### NOTABLES

• **DEFENSE & REBOUNDING:** In its last two contests, the Longhorns have held their opponents to an average of 67.0 ppg on a combined 38.2-percent FG shooting, including a 29.3-percent mark from three-point range, and posted a +12.5 rebound margin (41.5-29.0).

• **DISU IS DIFFERENT:** In Big 12 play, graduate F **Dylan Disu** has averaged a league-tying-best 18.1 ppg and 5.4 rpg in 27.9 mpg while hitting 50.2-percent (106-211) from the floor, including a conference-best 48.5-percent (32-66) mark from three-point range, and 78.0-percent (46-59) from the free throw line.

• **WEAVER PROVIDES SPARK:** Sophomore G **Chendall Weaver** has averaged 15.5 ppg and 6.0 rpg in 26.4 mpg over his last two games while converting 10-of-19 (.526) field goals and 10-of-13 (.769) free throws.

## BUILDING A RESUME

- The Longhorns are No. **27** in the latest NET rankings (through games of March 2) and No. **26** in the latest KenPom team rankings (through games of March 2).
- UT has three victories against AP-ranked opponents, including a 2-4 mark in true road games. The three wins came against No. 9 Baylor at home (75-73 on Jan. 20), at No. 11 Oklahoma (75-60 on Jan. 23) and at No. 25 TCU (77-66 on Feb. 3).
- The Longhorns have recorded **five Quad 1 wins** (5-7 record) entering Monday's contest.
- Texas is 4-4 in **Big 12 road contests** and 6-6 overall this season in games away from Austin (4-5 road, 2-1 neutral). Three of UT's four road victories in Big 12 play have been by double-digit margins (75-60 at Oklahoma, 77-66 at TCU and 81-69 at Texas Tech).

## BAYLOR SERIES INFO

- Monday's contest marks the **263rd** meeting between Texas and Baylor.
- UT owns a **165-97** lead in the all-time series entering Monday's game.
- Texas is **35-25** against Bears since the formation of the Big 12 Conference (prior to start of 1996-97 season).
- Baylor was UT's first opponent in the program's inaugural 1906 season. The Horns won the first game of the series, 27-17, on March 10, 1906, in Austin. The Longhorns won all four games played against the Bears that season.
- Baylor is UT's most common opponent in program history. Texas and Baylor have competed in the same conference since 1915 (Southwest Conference and Big 12). The only season Texas and Baylor did not meet since 1906 was in 1908, when the Longhorns did not field a team.
- Texas is **68-55** against the Bears when the two teams play in Waco.

## IN THE POLLS

- Texas is not ranked in the latest AP poll (Feb. 26) and not ranked in the latest USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll (Feb. 26).
- Prior to the Jan. 15th poll release, the Longhorns had been ranked in the top 25 of The AP poll for **36** consecutive weeks, dating back to the rankings on Jan. 31, 2022.
- Texas began the 2023-24 season ranked No. 18 in the preseason AP poll and No. 18 in the preseason USA TODAY Sports Coaches poll.

## OKLAHOMA STATE RECAP

- The Longhorns defeated Oklahoma State for the fifth consecutive time. Texas has now won 17 of the last 20 meetings in Austin against the Cowboys.
- UT improved to 40-23 against Oklahoma State since the inception of the Big 12 Conference.
- The contest was tied at 52-52 with 12:20 remaining, before the Longhorns closed the game on a 29-13 run.
- Texas registered a plus-11 rebound margin (39-28), including a 17-8 margin on the offensive glass. The Longhorns posted a 22-1 advantage in second-chance points.
- Texas recorded a 34-8 margin in bench scoring.
- UT registered 19 assists (on 32 field goals made) against just eight turnovers on the afternoon.

- The Longhorns tallied 12 steals (one shy of team season high), marking the eighth time this season that Texas has reached double digits in steals.
- Texas limited Oklahoma State to 26.3-percent (5-19) shooting from three-point range and allowed just nine assists while forcing 15 turnovers.
- UT converted 56.7-percent (17-30) from the floor, including 5-of-9 (.556) from three-point range, and a perfect 6-of-6 free throws in the opening 20 minutes while building a 45-36 halftime cushion.
- **Max Abmas** reached double figures in scoring (15 points) for the 26th time this year (29 games) and 138th time in his career (152 games). He tied his season high in steals (3).
- **Brock Cunningham** registered a game-high seven rebounds (four offensive) and added eight points (2-3 threes, 2-2 FT), two assists and one steal in 25 minutes.
- **Dylan Disu** tied his collegiate career high in assists (5). He reached double figures in scoring (team-high 17 points) for the 15th time this season (20 games) and 61st time in his career (131 games). Disu recorded a team-best plus-minus total of plus-25 in 32 minutes.
- **Chendall Weaver** set his season high in scoring (16 points). He set his collegiate career high in field goals made (7-12). Weaver reached double figures in scoring for the seventh time this year (29 games) and 22nd time in his career (61 games).

