STORY LINES

STARTING FIVE

- Sunday's nationally televised broadcast marks the eighth time the Bears will be featured on the big screen this season. The Bears are 5-2 in nationally televised games in 2023-24.
- In Baylor's win at Cincinnati, the Bears shot over 40% from the field for the fourth-straight game. Baylor is 10-1 in league play, and 19-1 overall, when shooting at least 40% from the floor.
- The Bears have held their opponent to below 20% shooting from behind the 3-point arc for three-straight games. Baylor ranks eighth in the country, and first in the Big 12, in three-point percentage defense (25.7).
- In her first 46 games as a Bear, **Jana Van Gytenbeek** turned in just three double-figure scoring performances, and in her last seven games, she has finished in double figures five times, including three-straight headed into Sunday.
- A win over Oklahoma State on Sunday, and a loss by Iowa State, would grant Baylor the No. 4 seed in the upcoming Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship in Kansas City. A win by both the Bears and the Cyclones would push BU to the five seed as Iowa State holds the head-to-head advantage in the tiebreaker.

SIGNATURE WINS

- Baylor is one of five Division I programs in the country with six-or-more AP top-25 wins this season.
- The Bears are the only Big 12 program with six wins over ranked opponents.
- Baylor has signature wins over Utah, Miami, Texas, TCU and a pair over West Virginia. Two of those victories were top-five wins by the Bears.
- NC State and UCLA lead the country with seven top-25 wins while South Carolina and UConn join the Bears with six.
- Behind BU, Kansas State and Oklahoma are the only other schools in the Big 12 with five victories against ranked foes this season.

STACKING WINS

- The Bears won their fourth-straight game at Cincinnati on Tuesday. The win streak is the longest for BU since starting the year a perfect 14-0.
- **Jana Van Gytenbeek** (11.3) and **Dre'Una Edwards** (10.8) lead the Bears in scoring in the four-game span, both coming off the bench for BU.
- On the glass, **Aijha Blackwell** (8.5) and **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** (7.8) are leading the way while Van Gytenbeek and **Sarah Andrews** have dished out a team-leading 15 assists apiece.
- In their last four contests, the Bears are shooting 45.2% from the floor while holding their opponents to 18.6% from behind the 3-point arc.

REBOUNDING MACHINES

- Baylor is 18-1 this season when outrebounding its opponents, including 10-1 in Big 12 action.
- Baylor's 52 rebounds at Houston (Feb. 4), 50 boards at Cincinnati (Feb. 27) and 45 boards at Oklahoma State (Jan. 28) were the most by the Bears in Big 12 games this season.
- **Aijha Blackwell** has led the Bears in rebounding 12 times this season. She has finished in double figures on the glass in 10 contests this year and eight times in Big 12 play.

SHARING THE SUGAR

- Baylor ranks 10th in NCAA Division I and second in the Big 12 in assists per game, averaging 19.1. Iowa leads the country at 21.6 assists per contest while Oklahoma leads the conference at 20.6.
- Baylor has 533 assists on 794 made baskets this season (67%). **Sarah Andrews** (109), **Jada Walker** (93) and **Jana Van Gytenbeek** (71) lead the Bears in the category while all 13 players have recorded an assist.

MASTERING THE MOUNTAINEERS

- Baylor's most recent win at West Virginia (Feb. 24) helped the Bears pull off their second two-game sweep of a conference opponent in three tries as the Bears earned their league-high sixth top-25 win of the year.
- With hard contact on **Jada Walker** with less than five seconds left on the clock, and a one-point deficit, **Jana Van Gytenbeek** subbed into the game and drilled a pair of game-winning free throws.
- Five Bears finished in double scoring marking the first time since BU's game at Houston on Feb. 4 that at least five players notched double figures. Additionally, it marked the third time this year that five-or-more scored in double digits against a ranked foe.

STORY LINES

SCOUTING THE SERIES WITH OKLAHOMA STATE

- Baylor leads the all-time series against the Cowgirls, 49-13, and the Bears are 26-2 in Waco.
- Sunday's meeting marks the fifth and final two-game series for the Bears this season. Baylor swept the series against Houston and West Virginia while splitting with Kansas and Texas.
- Oklahoma State swept the two-game series last season, putting up 70-plus points in both contests.
- Prior to the pair of losses last season, Baylor won 13-straight games against the Cowgirls. The Bears have won 28 of the last 30 dating back to the 2009-10 campaign.

