Women's Basketball

- . Baylor's season came to an end on Saturday in the 2024 NCAA Tournament, falling to USC, 74-70, in the Sweet
- The Bears finished the year 26-8 overall and recorded a league-high seven top-25 wins.
- . Baylor went undefeated in non-conference play and turned in the second-best start in program history (14-0).

Softball

- Won its first conference series of the year last weekend as they went 2-1 against lowa State at home.
- BU is now 19-12 on the season and 3-9 in conference
- . Baylor will face Texas State in a midweek contest, before hosting Texas Tech this weekend at Getterman Stadium for a three game series.

- Acrobatics & Tumbling

 The Bears travel to Oregon for the final meet of the regular season on April 5.
- Baylor is 23-13 against the Ducks, including a 7-6 record on the road. All of the wins vs. Oregon are Felecia
- BU is on a 34-meet winning streak, dating back to 2021.
- No. 1 A&T defeated Augustana on the road on Mar. 23 by 12.245 points for the win, 281.600-269.355.
- · Freshman Payton Washington earned the highest score on an individual tumbling pass of any NCATA athlete against AU, scoring a 9.975 in the six-element pass.

Baseball

- BSB continues an eight-game homestand with four more games at Baylor Ballpark this week, hosting HCU on Tuesday and welcoming UIW this weekend.
- The Bears are coming off their second-straight Big 12 home series victory after taking two of three from Cincinnati.
- Collin McKinney became the first Bear since Logan Verrett on March 16, 2009, vs. Texas A&M to strikeout five hatters in a row.
- McKinney set career highs with 6.1 innings pitched and 10 strikeouts in Saturday's win vs. UC, allowing just one unearned run on one hit and two walks.
- McKinney became the second Bear this season to strikeout 10 or more, giving BU multiple 10 + K outings for the first time since the 2018 season.

Men's Tennis

- . The Bears won their first two Big 12 matches on Thursday and Saturday, defeating Texas Tech at home and BYU on the road.
- In the most recent ITA singles rankings, Tadeas Paroulek is 68th, Zsombor Velcz is 88th and Devin Badenhorst is
- BU continues its conference road stretch in Oklahoma, taking on the Sooners on Friday evening and the Cowboys on Sunday afternoon before the final week of the regular season.

Women's Tennis

- The Bears check in at No. 35 in the latest ITA team rankings.
- For the first time this season, the tandem of Sierra Berry and Zuzanna Kubacha are ranked, sitting at No. 59 in the doubles rankings.
- Baylor wraps up a three-match road swing on Saturday at TCU before returning home for its final three matches of the regular season.

- TF competed in a split weekend, with most of the team at LSU's Battle on the Bayou while the pole vaulters competed in Texas at the 98th Clyde Littlefield Texas Relays and Texas State's Bobcat Invitational.
- The distance squad found success with many new top-10 program marks, while Molly Haywood and Alencia Lentz took second-place finishes in Austin in the University Elite section of pole vault.