## DIFFERENT TEAM OF LATE

- Texas has posted impressive double-digit victories in each of its last two contests (81-69 at Texas Tech on Feb. 27 and 81-65 vs. Oklahoma State on March 2).

## WHAT GOES INTO WINNING

- In Texas' 19 wins this year, the Longhorns have held their opponents to an average of **62.6** ppg on a combined 39.2-percent FG shooting including a **31.8**-percent mark from three-point range.
- During UT's 10 losses this year, the Longhorns have allowed **79.6** ppg on 49.6-percent FG shooting including a 37.4-percent mark from three-point range.
- Texas has a **+6.3** rebound margin (38.1-31.8) in its wins and a **-6.3** rebound margin (30.4-36.7) in its losses.

## QUITE THE SIX-GAME STRETCH

- Texas played its **SIXTH**-straight game against an AP Top 25 opponent on Feb. 6 against No. 14 Iowa State.
- This marked the **first** time in program history that the Longhorns had played six consecutive games against ranked foes.
- UT went **3-3** during the gauntlet that included matchups against No. 9 Baylor (W, 75-73), at No. 11 Oklahoma (W, 75-60), at No. 21 BYU (L, 84-72), No. 4 Houston (L, 76-72 ot), at No. 25 TCU (W, 77-66) and No. 14 Iowa State (L, 70-65).
- This is considered the **toughest six-game stretch in the nation** by any team in NCAA Division I this season according to ESPN Analytics.

## CARDIAC HORNS

- Texas has converted a game-winning basket in the closing seconds in **three** of its first 29 contests this season.
- During the 75-73 home win over No. 9/9 Baylor (Jan. 20), **Tyrese Hunter** converted the game-winning layup with no time remaining in the contest. This marked the first true game-winning "buzzer beater" (no time remaining after a made shot) in program history since Javan Felix hit a 16-foot jumper as time expired to lift the Longhorns to a 74-72 victory over No. 3/3 North Carolina in the Frank Erwin Center on Dec. 12, 2015.
- **Max Abmas** hit a jumper from the right baseline with 6.2 seconds left to help Texas earn a 74-73 win at Cincinnati (Jan. 9).
- **Max Abmas** also knocked down the winning jumper from the right elbow with 0.4 seconds remaining to top Louisville 81-80 (Nov. 19) in Madison Square Garden.

## TEXAS IN THE BIG DANCE

- Texas has made a total of **37** all-time appearances in the NCAA Tournament (39-40 overall record).
- Texas is one of **six** schools to appear in at least 29 of the last 34 NCAA tourneys.
- UT is one of **seven** schools to appear in at least 21 of the last 24 NCAA tourneys.
- The Longhorns have advanced to the Final Four three times in program history (1943, 1947 and 2003), the Elite Eight a total of eight times and the Sweet 16 a total of 14 times.