NUMBERS TO WATCH

- Newcomer **Jada Walker** is 62 points away from 1,000 in her career.
- Senior **Sarah Andrews** is 56 assists away from 500 in her career. If she reaches this milestone, she will be just the fifth player to reach 500 in program history.

GETTING EVEN

- After Kansas handed BU its first loss of the season in Lawrence on Jan. 10, the Bears used a 69-61 win at Foster Pavilion on Feb. 21 to split the season series.
- With the win, the Bears earned their 20th win of the season. Baylor has turned in 24-straight 20-plus win seasons which marks the second-longest streak in the country behind UConn (31).
- Baylor's bench scored 35 points while the Bears held Kansas' bench to zero points marking the fourth time this season, and third time in league play, the Jayhawk reserves went scoreless.
- A trio of Bears finished in double figures led by **Dre'Una Edwards'** 20-point outpouring. The 20-piece marked the second of the season for the graduate senior and 16th of her career.

SEASON SWEEP OF THE COOGS

- Baylor used a 23-point victory to sweep the two-game series against Houston on Feb. 4, charging past the Cougars, 83-60.
- The 23-point win marked the fourth 16-plus point victory by Baylor in Big 12 action this season.
- With her fourth rebound of the game, **Aijha Blackwell** hit 1,000 rebounds in her career.
- Baylor moved to 15-2, and 60-6 in the **Nicki Collen** era, when leading at the half.
- **Yaya Felder** contributed 14 of BU's 28 points off the bench, leading the Baylor reserves for the second-straight game.

GIDDY UP

- Baylor bounced back on the road, powering past Oklahoma State, 72-60, on Jan. 28.
- Four Bears finished in double figures led by **Dre'Una Edwards'** 16-point outpouring. She has led BU in scoring in three contests this season.
- **Bella Fontleroy** contributed 15 of BU's 27 points off the bench, going a career-best 6-for-6 from the charity stripe.
- **Aijha Blackwell** had a massive game on the glass, finishing with a season-high 19 rebounds. Her 19 boards were the most by a Bear in a game since NaLyssa Smith recorded 20 against Iowa State on Feb. 28, 2022.

GOOD KNIGHT

- Baylor outlasted the UCF Knights, 77-74, on Jan. 20 at Foster Pavilion to jump back in the win column after a pair of losses at Kansas (Jan. 10) and Iowa State (Jan. 13).
- The Bears played in front of their second-largest crowd of the season and at the new facility with over 5,000 in attendance.
- Baylor shot 50% (27-of-54) from the floor as a team and moved to 18-1 in the **Nicki Collen** era when shooting 50% or better from the field. Additionally, Baylor is 266-2 all-time when shooting at least 50% from the floor.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** finished in double figures for the eighth time this season with her second-career 20-point outing matching a season-high 24 points.
- **Aijha Blackwell** turned in her fifth double-digit rebound outing this year, and third in four games, with a season high 13 boards.
- **Sarah Andrews** dished out a season high 10 assists, finishing in double figures in the category for just the second time in her career. She added 11 points for her second-career double-double.

AMONG THE BEST

- The Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and WBCA announced last week that **Sarah Andrews** and **Dre'Una Edwards** are top-10 candidates for the Nancy Lieberman Award and Katrina McClain Award, respectively.
- Andrews is the only individual from the Big 12 represented on the Nancy Lieberman Award list and Edwards is one of just two from the league.
- Andrews, who earned a spot on three preseason watch lists, including the Nancy Lieberman Award, has started all 28 games for the Bears this season.
- Edwards has started 25 games for the Bears this season and she has reached double-figure scoring in a team-leading 21 of 28 games this season.

STORY LINES**SEASONED SARAH**

- **Sarah Andrews** was a unanimous preseason All-Big 12 selection and brings back the most experience in a Baylor uniform.
- She is the only Bear to have played more than two seasons at BU.
- The two-time all-conference pick averaged a team-leading 14.7 points per game in 2022-23 and eclipsed 1,000-career points in Baylor's win over Southern on Nov. 6 to start the year, becoming the 40th player in program history to accomplish this feat.
- She ranks second all-time in BU women's basketball history with 224 made 3-pointers. Odyssey Sims holds the record at 258.

HOT START

- The Bears pieced together their best start to a season since the perfect 40-0 season put together by the 2012 national championship team, starting the year at 14-0.
- With BU's undefeated record in non-conference play, it marked just the fifth time in program history that the Bears have gone perfect in non-con action since the turn of the century. The other seasons were: 2000-01, 2001-02, 2011-12 and 2015-16. Additionally, it marked the sixth time entering Big 12 play unbeaten, doing so in the 2005-06 season as well.

