STORY LINES

- Baylor softball (35-21) continues its journey in the NCAA Division I Softball Championship advancing to the super regional round for the seventh time in program history. The Bears knocked off No. 13 national seed Louisiana in the Lafayette regional to advance to the round of 16.
- On their way to Gainesville, the Bears defeated Ole Miss in the opening game of the regional round before taking down Louisiana on day two to head to championship Sunday. On the last day of competition in Lafayette, Baylor fell against the No. 13 national seed 13-0, before turning around in a winner-takes-all game and defeated the Ragin' Cajuns 4-3 to capture the upset.
- Every inning of the Gainesville Super Regional will be broadcast on the ESPN family of networks. Matt Schumacker (pxp) and Erin Miller (analyst) will be on the call all weekend. Baylor's first game against the Gators will be featured on ESPN 2. Every Baylor game will continue to be broadcasted on 101.3 FM with Derek Smith handling the commentary.
- BU earned an NCAA postseason bid for the 16th time in program history. Baylor is 51-35 all-time in the NCAA Tournament. The Bears have advanced to the Super Regional round six times (2005, 2007, 2009, 2011, 2014, 2017).
- Baylor has made four World Series appearances, the last time coming in 2017, which also happens to be the last time Baylor advanced to a super regional.
- The Bears are 6-6 all-time against the Gators, including holding a 3-2 record against Florida when playing in Gainesville. The Last time BU faced Florida was during the 2018 season. Baylor came to Gainesville for the 2021 Gainesville regional but did not end up playing the host team.
- Seventeen of Baylor's losses this season have come against teams ranked or receiving votes in polls at some point in the season.
- The Bears have already faced nine ranked teams this season: No. 2 Tennessee, No. 23 Louisiana, No. 25 Oregon, No. 19 UCLA, No. 13 Missouri, No. 7 Oklahoma State, No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 23 Texas State and No. 1 Texas.
- Baylor is one of five Big 12 Big 12 Conference teams to advance to the NCAA Tournament: No. 1 Texas (Austin Regional), No. 2 Oklahoma (Norman Regional), No. 5 Oklahoma State (Stillwater Regional) and UCF received an at-large bid, heading to the Tallahassee Regional.
- The Big 12 posted the highest winning percentage of any conference (.813) during the NCAA Regionals as Baylor, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State and Texas advanced to Super Regionals. The four Big 12 teams are the most to advance to the second weekend of the NCAA Softball Championship since 2011 while the 80% of the league's five selections to move on to the second weekend is the best among any multi-bid league.
- Baylor Softball received three All-Big 12 selections among the 2024 All-Big 12 Softball postseason awards announced by the conference office.
- For the second-straight season, **Shaylon Govan** received All-Big 12 first team honors, while **Aliyah Binford** and **Emily Hott** each received second team honors.
- **Aliyah Binford** has a team-leading 147 strikeouts and holds a 13-11 record. She is currently ranked No.1 in the Big 12 in strikeouts.
- **Shaylon Govan** leads the Bears with a .451 average, 60 hits, nine doubles and 10 home runs. Her batting average is first in the Big 12 and 7th nationally, while her on base percentage is ranks second nationally. With her .589 on base percentage, **Govan** is ranked 8th in the country in walks per game and has been walked 47 times so far this season.
- **Emily Hott** has also been on fire offensively, totaling 56 hits, nine doubles, six triples and 10 home runs. Her six triples tie a single-season record for the Bears and another one would put her in the top spot alone.
- Sixteen different Bears have recorded a hit so far this season, with **Govan** leading the way with 60, followed by **Hott** with 56. There are 13 Bears with double-digit hits on the season.
- Head coach **Glenn Moore** hit his 1,000th career win last season, when the Bears took down UT Arlington on March 23, 2023. He hit his 900th win at Baylor this season after taking down UTSA, 2-1, on April 9, 2024.

QUICK HITS

- Baylor will face eight ESPN Preseason Top-25 teams this year, with four in the Preseason Top-10; Oklahoma, Tennessee, Texas and UCLA. BU will play 18 total games this season against preseason top-25 teams. Baylor was ranked No. 19 in the ESPN Preseason poll.
- Baylor welcomes back 21 returners from last year, with three freshmen.
- BU was picked 4th in the Big-12 Preseason coaches' poll. Oklahoma, Texas and Oklahoma State had the top three spots.
- Every Baylor Softball game this season will be broadcast on the radio on 101.3 FM. Dan Ingham, in his ninth season as the voice of Baylor Softball, will call every game.
- Twenty-five of the Bears home games will be aired on Big 12 Now on ESPN+.