## OUR GUY, RT - YEAR TWO

- **Rodney Terry** was named the 26th head coach in Men's Basketball program history at The University of Texas on his 55th birthday - March 27, 2023. Terry was tabbed Acting Head Coach a few hours prior to the Dec. 12, 2022 home game against Rice. He was named Interim Head Coach for the remainder of the 2022-23 season on Jan. 5.
- A former head coach at Fresno State and UTEP for a combined 10 years, he sports an overall head coaching record of **204-174** (.540) in **12** seasons.
- Terry was tabbed the **2023 Sporting News National Coach of the Year**, becoming the first coach in program history to earn the prestigious honor. He also was named the Clarence "Big House" Gaines College Basketball Division I Coach of the Year by the National Sports Media Association (NSMA).
- Terry, who has 28 years of collegiate coaching experience including nine as an assistant previously with the Longhorns from 2002-11, was in his second year as Associate Head Coach at Texas prior to being named Interim Head Coach.
- He spent three years (2018-21) as head coach at UTEP and posted a 37-48 (.435) mark, including a 29-27 record in his final two seasons. In his second year in El Paso (2019-20), the Miners went 17-15 to post their first winning season in four years and claim nine more wins than the previous season.
- Terry worked for seven years (2011-18) as the head coach at Fresno State, guiding the Bulldogs to a 126-108 (.538) mark. He posted 20-win seasons in four of his last five years and double-digit win totals in Mountain West Conference play in each of his last four years.
- During the 2015-16 season, Terry led the Bulldogs to a 25-10 record and the MWC Tournament title. Fresno State advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2001, and the 25 wins marked the third-most in school history.
- Terry spent nine seasons (2002-11) as an assistant coach under Rick Barnes at The University of Texas. The Longhorns posted an overall record of **232-80** (.744) and made nine NCAA Tournament appearances, including four trips to the Sweet 16 (2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008), three Elite Eights (2003, 2006 and 2008) and one Final Four (2003). Texas also claimed two Big 12 Conference regular-season titles (2006 and 2008).

- A total of 10 McDonald's All-Americans made their way to the UT campus during Terry's time. Texas' five-man freshman class in 2004 featured three McDonald's All-Americans and was tabbed the No. 1 class in the nation by Hoop Scoop.
- The Longhorns claimed two National Player of the Year winners (T.J. Ford in 2003 and Kevin Durant in 2007) and 13 players drafted by the NBA in the nine years under Terry, including nine first-round selections and five lottery picks.

#### TERRY AT TEXAS

- Now in his second year as the head coach at Texas, **Rodney Terry** has guided the Longhorns to a **41-18 (.695)** record.
- Texas is **11-4** under Terry in games decided by five points or less OR in overtime.
- Terry is **11-13** against AP Top 25 opponents while at Texas. The Longhorns have faced **24** AP-ranked foes in Terry's **59** contests as head coach at Texas.

#### HEAD COACHING EXPERIENCE ON THE STAFF

- **FOUR** members of the Texas coaching staff have a combined **46** years of **Division I collegiate head coaching** experience.
- Head Coach **Rodney Terry** has **11-plus** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at UTEP for three years (2018-21) and head coach at Fresno State for seven seasons (2011-18) in addition to his one previous year at Texas.
- Assistant Coach **Frank Haith** has **18** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at Miami (Fla.) for seven seasons (2004-11), Missouri for three years (2011-14) and Tulsa for eight seasons (2014-22).
- Assistant Coach **Steve McClain** has **14** years of Division I head coaching experience. He served as head coach at the University of Illinois at Chicago (UIC) for five years (2010-15) and head coach at Wyoming for nine seasons (1998-2007).
- General Manager **Chris Ogden** has **three** years of Division I head coaching experience. Ogden served as the head coach at UTA for three seasons (2018-21).

#### EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- Texas is averaging 75.7 ppg this season while hitting at a **47.0**-percent (802-1707) clip from the floor, including a **36.2**-percent (216-596) mark from three-point range.
- The last time the Longhorns converted at least **48-percent** from the floor on the year was **1994-95** (.480).
- The last time Texas hit at least **37-percent** from the three-point line in a season was **2010-11** (.376). The school single-season record for highest 3-point percentage is 38.9 in 2006-07.
- The Longhorns have converted **at least 50-percent** from the floor in 11 of their first 29 contests, including six of their first 16 Big 12 league games.
- **Nine** different Longhorns have reached double figures in scoring this year, while **five** UT players have recorded at least **21** points in a contest.
- Texas has reached double digits in three-point field goals made a total of **seven** times in their first 29 games this year (6-1 record).
- UT posted 94 points while hitting 51.4-percent (36-70) from the field, including a season-best 15-of-32 (.469) from three-point range, against West Virginia (Feb. 10). Texas scored 55 points in the first half on 65.7-percent (23-35) shooting, including an 8-of-16 (.500) mark from three-point range.

