest run since a 24-0 spurt against MVSU in the season opener last year.
- BU set a new program record for field-goal percentage in a game (.672).
- The Bears 59-point win tied for the fifth-largest in program history and was its largest since a 64-point win against Mississippi Valley last season.
- 19 three-pointers are the second-most in program history and the most BU has ever made in a game at the Ferrell Center. The program record is 20 three-pointers set 2/14/1995 at TCU.
- Ja'Kobe Walter had a team-high 26 points with a career-high 5 assists.

DOWNED BY THE BLUE DEVILS

- Baylor dropped to 9-2 on the season and 3-3 in Madison Square Garden
- Baylor's 12-0 run in the first half was its second longest of the year and its longest since a 13-0 run against John Brown on Nov. 11.
- With 11 points and 10 rebounds, Yves Missi recorded his third double-double of the season, the most in a single-season by a Baylor player since James Akinjo had 3 in 2021-22.
- With his team-high 17 points, Dennis scored in double figures for the 58th time in his last 60 games. Dennis pulled down a season-high 7 rebounds.

STUMBLE VS. SPARTY

- BU allowed Michigan State to shoot .633, Baylor's highest opponent FG % allowed since Oklahoma shot .661 from the field on Feb. 26, 2005.
- Baylor failed to take the lead at any point in the game for the first time since Dec. 2, 2018 at Kansas State, snapping a 164 game streak.
- The Bears scored just 17 points in the first half, its fewest since it scored 15 against Wichita State on 12/1/2018.
- RayJ Dennis scored in double figures for the eighth time at Baylor and the 57th time in the last 60 games.

400 WINS AT FERRELL

- With a 78-60 win over Seton Hall in the Big East-Big 12 Battle BU recorded its 400th- all-time win at the famed Ferrell Center.
- BU Improved to a league-best 14-4 in Conference Challenges, and 3-1 in the Big East-Big 12 Battle.
- Baylor is second in the nation and improved to 26-3 when faced with a rest disadvantage.
- RayJ Dennis had a team-high 17 points, with seven assists and five rebounds in 36 minutes.

LOCKED DOWN THE DEMONS

- BU limited Northwestern State to just 14 first-half points, the second-fewest allowed in a half by BU in the Big 12 era (1996-97).
- 40 points were Baylor's fewest allowed since holding No. 6 Villanova to 36 on 12/12/21.
- BU's 51-point win tied for the 12th widest margin of victory in program history and the largest since beating Mississippi Valley by 64 in the season opener last season.
- BU improved to 45-1 under Drew when holding teams under 50 points.
- Yves Missi recorded his second career double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds, Baylor's third double-double this season.

CRUSHED THE COLONELS

- BU's 108 points were its most since scoring 117 in the season opener against MVSU last year in the season opener.
- Baylor allowed zero second-chance points for the first time since Jan. 4, 2022 when they held Oklahoma scoreless in that category.
- BU's 25 assists were its most since it had 26 against Texas Tech last season (2/4/23).
- Baylor finished the month of November with an undefeated record for the third time in the last four seasons.
- The Bears won seven games in November for the third time in school history (2021 & 2016).

GIVING THANKS FOR ANOTHER REGULAR-SEASON TOURNEY TITLE

- With a win over Florida, BU won it's fifth regular-season tournament title in it's last six opportunities.
- BU improved to 20-11 against SEC opponents during the Drew era, including 15-7 since 2012-13, and six of the last seven games.
- RayJ Dennis took home tournament MVP Honors highlighted by his 24 points and 8 assists against the Gators.
- Jalen Bridges hit five threes and averaged 18.5 points in two games to join Dennis and Ja'Kobe Walter on the all-tournament team.
- Walter averaged 17.5 points per game, including 11 against the Gators in the championship game.

