- No. 9 BU welcomes No. 2 Texas A&M to Willis on Friday for a noon meet
- This will be just the second home meet of the season for Baylor
- All of BU's opponents so far this season have been ranked
- It'll be "Thanksgiving at Willis" with a canned food drive

Football

- Baylor won its fourth straight game with a 49-35 win at West Virginia on Saturday.
- It marked the first BU win at West Virginia in seven tries and saw the Bears roll to over 500 yards of total offense, with QB Sawyer Robertson throwing for 329 yards and three TDs.
- RB Bryson Washington had his second straight game with four TDs, rushing for three and adding a receiving score.
- LB Keaton Thomas had 12 tackles in his return to Morgantown, which is where he started his career as a walk-on defensive back.
- The Bears clinched bowl eligibility for the 12th time in the last 15 years.

Men's Tennis

- · Baylor men's tennis hosts the inaugural NCAA Men's and Women's Individual Championships at the Hurd Tennis Center this week, starting on Tuesday and running through Sunday.
- The Bears have two doubles teams, including Devin Badenhorst and Zsombor Velcz, and Oskar Brostrom Poulsen and Marko Miladinovc, with Badenhorst and Brostrom Poulsen also competing in singles.
- Baylor signed three student-athletes for 2025-26 last week, including Romania Alex Chirita, Blake Anderson and Drew Hedaecoe.

Men's Basketball

- No. 13/15 MBB beat Tarleton State 104-41 on Sunday night capping 2-0 week for the Bears.
- The 63-point win over Tarleton marks just the second 60+ point win over a D1 team (and fourth overall) for BU since 1980
- The 13 points allowed by The Bears in the first half on Sunday night were the second-fewest first-half points allowed by Baylor in the Big 12 Era (12)
- BU has recorded back-to-back 100-point games for the first time since 1989
- The Bears head to the Baha Mar Hoops Bahamas Championship where they will open against No. 22 St. John's on Thursday night
- The second all-time meeting between Rick Pitino and Scott Drew will be a match-up of two of the winningest basketball families. The Drew family (Scott, Homer and Bryce) have 1,344 wins, while the Pitino family (Rick and Richard) have 958 combined

Volleyball

- Baylor split a pair of matches in week 11 of play on the road
- . BU swent K-State for the eighth-straight win and fourthconsecutive sweep of the season on Wednesday
- The Bears fell to No. 12 Kansas on Saturday afternoon despite keeping sets close
- BU hosts Texas Tech on Wednesday before Senior Day against Houston on Saturday. These will be the last two home matches of the season
- The Pro Volleyball Federation draft will take place on Monday, 11/25, and will be live streamed
- . BU welcomed three for the 2025 class, including two libero/DS players and one middle blocker

Women's Basketball

- The Bears head to The Bahamas for the Battle 4 Atlantis that tips off on Saturday at 12:30 p.m. CT. The tournament will be streamed on FloCollege with the championship and consolation games on the last day broadcast on ESPN2 and ESPNU.
- BU faces Southern Miss on Saturday before advancing to play the winner/loser of the Indiana/Columbia game.
- The Bears went 2-0 at home last week, defeating East Texas A&M and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi by a combined 72 points. Darianna Littlenage-Burgs had her second double-double of the season and Aaronette Vonleh had the fifth double-double of her career against the Lions