- The Longhorns converted 50.9-percent (29-57) from the floor, including a 50-percent (6-12) mark from three-point range, and 13-of-15 (.867) from the free throw line in the win at No. 25/25 TCU (Feb. 3).
- UT hit 50-percent (26-52) from the floor, including an 8-of-18 (.444) mark from three-point range, and 15-of-18 (.833) free throws in the victory at No. 11/13 Oklahoma (Jan. 23).
- The Longhorns converted 51.9-percent (27-52) from the field, including a 9-of-19 (.474) mark from three-point range, during the home win over No. 9/9 Baylor (Jan. 20). Texas hit 9-of-11 (.818) from three-point range in the first half, **marking its top 3-point percentage in a half since UT went 5-of-5 from beyond the arc in the first half against Baylor on Feb. 14, 2006.**
- UT hit 50.9-percent (29-57) from the floor during its 74-73 victory at Cincinnati (Jan. 9).
- Texas recorded a season-high 96 points while converting 54.2-percent (32-59) from the floor, including a 50-percent (10-20) mark from three-point range, and 22-of-25 (.880) free throws in the 96-85 win over LSU (Dec. 16) in Houston.
- The Longhorns converted 60.4-percent (29-48) from the floor, including a 45.5-percent mark (10-22) from three-point range, in their 80-64 win over Rice (Nov. 15).

#### SUCCESS AT THE STRIPE

- The Longhorns have converted **74.8**-percent (376-503) from the free throw line this season.
- Texas hit a season-best 24-of-30 (.800) from the free throw line during the victory at Texas Tech (Feb. 27).
- UT converted 18-of-20 (.900) from the free throw line against No. 14/14 Iowa State (Feb. 6).
- Texas hit 13-of-15 (.867) from the free throw line, including a 10-of-11 (.909) mark in the second half, in the victory at No. 25/25 TCU (Feb. 3).
- UT converted 15-of-18 (.833) from the free throw line in the win at No. 11/13 Oklahoma (Jan. 23).
- In Houston against LSU (Dec. 16), Texas hit 88.0-percent (22-25) from the free throw line. **The Longhorns went 12-of-12 from the stripe in the second half.** This marked the 11th time in program history (since the 1965-66 season) that Texas was perfect from the line in a half while attempting at least 10 free throws.

#### GET OLD AND STAY OLD

- The 2023-24 Texas roster includes **five** players who have already earned their undergraduate degrees: Max Abmas, Brock Cunningham, Dylan Disu, Ithiel Horton and Kadin Shedrick.
- **Seven** individuals have **played** in at least **83** career games and **four** players have **started** at least **94** career contests.
- **Four** players have already surpassed the **1,000-career point mark: Max Abmas** (3,040), **Ithiel Horton** (1,353), **Dylan Disu** (1,244) and **Tyrese Hunter** (1,077).
- The **12** players who brought previous collegiate experience to this year's roster have combined career totals of **1,017** games played (**641** starts).

### ONE-TWO SCORING PUNCH

- The duo of graduate F **Dylan Disu** (16.8 ppg) and graduate G **Max Abmas** (16.5 ppg) is averaging a combined **33.3** points per game this season.
- In Big 12 play, Disu (18.1 ppg) and Abmas (15.9 ppg) have actually increased that total to a combined **34.0** points per contest.
- Disu and Abmas are the **highest-scoring Texas duo since** D.J. Augustin (19.2 ppg) and A.J. Abrams (16.5 ppg) posted a combined 35.7 points per game in the **2007-08** season.

### MID-COURT MAX

Graduate G **Max Abmas** (pronounced: ACE-miss) has played and started **152** career games during his five years at Oral Roberts and Texas. He owns five-year collegiate totals of **3,040** points, **521** assists, **495** rebounds and **163** steals. Abmas has reached double figures in scoring **138** times, topped the 20-point mark **75** times, eclipsed the 30-point mark **19** times and topped the 40-point mark **twice** in his career.

- In his first 29 contests at Texas, he leads the team in assists (4.3 apg) and minutes (34.9 mpg) and ranks second in scoring (16.5 ppg). He has hit 42.2-percent (159-377) from the floor, including a 37.2-percent (81-218) mark from three-point range, and 90.8-percent (79-87) from the free throw line. Abmas also sports a 1.87-to-1 (125-67) assist-to-turnover ratio this season.
- Abmas registered 15 points (5-10 FG, 3-6 threes), four assists and tied his season high with three steals in 34 minutes against Oklahoma State (March 2).
- He tallied 18 points (4-12 threes) and four assists without a turnover in 30 minutes in the victory at Texas Tech (Feb. 27).
- Abmas posted 19 points (5-12 threes), a season-high nine assists without a turnover, six rebounds (tied season high) and one block in 31 minutes against West Virginia (Feb. 10).

