Equestrian

- Baylor returns to action facing No. 3 TCU in Burleson on Oct. 10 at 10am at Bear Creek Farms.

Football

- Baylor suffered a 43-21 loss at No. 16/16 Iowa State as the Cyclones used a strong final half to stay unbeaten.
- The Bears opened the game with a 14-3 lead and owned a 21-19 lead after the first drive in second half.
- QB Sawyer Robertson threw a career-high tying three TDs, finding Michael Trigg, Ketron Jackson Jr., and Josh Cameron for scores. He threw for 258 yards and added 24 more on the ground.
- BU has faced a rugged start to the 2024 schedule as its combined first six opponents own a 29-8 record and its first five Big 12 foes have combined to go 23-3 and 10-1 in Big 12 play.
- BU will travel to face Texas Tech in Lubbock on Oct. 19.

Men's Golf

- Men's golf opened play at the Big 12 Match Play Championship, which runs through Oct. 9th at the Clubs at Houston Oaks.
- The Bears finished second in 2023, the third time in program history BU finished first or second in the event's six years of existence.

Men's Tennis

- Hosted Big 12/SEC Challenge over the weekend
- Baylor went 13-5 over singles and doubles competition, facing off against five SEC schools
- No. 49 ranked Zsombor Velcz earned Big 12 MVP, going 5-1 on the weekend
- Transfer Quintan Van Wijk also went 5-1 on the weekend, going undefeated in singles
- Big 12 won out 48-42 over SEC

Soccer

- Fell against Texas Tech in its lone match last week, 1-0. The Bears still sit at No. 40 in the NCAA RPI rankings.
- BU will host Arizona State and West Virginia this week in its last two home matches of the season. Thursdays match against the Sun Devils will be senior night where the Bears will honor its seven seniors.
- After its two-game home stand, Baylor will go on the road for its final three games of the regular season.

Volleyball

- No. 14 Baylor fell 3-1 to No. 22 TCU on Sunday in Fort Worth.
- The 18th-ranked Bears are back in action with a pair of games in Utah, starting with a second-straight nationally televised match with No. 23 BYU at 8 p.m. CT on FS1
- The Utah swing will conclude with a 2 p.m. first serve against the Utes on Saturday on ESPN+.

Women's Tennis

- Begins the ITA Texas Regional Championship at TCU's Bayard H. Friedman Tennis Center on Thursday, running through Monday.
- The Bears have four entered in the qualifying draw and six in the main draw for a shot at qualifying to the NCAA Individual Championships in Waco next month. At all 13 ITA Regional sites across the nation, the two singles finalists and the doubles champion will punch their ticket to NCAAAs.
