Acrobatics & Tumbling

- The Bears traveled to Oregon for the final meet of the regular season on April 5.
- Defeated the Ducks by 8.32 points with an 274.915 to 266.595 win.
- The Bears are now on a 35-meet winning streak dating back to 2021.
- Baylor awaits the seeding for the 2024 NCATA National Championship in Fairmont, W.Va., taking place from April 25-28.

Baseball

- BSB hits the road for a four-game stretch, heading to BYU Thurs.-Sat.
- The Bears are coming off their fourth-straight home series win after taking two of three from Incarnate Word.
- BU is hitting .300 over its last 10 games, with seven players hitting above .325.
- Baylor's five-game win streak was its longest of the Thompson era, and marked the first time since April 24-May 11, 2018 that the team had scored eight or more runs in five consecutive games.
- On Saturday, redshirt freshman RHP Collin McKinney became the first Bear to strikeout 10+ batters in back-to-back starts since Kendal Volz did so in his final start of 2007 and first of 2008.
- Three Bears hold active on-base streaks of at least 10 games in Wesley Jordan (23), Hunter Teplanszky (15) and Enzo Apodaca (10).