BEARS BEAT THE BEAVERS AT BARCLAYS

- BU improved to 5-0 to start a season for the fourth time in the last six years.
- Ja'Kobe Walter has the most points by a freshman through five games in the Scott Drew Era (96).
- Yves Missi recorded his career-first double-double, BU's first since Flo Thamba had 12 points and 12 rebounds
 against Texas last season (2/25/23).
- Missi's 14 rebounds are the most by a Baylor player since Mark Vital had 15 vs. Oklahoma State on March 12, 2021.

CRUISING PAST THE 'ROOS

- · Jayden Nunn scored 14-straight first-half points en route to a season-high 25 to lead the Bears past Kansas City
- Ja'Kobe Walter poured in 23 for his second 20-point game of the season.
- It marked the first game with two 20-point scorers for BU since Adam Flagler and Keyonte George did it at Kansas 2/18/23
- RayJ Dennis scored 11 points and dished out 8 assists to reach 500 career assists.
- Baylor improved to 4-0 for the fourth time in the last six seasons.

FINDING OTHER WAYS TO WIN

- Despite snapping a streak of 1,032 straight games with at least one 3-pointer, the Bears found a way to win a 77-62 contest against Gardner-Webb.
- \bullet Baylor also snapped a streak of 181-straight games of making 2-plus three-pointers.
- Ja'Kobe Walter had a team-high 14-points to lead the Bears for a second time in three games.
- Yves Missi established a career high in points (11), blocks (5) and rebounds (8).

HOLDING OFF JOHN BROWN

- BU improved to 19-2 in home openers under Scott Drew (five straight)
- Baylor shot .563 from the field it's highest shooting percentage, since it shot .567 from the field against McNeese last season (11/23/22).
- The Bears pulled down 21 offensive rebounds, the most since they secured 22 in the season opener against Mississippi Valley last season
- Langston Love matched a career high with 20 points on a career-high eight field goals.
- With 15 points, **Jayden Nunn** scored in double figures for the 26th time in his career and the first time at Baylor.

CAUGHT THE TIGERS BY THE TAIL

- Trailing by 9 at the half and 6 with 6-minutes to play, BU used a 13-2 run over the next five minutes to take control of
 the game and open the season with a win against a power conference opponent for the first time since Colorado in 2013.
- BU improved to 19-2 in season openers under **Scott Drew** (five-straight wins).
- Five-star freshman **Ja'Kobe Walter** burst out of the gates with 28-points, the most by a freshman in a debut in program history.
- Walter is one of four freshman in Big 12 history to score at least 28 points in his debut, and the only one to do it
 against a power conference opponent.
- Walter went a perfect 10-for-10 from the free throw line making him the ninth different player in program history to shoot 1.000 percent from the line [min. 10 attempts]

ELEVEN CONSECUTIVE POSTSEASON BERTHS

- Baylor is on a school-record streak of 11-consecutive postseason berths and has appeared in 14 of the last 15
 postseasons. BU made seven postseason appearances in the program's 97 seasons prior to the Scott Drew era.
- Baylor is 1 of 8 teams to appear in every postseason since 2012, joining Gonzaga, Iona, Kansas, Michigan State, Oregon, Saint Mary's and Virginia.
- BU earned NCAA bids in 2012, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017, 2019, 2021, 2022, and 2023 and NIT bids in 2013 and 2018.
- Baylor has appeared in 13 of 14 postseasons since 2008. Prior to that, Baylor's only postseason berths were in 1946 (NCAA), 1948 (NCAA), 1950 (NCAA), 1987 (NIT), 1988 (NCAA), 1990 (NIT) and 2001 (NIT).

THREE-STRAIGHT TOP-THREE SEEDS

- Last season, Baylor earned its third-straight top-three seed for a third-straight NCAA Tournament joining Kansas, Gonzaga and Purdue as the only four teams to accomplish that.
- 2023 marked the fourth time BU has earned a No. 3 seed after also doing it in 2010, 2012, 2015 and 2017.
- Baylor has earned a top-3 seed in 7 of the last 13 NCAA Tournaments.
- BU is 17-6 in NCAAT games as the higher seed, but 2021 was the first time as a higher seed after the Sweet 16.
- BU is 3-5 in NCAAT games as the lower/same seed, though four of those five losses were to top-2 seeds.