TAKING DOWN TEXAS

- Baylor's 85-79 conference-opening win at Texas on Dec. 30 marked the 14th-straight win in Austin for the Bears.
- The win marked the Bears' second top-five win of the year after a non-con victory over then-No. 4 Utah.
- The last time Baylor picked up two top-five wins in the regular season was during the 2012-13 campaign, beating No. 3 UConn and No. 5 Notre Dame on the road.
- Baylor forced Texas to commit 23 turnovers - the most in a game by the Longhorns this season and the most in a Big 12 game since turning the ball over 24 times at Oklahoma on Jan. 29, 2022.
- Baylor's nine 3-pointers were the most given up by the Longhorns this year. Senior **Sarah Andrews** went a team-best 4-for-8 from deep and moved into second all-time at Baylor in made 3-pointers.

KEEPIN' IT 100

- Baylor used an 80-point win to take down McNeese on Nov. 24 at the Ferrell Center. The 124 points scored by the Bears in the 124-44 victory were the most in a game in the **Nicki Collen** era and most since notching 136 against Northwestern State on Dec. 18, 2020. Additionally, it ranked fifth all-time in points recorded in a game by BU.
- It was just the eighth time in program history Baylor had put up 120-plus points, including overtime games.
- The team combined for 17 3-pointers, surpassing the previous record of 15 made 3-pointers set against Arkansas State on Dec. 18, 2019. The Bears were 17-for-32 (53.1%) and moved to a perfect 7-0 in the Collen era when shooting 50% or better from range.
- Baylor dished out 43 assists as a team - the second-most in program history - and were led by senior **Jana Van Gytenbeek** in the category with a career-high 12 dishes.
- As a team, Baylor grabbed 68 rebounds, which sits just outside the top-five all-time in program history. Of the 68 boards, 34 of them were offensive, marking the most since at least the 2014-15 campaign when the Bears recorded 35 in a win over Prairie View A&M.

NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED

- After Baylor's wins over Utah and Harvard, the Bears were recognized as the U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) National Team of the Week on Nov. 21.
- The Bears were recognized for the second-straight year and second time under the direction of head coach **Nicki Collen**. In 2022-23, Baylor was recognized as the USBWA National Team of the Week after a pair of ranked road wins at Oklahoma and Kansas.
- Senior **Sarah Andrews** was recognized as the ESPN National Player of the Week on Dec. 18 for her performances against Delaware State (Dec. 14) and then-No. 24 Miami (Dec. 16). It marked the second time in her career the guard has been given a weekly national honor from ESPN.

UPSETTING THE UTES

- Baylor, ranked No. 21 in the AP Top 25 Poll at the time, defeated the then-No. 4 Utah Utes, 84-77, at the Ferrell Center on Tuesday, Nov. 14.
- The victory marked the first Big 12 win versus a top-four opponent since Kansas State topped No. 4 Iowa, 84-83, on Nov. 17, 2022, and the Wildcats have since had one, knocking off No. 2 Iowa on Nov. 16.
- Baylor's win over the Utes marked the Bears' first top-four win since beating No. 1 UConn, 74-58, on Jan. 9, 2020, and it was the first top-four win at home since beating the Huskies, 68-57, on Jan. 3, 2019.
- The 84 points scored by the Bears are the most against a top-10 opponent in a regular-season, non-overtime game since scoring 87 at No. 9 Iowa State on Feb. 28, 2022. Additionally, it's the most points scored against a top-five opponent in the regular season since netting 94 against No. 2 Notre Dame on Nov. 20, 2011.
- The win marked the highest-ranked victory for head coach **Nicki Collen** in her head coaching career and she moved to 3-3 all-time against top-10 foes.

STARTING STRONG

- The Bears earned their 14th-straight season-opening victory on Nov. 6 against Southern, powering past the Lady Jaguars, 85-53, at the Ferrell Center.
- Baylor's matchup with Southern marked the 14th-consecutive year the Bears started their season at home. Baylor has won 19-straight home openers, dating back to the 2005-06 campaign.

BACK IN THE RANKS

- Baylor entered the 2023-24 season as the 19th-ranked team in the country, as announced by the Associated Press, and No. 20 in the WBCA/USA Today Top-25 Poll.
- The Bears' appearance in the preseason AP poll marks the 19th-straight season BU has been ranked to start the year.
- The Bears have been ranked in 366 of the last 375 AP Top-25 weekly polls, including 10-straight weeks to start the 2022-23 campaign.
- Baylor was one of just two Big 12 schools to be ranked in the preseason poll, with Texas joining the Bears as the No. 13 team.