- Abmas is just the **THIRD** player in Division I men's history to record **BOTH** 3,000 points **AND** 500 assists. He currently has **3,040** points and **521** assists in 152 career games. Antoine Davis (Detroit Mercy) registered 3,664 points and 593 assists, while Keydren Clark (Saint Peter's) tallied 3,058 points and 501 assists.

### DISU'S DOMAIN

Graduate F **Dylan Disu** has played in **131** career games (**99** starts) during his five seasons at Vanderbilt and Texas. He has registered career totals of **1,244** points, **679** rebounds and **140** blocked shots. In his career, Disu has reached double figures in scoring **61** times, including **nine** 20-point performances, and double digits in rebounds **21** times. He has tallied **17** career double-doubles.

- In his first 20 games (15 starts) this year since returning from injury (missed the first nine contests, left foot surgery), Disu leads the team in scoring (16.8 ppg) and ranks second in rebounding (5.0 rpg), third in blocks (22) and fourth in minutes (26.4 mpg). He has converted **51.4-percent (37-72)** from three-point range and 80.9-percent (55-68) from the free throw line.
- In his first sixteen Big 12 Conference games, **he is tied with Kansas' Hunter Dickinson for the league lead in scoring (18.1 ppg)** while averaging 5.4 rpg and adding 26 steals and 17 blocks in 27.9 mpg. Disu has converted 50.2-percent (106-211) from the floor, including a **league-best 48.5-percent (32-66)** mark from three-point range, in conference play.

- In the 2023 NCAA First and Second Round games, Disu averaged 22.5 points and 10.0 rebounds in 26.3 mpg while hitting 71.0-percent (22-31) from the floor. During UT's five postseason games in which he was healthy, he averaged a team-best 17.8 ppg and 9.0 rpg in 25.8 mpg.

- He tallied 28 points (14-20 FG) and 10 rebounds in 31 minutes against Penn State (Mar. 18) in the 2023 NCAA Second Round. Disu set the UT NCAA Tournament single-game record for most field goals made (14). His 28 points was the highest single-game scoring output by a Longhorn in a NCAA tourney contest since Kevin Durant had 30 in a Round of 32 loss to USC in 2007.
- Disu claimed **Most Outstanding Player** honors at the 2023 **Phillips 66 Big 12 Championship**. He averaged a team-best 14.7 ppg and 8.3 rpg in 25.5 mpg while hitting 73.9-percent (17-23) from the floor and 10-of-12 (.833) free throws in the three games.
- He earned his BA in Human Dimensions of Organizations in Spring 2023 and is currently in the Sport Management Graduate Program.

#### DISU IN THE RECORD BOOKS

- In the first half against West Virginia (Feb. 10), Disu tallied 19 points (7-7 FG, 5-5 threes), two steals and one assist in 12:54 of game action.
- He became just the **sixth** UT player to record a **perfect half from 3-point range** with a minimum of five attempts (since the 1986-87 season) by going 5-of-5. Disu joined Jase Febres (at K-State, 5-5 in second half on Jan. 2, 2019), Javan Felix (Baylor, 5-5 in first half on Feb. 26, 2014), Avery Bradley (Nebraska, 5-5 in first half on Feb. 13, 2010), Kevin Durant (at Kansas, 5-5 in first half on March 3, 2007) and William Clay (Georgia, 5-5 in first half on Nov. 29, 1998).

He owns two-year career collegiate totals of **455** points and **385** rebounds. Mitchell has converted **59.5**-percent (197-331) from the floor in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **21** times, double digits in rebounds **14** times and posted **nine** career double-doubles.

- In his first 29 games this season, Mitchell leads the team in double-doubles (8) and rebounding (8.2 rpg) and ranks second in blocks (30) and steals (31), third in minutes (29.5 mpg) and fourth in scoring (10.0 ppg) and assists (43, 1.5 apg). Graduate F **Brock Cunningham** is in his sixth season in the UT program and turned **25 years of age on Dec. 13**. He earned his BS in Advertising in Spring 2022 and is currently in the Advertising Graduate Program. Cunningham has played in **142** career games (**17** starts) and reached double figures in scoring **six** times and double digits in rebounds **five** times. A four-time Academic All-Big 12 selection, he elected to redshirt the 2018-19 season.

- In his first 29 games (13 starts) this year, he ranks third on the team in rebounding (4.0 rpg), assists (63, 2.2 apg) and steals (29), fifth in minutes (22.3 mpg), tied for fifth in blocks (12) and eighth in scoring (4.6 ppg).