A TOP-25 STAPLE

- . BU has now been ranked in 85 of the last 86 AP Polls.
- Ranked in the AP Top-25 for 22-straight weeks, Baylor has the eighth-longest active streak in the country and the third-longest in the Big 12 Conference. (Houston 78, Kansas 58).
- Ranked as high as No. 6 this year, The Bears have now been ranked in the top-10 for a fifth-straight year, one of
 just four programs (Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas) to accomplish that feat.
- BU spent a school-record 54 weeks in the AP Top-10 from Dec. 16, 2019-Dec. 5, 2022.
- Baylor set a school-record streak of 65-straight weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 (previous record was 25). The streak lasted from Nov. 5, 2019 to Jan 9, 2023 (1,161 Days).

- Baylor's 14-4 record in conference challenges (Big 12-Big East, Big 12/SEC, Big 12/Pac-12) is best in the Big 12, followed by Kansas at 12-7, OSU at 11-8, Iowa State at 10-8, Texas Tech at 10-9, OU at 10-9, Texas at 8-9, TCU at 7-7. K-State at 7-11 and WVU at 5-10.

- Baylor is 42-13 in regular-season tournaments during the Drew era, including titles in 4 of the last 5 tournaments.

SCOTT DREW COACHING TREE

- Four current Division I head coaches took their first DI head coaching jobs after stints on Scott Drew's BU staff.
- Jerome Tang is in his second year as head coach at Kansas State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 19 years with Drew.
- Grant McCasland is in his first season as head coach at Texas Tech. He spent five years as a Baylor assistant before taking over as Arkansas State head coach for one season in 2016-17.
- Matthew Driscoll is in his 15th season as head coach at North Florida after six seasons as a Baylor assistant.
- Paul Mills is in his first season as head coach at Wichita State. He was a member of Drew's original Baylor staff in 2003-04 and spent 14 years with Drew, the final eight as an assistant coach.
- All four former assistants have led their teams to NCAA Tournaments Driscoll led UNF to the 2015 NCAA
 Tournament, while McCasland took UNT to the 2021 Second Round and Mills took ORU to the 2021 Sweet 16.
- Additionally, McCasland led North Texas to the NIT Championship in 2023, prior to leaving for Texas Tech.
- Drew is 0-2 all time when facing a former assistant as a head coach.

PROTECTING HALFTIME LEADS

- Baylor is 124-15 when leading at halftime since the start of 2017-18.
- Baylor has won 89% of its games (241-28) when leading at the half in the last 10+ seasons ... 13-2 in 2023-24, 19-5 in 2022-23 20-3 in 2021-22, 24-0 in 2020-21, 21-2 in 2019-20, 15-3 in 2018-19, 15-0 in 2017-18, 18-3 in 2016-17, 18-2 in 2015-16, 21-7 in 2014-15, 18-2 in 2013-14, 17-1 in 2012-13 and 26-1 in 2011-12.
- BU has won 42% of games in which it's been tied or trailing at the half since 2011-12, going 65-88 in those.

SECOND-MOST WINS AMONG BIG 12 TEAMS IN LAST 11 YEARS

- Baylor's 311-122 record since 2011-12 trails only Kansas (350-90) among Big 12 teams.
- Houston (303-121) is third, Cincinnati (297-126) is fourth, BYU (292-136) is fifth, Iowa State (253-167) is sixth,
 Texas (255-171) is seventh, Oklahoma (245-167) is eighth, West Virginia (252-175) is ninth, Kansas State (246-176) is 10th, Texas Tech (236-179) is 11th, Oklahoma St. (227-188) is 12th, TCU (223-197) is 13th and UCF (223-171) is 14th.
- Baylor has averaged 24.6 wins per season over the last 11 seasons since 2011-12.