MOORE ERA HIGHLIGHTS

- **Glenn Moore** is now **913-464** while coaching at Baylor and stands as the active wins leader across all sports for Baylor athletics. His .663 winning percentage is best in BU history and he's the program's all-time wins leader.
- **Moore** recorded his 900th Baylor win with a 2-1 win over UTSA in San Antonio, Texas (4/9/2024).
- **Moore** recorded his 1,000th career win with a 5-0 win over UT Arlington in Arlington, Texas (3/22/23).
- **Moore** recorded his 900th win overall with a 10-2 (5) victory over Grand Canyon in Waco (2/14/20).
- **Moore's** 800th career win came with a 9-3 win over McNeese State in Waco (2/22/18).
- **Moore** notched his 700th win at Baylor in the final game of the Tucson Super Regional, punching Baylor's ticket into the Women's College World Series (5/28/17).
- All but one of his 100-win milestones have come at Baylor, with his first 100th game coming during his tenure at LSU with a 6-5 win over Auburn (3/17/00).
- In **Moore's** 23 seasons as Baylor head coach, BU has cracked the Top 25 polls in all but one season.
- In 2021, **Moore** reached 800 wins at Baylor as he led the Bears back to the postseason at the Gainesville Regional.
- **Moore** has coached 88 of Baylor's 93 All-Big 12 selections and 13 of Baylor's 14 All-Americans.
- Baylor has had 9 players drafted into the National Professional Fastpitch (NPF) draft.
- Baylor has placed at least six selections to the conference's academic honors for 15 straight seasons and five or more for 20 straight years.
- Moore has a career record of **1052-506** over 27 seasons as a collegiate head coach.

MEET THE (RETURNING) TEAM

- With 21 returners, you will see some familiar faces on the diamond this year as 2023 letterwinners **Emry McDonough, Taylor Strain, Ava Knoll, Emily Hott, Ashlyn Wachtendorf, Kaci West, Shaylon Govan, Sydney Collazos, Presleigh Pilon, McKenzie Wilson, Ana Watson, Dariana Orme, Shannon Vivoda, RyLee Crandall, Caroline Rowatt, Jensen Vienne, Amber Toven, Aliyah Binford, Ellington Whitaker and Zadié LaValley** all came back.
- Of the returners, **Govan** returns with the highest batting average with .369 last season, while also recording a team high in home runs with 11 and RBIs with 54. She is also notched her name at the top of the Baylor record books with her single-season walks (47) and sacrifice flies (7) records.
- Also back, is **Orme** who led the team in the circle with 149.2 innings pitched, games started (26), and strikeouts (126)

MEET THE (FRESHMAN) TEAM

- Baylor added three freshmen to their roster this season, **Lexie Warncke, Leah Cran and Paige King**.
- All three newbies hail from Texas, with Cran and King as infielders and Warncke in the circle.

PRIVATE SCHOOLS IN THE WCWS

- Baylor’s four appearances in the Women’s College World Series places the Bears tied for third all-time among private schools.
- The Bears are one of two private schools to make the WCWS since 2008, doing so three times over that period (2011, 2014, 2017).
- Since 2000, Baylor leads all private schools with four appearances, with the next closest school being Northwestern and DePaul with three each.

GOOD TO BE HOME

- Baylor is in its 25th full season of play at Getterman Stadium, with the Bears securing a winning record in all but one full competition season since its doors were opened in 1999.
- Their first home game Getterman Stadium will take place Feb. 9 as Baylor their season with a three-game series against No. 2 Tennessee.
- In 2019, brand-new turf was installed on the field by GeoSurfaces, and new LED lights replaced the previous stadium fixtures.
- In 2020, Baylor installed a new video board. Daktronics, who has done every video board on campus with the exception of the one inside the Ferrell Center, did the renovations as the old scoreboard as be replaced with LED panels. The brick columns on either side of the board will remain in keeping with Baylor’s beautiful campus, and lighted letters that read Getterman Stadium are up above.
- Named for Sue and the late Ted Getterman, the stadium is considered one of the most premier softball venue in the nation. At the time, their donation stood as the largest single donation ever to a Baylor women’s athletics program.