Graduate F **Kadin Shedrick** (first name pronounced: KAY-den) has played in **103** career games (**45** starts) during his five years at Texas and Virginia. He owns four-year collegiate totals of **670** points, **404** rebounds and **146** blocks. Shedrick has converted **61.8**-percent (246-398) from the floor and **73.7**-percent (174-236) from the free throw line in his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **32** times, including **two** 20-point efforts, and double digits in rebounds **five** times in his career and registered **five** career double-doubles. A two-time All-ACC Academic Team selection (2022 and 2023), Shedrick has two years of eligibility remaining as he redshirted the 2019-20 season.

- In his first 27 games (11 starts) at Texas, Shedrick leads the team in blocks (32) and ranks tied for fourth in rebounding (3.2 rpg), fifth in scoring (7.9 ppg) and sixth in steals (22) in 17.2 mpg. He has converted 58.6-percent (78-133) from the floor and 72.6-percent (53-73) from the free throw line.
- He registered 10 points (5-6 FG), six rebounds and two blocks in just 7:47 of game action during the win at Texas Tech (Feb. 27).
- Shedrick recorded seven points (3-6 FG, 1-1 threes) and tied a season high with three blocks in 18 minutes at No. 3/3 Houston (Feb. 17).
- He posted 10 points (3-4 FG, 4-4 FT) and two blocks in 16 minutes in the home win over No. 9/9 Baylor (Jan. 20).
- Shedrick had 17 points (5-9 FG, season-high 7-8 FT), seven boards, two blocks and one assist in 27 minutes vs. UTA (Jan. 1).
- He had 15 points (6-10 FG), a career-high four steals and three blocks in 25 minutes against Houston Christian (Dec. 9).
- Shedrick tallied his first double-double as a Longhorn with 11 points (5-6 FT), a season-high 11 rebounds (four offensive) and three blocks in a career-best 33 minutes vs. Texas State (Nov. 30).
- He registered 17 points (7-10 FG, 3-3 FT), two blocks and two steals in 26 minutes against Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- Shedrick did not play in the Saatva Empire Classic championship game vs. No. 5/4 UConn (Nov. 20) - precautionary (shoulders) as he wasn't cleared to play on back-to-back nights at that time.
- He had a career-high 27 points (career-best 11-15 FG), seven boards and three steals in 27 minutes vs. Louisville (Nov. 19).
- Shedrick recorded 15 points (4-6 FG, 1-1 threes, 6-9 FT) and four boards in 21 minutes against Rice (Nov. 15).
- He tallied 12 points (3-3 FG, 6-7 FT), five rebounds, a career-high three assists and three blocks in 11 minutes during his Texas debut against UIW (Nov. 6).
- Shedrick earned his BS in Commerce from the University of Virginia in Spring 2023 and is pursuing a graduate certificate in Strategic Communication.
- He underwent surgery on both shoulders in late spring. He was fully cleared for practice with contact just five days prior to the season opener.

### **JUST CALL HIM I.T.**

Graduate G **Ithiel Horton** (teammates/staff call him "I.T."; pronounced: ITH-ee-elle) has played in **131** career games (**94** starts) during his six years at Texas, UCF (2022-23), Pittsburgh (2019-22) and Delaware (2018-19). He has career totals of **1,353** points, **384** rebounds, **185** assists and **120** steals. Horton has reached double figures in scoring **69** times, topped the 20-point mark **14** times and eclipsed the 30-point plateau **two** times in his career.

- In his first 29 games (11 starts) at Texas, he is sixth on the team in scoring (6.1 ppg) and assists (27) in 19.9 mpg. He has hit 35.3-percent (30-85) from three-point range this season.
- Horton recorded 10 points (2-5 threes, 4-6 FT), two boards, two assists and two steals in 27 minutes at No. 9/10 Kansas (Feb. 24).
- He tallied a season-high 20 points (8-14 FG, 4-10 threes) and three assists in a season-best 37 minutes against UCF (Jan. 17).
- Horton posted his **first collegiate double-double** with 13 points and a career-high 10 rebounds in 36 minutes vs. UTA (Jan. 1).
- He registered 11 points (4-9 FG) in 25 minutes against No. 5/4 UConn (Nov. 20).
- Horton tallied 18 points (5-8 FG, 5-6 threes, 3-4 FT), three assists and three steals in 28 minutes against Delaware St. (Nov. 10).
- Horton recorded a team-high 17 points (6-12 FG, 3-7 threes, 2-2 FT), five boards, three assists without a turnover and two steals in 26 minutes during his Texas debut against UIW (Nov. 6).
- Horton earned his BA in Social Science from Pittsburgh and is pursuing coursework in African & African Diaspora Studies.