NON-CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS

- Baylor is 14-3 against the Big East during the Drew era.
- The Bears are 20-11 against the SEC during the Drew era, including 15-7 since 2012-13.
- Baylor is 5-0 against Big Ten teams since 2016 with two wins over Michigan State and Wisconsin, along with a win over Illinois.
- The Bears are 11-1 against their last 12 Pac 12 opponents, with wins in each of their last 6 meetings against teams from out west.
- Drew is 6-6 against the ACC since BU's first year without scholarship restrictions in 2007-08.

POINT GUARDS THRIVE IN DREW'S SYSTEM

- Twelve of Baylor's 13 starting point guards during the Scott Drew era have earned All-Big 12 recognition.
- Baylor's starting point guard has earned All-Big 12 recognition in 17 of 18 seasons since 2004-05.
- Adam Flagler (2023), James Akinjo (2022), Jared Butler (2019, 2020, 2021), Davion Mitchell (2020, 2021),
 Makai Mason (2019), Manu Lecomte (2017, 2018), Lester Medford (2016), Kenny Chery (2014, 2015), Pierre Jackson (2012, 2013), Tweety Carter (2010), Curtis Jerrells (2007, 2008, 2009) and Aaron Bruce (2005, 2006, 2007) have earned All-Big 12 recognition.

54 PRO PLAYERS IN DREW ERA

- In Scott Drew's 20 years at Baylor, 54 of his players have gone on to professional careers.
- Eight Bears are currently on NBA rosters Kendall Brown (Pacers), Jared Butler (Wizards), Keyonte George (Jazz), Davion Mitchell (Kings), Royce O'Neale (Nets), Taurean Prince (Lakers), Jeremy Sochan (Spurs) and Ishmail Wainright (Trail Blazers).
- In addition to the eight current NBA players, eight more of Drew's former players have played in the NBA (most recent team) — Quincy Acy (Raptors), Freddie Gillespie (Raptors), Pierre Jackson (Mavs), Cory Jefferson (Suns), Perry Jones III (Thunder), Quincy Miller (Kings), Johnathan Motley (Clippers) and Ekpe Udoh (Jazz).
- With his selection to the rookie team in the Rising Stars Challenge in 2023, Jeremy Sochan became the first
 player in program history to be a participant in the NBA's All-Star Weekend.

HISTORY OF DEVELOPMENT WITH REDSHIRTS

- Baylor has a track record of success when redshirting players. Adam Flagler, Davion Mitchell, MaCio Teague, Freddie Gillespie, Mark Vital, Ekpe Udoh, Johnathan Motley, Cory Jefferson, Brady Heslip, Jo Lual-Acuil Jr., Manu Lecomte have all gone on to professional careers after redshirting.
- Jonathan Tchamwa Tchatchoua redshirted in 2019-20 while sitting out to satisfy NCAA transfer rules,
 Langston Love redshirted during the 2021-22 season and freshman Omar Adegbola has elected to use a redshirt year in 2023-24.

BAYLOR BASKETBALL ON THE RADIO

- Baylor basketball is aired live via the Baylor Sports Media Network from Playfly on ESPN Central Texas and Flagship station 1660AM/92.3 FM ESPN Radio (KRZI) in Waco and worldwide on Sirius/XM Radio.
- Games are broadcast by the "Voice of the Bears" John Morris, who was named NSMA 2019 Texas co-Sportscaster of the Year on Jan. 13, 2020, and Baylor Hall of Famer Pat Nunley.
- Morris is in his 40th year doing BU broadcasts (29th full-time), and Nunley is in his 43rd season as analyst.
- At 29 years together, Morris and Nunley rank in the top-5 of the longest radio duo's in men's college basketball
- All of Baylor's games can be heard live on the Internet at https://www.centexsportsfan.com.

