Equestrian

- Baylor was named the No. 10 team in the NCEA on Nov. 26. The final fall rankings come out on Dec. 10.
- BU fell in its final meet of the fall, 12-6 against No. 2 Texas A&M on November 22.
- The Bears will compete again on February 1, hosting South Dakota State

Football

- Defeated Kansas in dominating fashion, 45-17, on Saturday in regular-season finale
- The win marked BU's sixth-straight victory, its longest winning streak since 2019 and longest winning streak to end a regular season in program history.
- Baylor logged its first game since 2021 with over 600 yards of total offense (603), its first game with two 100+ yard rushers since 2021, and first game with two 100+ yard receivers since 2019
- Redshirt junior QB Sawyer Robertson was named a Big 12 Co-Offensive Player of the Week and to the Davey O'Brien Award's Great 8 after his 23-for-31, 310-yard and 4 TD performance
- Redshirt freshman RB Bryson Washington ran for 192 yards on 28 carries and scored twice to set the program's freshman rushing record with 1,004 yards on the season. He is the first rookie in program history to eclipse the 1,000-yard mark.
- Sixth-year senior LB Matt Jones and redshirt sophomore LB Keaton Thomas are the first pair of BU teammates with over 100 tackles each in the same season since 2012.
- Baylor's eight-win regular season is just its third since the 2015 season.

Men's Basketball

- No. 15 Baylor faces off with the No. 25 UConn Huskies in the Big 12-Big East Battle, pitting two of the last three national champions against each other in a 5:30 p.m. CT tip-off on FS1
- Scott Drew is seeking his 450th career win at Baylor, facing Dan Hurley in a matchup of the two youngest active coaches to win a national championship
- Drew is one of six active coaches who have won a national title, beating two of the other five already this season (Calipari & Pitino). Wednesday's meeting is one of two more scheduled meetings with an active champion (Hurley and Self).
- The Bears are 15-3 against the Big East in the Drew Era
- Baylor is a Big 12 best 14-4 in conference challenges, including a 3-1 in Big 12-Big East Battle

Volleyball

- Baylor earned the No. 4 seed in the bottom left quadrant of the 2024 NCAA Championship bracket, the No. 15 seed overall.
- The Bears are hosting for the fifth time in the last eight years, with Dayton, South Carolina and Wofford coming to Waco for the First & Second Rounds.
- BU is 9-1 when playing on its home court in the NCAA Tournament.
- This will be Baylor's 13th overall appearance in the tournament, and the ninth-straight which have all come under head coach Ryan McGuyre.
- The Bears will face Wofford on Thursday at 7 p.m. at the Ferrell Center, Dayton and South Carolina facing off at 4:30 p.m. The winner of the two matches will play in the second round on Friday at 7 p.m.
- Baylor is one of six Big 12 teams in the tournament and is one of four hosting.
- Baylor's Elise McGhee was unanimously chosen as First Team All-Big 12, while Jackie Barrett Frazier, Lauren Briseño and Allie Sczech were named Second Team

Women's Basketball

- Went 3-0 last week, defeating Villanova for third place in the Battle
 4 Atlantis tournament before returning home with wins over New
 Orleans and Louisiana Tech at Foster Pavilion.
- Fifth-year Bear Sarah Andrews broke the program 3-point record on Sunday against LA Tech, passing Odyssey Sims' 258 career threes for sole possession of No. 1 in Baylor WBB history.
 Andrews achieved the feat in four less games than Sims.
- Sunday's game against LA Tech was the first time Baylor had three with double-doubles since 1/18/2023
- Baylor continues its five-game homestand against Texas Southern on Wednesday and UNLV on Sunday.