### **JUST CALL HIM 'BIG Z'**

Junior F **Ze'Rik Onyema** (pronounced: ZAIR-eck own-YEMM-ah) played in **83** career games (**35** starts) during his four years at Texas and UTEP. He owns four-year collegiate totals of **358** points and **235** rebounds. Onyema has converted **56.8**-percent (150-264) from the floor during his career. He has reached double figures in scoring **13** times and double digits in rebounds **two** times in his career. Onyema has two years of eligibility remaining as he redshirted the 2020-21 season.

- In his first 21 games (three starts) at Texas, he is fourth on the team in blocks (15) while averaging 3.5 ppg and 2.4 rpg in 9.8 mpg. He has hit 54.5-percent (30-55) from the floor this season.
- Onyema registered a season-high eight rebounds, four points (2-2 FT) and one block in 13 minutes at West Virginia (Jan. 13).
- He tied his career high with three blocks to go along with seven boards and four points in 12 minutes against Wyoming (Nov. 26).
- Onyema posted seven points (3-5 FG) and four boards in a season-high 28 minutes against No. 5/4 UConn (Nov. 20).
- He recorded 11 points (4-7 FG, 3-4 FT), a team-best seven boards and two blocks in 18 minutes during his Texas debut against UIW (Nov. 6).

### **IMPRESSIVE THREE-POINT STREAK**

- The last time Texas did NOT convert a 3-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc that day.
- **The Longhorns enter Monday's contest having hit at least one 3-pointer in 1,121 consecutive games.**
- UT has converted at least one 3-pointer in 1,249 of 1,257 games since the 3-pointer was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season.
- The Horns have failed to ATTEMPT at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988 in a 69-55 win at TCU).

## HORNS IN THE NBA

A total of 11 former University of Texas players appeared on NBA rosters when the league opened the 2023-24 regular season.

- Texas ranked in a tie for **FIFTH** nationally in most players on 2023-24 NBA opening-night rosters.
- In addition to the 11 former Longhorns on NBA rosters, Royal Ivey is an assistant coach for the Houston Rockets.

## STAFF INKS IMPRESSIVE FALL SIGNING CLASS

A trio of top-45 national recruits signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period. **Tre Johnson, Cam Scott** and **Nic Codie** will join the Longhorns for the 2024-25 season. The three-man class is currently **No. 4 nationally** in the Class of 2024 team rankings by 247 Sports Composite.

- **Tre Johnson** (6-6, 190), a guard from Dallas, Texas, who plays at Link Academy (Branson, Mo.), is ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 4 by Rivals, No. 4 by 247 Sports and No. 4 by 247 Sports Composite. He played at Lake Highlands HS in Dallas during his freshman through junior seasons. As a junior in 2022-23, Johnson averaged 21.8 points, 6.4 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game while leading Lake Highlands to a 34-3 record and the UIL Class 6A state championship. The National Junior of the Year by MaxPreps and Mr. Basketball in the state of Texas last year, he converted 53-percent from the floor, including a 42-percent mark from three-point range, and 91-percent from the free throw line as a junior. Johnson surpassed the 2,000-career point mark during the quarterfinals of the state tourney last year and recorded a game-high 29 points in his team's 55-44 victory over Beaumont United HS in the Class 6A state title game. Lake Highlands won its first state championship since 1968. Johnson was recently named to the roster for the **2024 McDonald's All-American Game**.

- **Cam Scott** (6-5, 185), a guard from Lexington, S.C., who plays at Lexington HS, is ranked as the No. 24 prospect in the nation by ESPN, No. 27 by 247 Sports Composite, No. 29 by On3, No. 30 by Rivals and No. 37 by 247 Sports. In his junior year in 2022-23, he averaged 19.2 points, 6.1 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 2.4 steals per game while leading Lexington to a 20-7 record and a trip to the Class AAAAA state semifinals. Scott was named the South Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year following his junior season. He earned co-MVP honors in June at the Pangos All-American Camp in Las Vegas after averaging 24.6 points per game while hitting 57-percent from three-point range.
- **Nic Codie** (6-8, 200), a forward from Carrollton, Texas who plays at Newman Smith HS, is ranked as the No. 40 prospect in the nation by On3, No. 41 by Rivals, No. 45 by 247 Sports Composite and No. 46 by 247 Sports. The top-ranked player in the state of Texas in the Class of 2024, Codie averaged 16 points and nine rebounds per game as a junior in 2022-23 while leading Newman Smith to a 22-8 record and the District 9-5A championship.