OFFENSIVE REBOUNDING A BAYLOR STAPLE

- BU is third in the conference (18th in the nation) in offensive rebound % (36.4%) according to KenPom.
- Baylor has ranked top-13 nationally in offensive rebounding percentage in nine of the last 10 seasons since 2013-14, including six times ranked in the nation's top-5. The Bears only cracked the top-20 once in Drew's first 10 years.
- Baylor finished ranked No. 13 nationally in 2021-22, No. 5 nationally in 2020-21, No. 8 in 2019-20, No. 2 in 2018-19, No. 9 in 2017-18, No. 3 in 2016-17, No. 4 in 2015-16, No. 1 in 2014-15 and No. 3 in 2013-14. Prior to that top-10 streak, BU's best rank was No. 16 in 2011-12.

BREAKTHROUGH IN BIG 12

- BU is 165-108 in Big 12 play in 14 seasons since 2010 after going 59-149 in the league's first 13 seasons.
- BU is 182-128 in Big 12 play in 16 seasons since 2008 after going 45-131 in the league's first 11 seasons.
- Baylor is 68-52 in Big 12 road games since 2012, second-best in the league behind only Kansas (74-47).
- BU has won 8+ Big 12 games in 12-straight seasons after winning 8+ just 3 times in the league's first 15 years.
- BU has double-digit Big 12 wins in five-straight seasons, 8 of the last 9 years and 10 of the last 14 seasons. BU
 didn't reach double-digit Big 12 wins in any of its first 13 years in the league before reaching 10+ for the first
 time in 2010.

DREW IS THIRD BIG 12 COACH TO REACH 150 CONFERENCE WINS

- Scott Drew joined Rick Barnes and Bill Self as the only coaches to reach 150 Big 12 wins on March 4, 2021 vs. OSU.
- Drew needed 136 games over 2,940 days for his first 50 Big 12 wins (50-86), 88 games over 1,821 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-38) and only 77 games over 1,493 days for his next 50 Big 12 wins (50-27).

IMPRESSIVE NON-CONFERENCE NUMBERS AT HOME

- Baylor is 88-4 in its last 91 non-conference home games dating back to Dec. 12, 2012.
- Baylor is 152-16 in non-conference home games in the **Drew era**, including 123-8 since 2007-08.
- Baylor is 67-8 in home games against unranked opponents (including Big 12 play) since 2016.

GRADUATING 91 PERCENT OF SENIORS

- Since **Scott Drew** took over the Baylor Basketball program in 2003, 40 of 44 scholarship players who have played their final years of collegiate eligibility under Drew have graduated from Baylor.

BEST IN TEXAS

- Baylor is 81-24 against in-state opponents since the start of the 2011-12 season, and the Bears have advanced deeper into postseason play than any of Texas' 23 Division I teams in five of the last ten seasons.
- BU is a combined 93-26 against Lone Star State teams over the last 14 seasons after going 10-27 against in-state teams in Scott Drew's first six seasons at Baylor (0-2 in 2023-24, 5-2 in 2022-23, 5-2 in 2021-22, 6-0 in 2020-21, 6-1 in 2019-20, 4-5 in 2018-19, 6-3 in 2017-18, 7-1 in 2016-17, 9-3 in 2015-16, 10-1 in 2014-15, 6-3 in 2013-14, 7-1 in 2012-13, 10-0 in 2011-12, 5-3 in 2010-11 and 9-1 in 2009-10).
- Additionally, 10 of the 30 NBA Draft picks from Texas colleges since 2012 have come from Baylor. Texas (seven), SMU (three), Texas Tech (three), Texas A&M (two), Houston (two), North Texas (one), TCU (one) and UT Arlington (one) have also had players selected in the last 10 NBA Drafts.

BIG 12 BOASTS SOME OF THE BEST

- The Big 12 has won two of the last three NCAA men's basketball national championships, played in three of the last four national championship games and appeared in four of the last five Final Fours.
- It's the only conference to have a representative in the title game in three of the last four seasons.
- in 2021 and 2022, The Big 12 becamse the first conference to win back-to-back national championships since the ACC in 2009 and 2010.
- 57% percent of the current Big 12 institutions have advanced to the Final Four since 2002, the highest percentage among conferences.
- The Big 12 finished first in conference NET average last season and has led the nation in NET/RPI ratings six of @BAYLORMBB