NOTHIN' NEW

- **Jada Walker** was voted the league's Preseason Newcomer of the Year by the conference's head coaches.
- Her selection marks the fifth-straight year a Baylor Bear has earned the preseason distinction.
- Walker joins Jordan Lewis (2021-22) and Aijha Blackwell (2022-23) as selections under the direction of third-year head coach **Nicki Collen**.

HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 3RD SEASON



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth head coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021. She enters her third season at the helm in 2023-24.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded the most wins by a rookie head coach in the country with 28. She helped lead the Bears to their 12th-straight Big 12 regular-season title and their

11th-straight top-two seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Collen implemented her system, which featured more perimeter shooting. Baylor went from the bottom of the list nationally to just outside the top 50 in 3-pointers made. In her first season, the Bears set new program records for 3-pointers made (233) and attempted (678).

From her introductory press conference, the Naismith Coach of the Year semifinalist said the Bears would be playing their best basketball late in the season, and she was right. Baylor became the first team to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span since 1999 when the Bears downed Texas two times to open the month of February. Two weeks later, exactly a month after sitting at the bottom of the conference standings with an 0-2 record, BU was back atop the league's leaderboard.

Collen implemented the 1-0 mentality that paid off with a 25-point win at No. 8 Iowa State in front of a nearly soldout crowd of 13,000 raucous fans which clinched the conference crown. Baylor became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start a Big 12 season 0-2 and go on to win the league.

After her first season ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Collen saw three of her players be selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. Two of them - NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) marked the first duo to be taken in the top 10 in program history.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

In year two, Collen mentored two all-conference selections, two unanimous Big 12 All-Freshman Team picks and the unanimous Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs. Littlepage-Buggs earned eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week awards during the 2022-23 campaign, becoming the first BU rookie to earn it eight-or-more times in program history. Additionally, she ranked second in the Big 12 all-time in freshman of the week honors.

The Bears secured 20 wins for the 23rd-straight year, which is the second-longest active streak among Division I programs behind UConn's 30-straight 20-plus win seasons. Collen led Baylor to its 19th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022-23 and 21st overall, as the Bears erased an 18-point deficit to win their opening-round game against Alabama.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta franchise, where she spent the last three seasons at the helm for the Dream. Her rookie season in Atlanta resulted in a 23-11 season in 2018, where she earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and helped the franchise to the WNBA Playoff Semifinals.

Prior to her arrival in Atlanta, she spent two seasons under former head coach Curt Miller of the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth in the East Division to second from 2016 to 2017, respectively.

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned for nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State from 2000-2002, one season at Ball State from 2002-2003, one at Louisville from 2003-2004, three at Arkansas from 2011-2014 and two at Florida Gulf Coast from 2014-2016.

Her teams' combined record in nine seasons as an NCAA Division I assistant was 214-74, good for a .743 win percentage. As an assistant, Collen guided four different squads to the NCAA Tournament, reaching the second round in three of those seasons.

She spent six of her nine seasons as an assistant under

her husband, Tom Collen's head-coaching tenures at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also coached under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Collen helped the FGCU program to a 64-9 record and the school's first NCAA Tournament win in her two-year tenure.

In her nine seasons at the collegiate level, Collen coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Collen's collegiate playing career began at Purdue in 1993-94, when the Boilermakers made an NCAA Final Four run with a 29-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in the Big Ten. Her sophomore season, Purdue made another deep run with an Elite Eight appearance to go with a 24-8 overall record. She transferred to Marquette, where she tallied 421 assists in her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game in her last 60 collegiate games. She helped the Golden Eagles to two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband, Tom, have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan. Connor and Reese are currently freshmen at Baylor.

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple All-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE & 11-PLUS YEAR DOMINANCE

- The Bears have made 19-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 21 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 14 Sweet Sixteens.
- The Bears are 24-time Big 12 Champions-- most in Big 12 history --capturing 12 of the last 13 regular season titles, 13 overall & 11 tournament titles.
- Baylor is 438-52 (.898) over the past 12 seasons while posting a 223-25 mark in Big 12 play and 29-3 in Big 12 Tournament play.
- 364 of Baylor's 438 wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 26 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.

BIG 12 DYNASTY

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 15 times in program history.
- The Bears have won nine of the last 12, and seven of the last 10 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.