### DID YOU KNOW ...

- **Max Abmas** earned his BS in Mathematics from Oral Roberts in Spring 2023 and is pursuing a graduate certificate in Strategic Communication. His father, Troy, works in cybersecurity and his mother, Erika, is a respiratory therapist. Max is interested in the field of forensics in his post-basketball career.
- **Alex Anamekwe** enjoys writing and has the desire to become an author. Both of his parents (father, Nnamdi; and mother, Kelechi) are from Nigeria. Kelechi ran track in Nigeria during her youth.
- **Cole Bott** chose to come to Texas because of the opportunity to play basketball while pursuing his MBA with an interest in the stock market.
- **Brock Cunningham's** father, Ed Cunningham, was a football offensive lineman at The University of Texas (1985-89) who earned All-America honors in 1989. Brock graduated in May 2022 with a bachelor's degree in Advertising and he is on pace to earn his master's degree in Advertising in Spring 2024.
- **Dylan Disu's** mother, Michelle Anderson, played basketball and volleyball at William Penn University (Oskaloosa, Iowa). His father, Rodney Anderson, football at Texas A&I University (now Texas A&M-Kingsville). Dylan earned his BA in Human Dimensions of Organizations in Spring 2023 and is currently in the Sport Management Graduate Program.
- **Ithiel Horton** is the first player in UT program history to wear jersey No. 9. In Hebrew, the name "Ithiel" means "God is with me." His mother, Hattie, is an evangelist, and his father, Kevin, plays the organ in church. His uncle, Lenny Horton, played basketball at Georgia Tech. His uncle, Brian Horton, played basketball at Fairleigh Dickinson and Morgan State.
- **Tyrese Hunter** lost both his father and mother during his childhood. His father, Brian, passed from sudden cardiac arrest when Tyrese was six years old. His mother, Ida, died of kidney failure when Tyrese was 13. Tyrese is the third-youngest of 12 children in the family (eight brothers and three sisters). He credits his grandmother, Annie Williams, and his oldest brother, Brian Jr., with raising him after the loss of his parents. Annie passed away this spring. Tyrese wears jersey No. 4 to honor his mom's birthdate (born on August 4, 1971).
- **Ze'Rik Onyema** has previously lived in Savannah, Ga.; Houston, Texas; Germany; El Paso, Texas; San Antonio, Texas; and Hawaii. His father, Kingsley, is a native of Owerri, Nigeria. Kingsley works in logistics for the U.S. Army and is based at the Pentagon. His mother, Mary, is an eighth-grade teacher. He wears jersey No. 21 to pay tribute to his mother's birthday (April 21) and his parents' anniversary (June 21).
- **Gavin Perryman's** father, Brandy Perryman, was a four-year letterwinner in basketball at Texas (1995-98) and finished his career as UT's all-time most accurate free throw shooter (89.7-percent, 183-204). His mother, Mandie Perryman, worked in the Texas Basketball office as a student assistant.
- **Kadin Shedrick** has a younger sister, Kari, who plays softball at Radford University (Radford, Va.). He played baseball as his primary sport until the age of 15. Kadin grew from 6-2 to 6-8 between his freshman and sophomore year of high school. His mother, Cindy, competed for the club Rowing team at the University of Cincinnati.
- **Chendall Weaver** wears jersey No. 2 to honor the memory of his best friend, Nevaeh Lopez who passed in 2020 (she attended Mansfield Timberview HS and wore jersey No. 2). His older sister, Chennedy Carter, played basketball at Texas A&M (2016-19) and was the No. 4 pick of the 2020 WNBA Draft by the Atlanta Dream. She played two seasons with the Atlanta Dream (2020-21) and one season with the Los Angeles Sparks (2022).

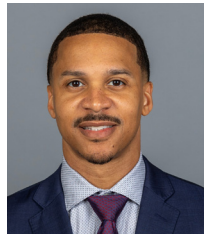
