Equestrian

- Baylor was named the No. 10 team in the NCEA on Dec. 10, the final fall rankings.
- Fifth year Madison Mitchell has earned a pair of monthly honors, being named Flat Rider of the Month for November for both the Big 12 and NCEA after going 2-1 with two MOP awards, all against ranked opponents.
- The Bears will compete again on February 1, hosting South Dakota State.

Football

- Baylor Football will wrap up its 2024 season with the Kinder's Texas Bowl, facing off with eight-win LSU on Dec. 31 at 2:30 p.m. in Houston at NRG Stadium, the home of the Houston Texans.
- The Bears will be facing LSU for the first time since 1985 in the Liberty Bowl and for the third time in its bowl history.
- Baylor finished 2024 having won six straight games, the longest streak to conclude a regular-season in program history.
- The Bears signed 21 players on early signing day on Dec. 4, completing the No. 35 recruiting class in the nation, its highest ranking since 2018.
- Josh Cameron was named a Second Team All-American punt returner Tuesday by the FWAA
- Cameron is the first Baylor return man in program history to be recognized as an All-American by the FWAA, and first special teams honoree for the Bears since 2006 (Daniel Sepulveda).
- Cameron joins Trestan Ebner's three honors in 2020 as the only BU return men in program history to be named All-Americans.
- Four Bears were named All-Big 12 honorees by the Associated Press in Matt Jones (First Team LB), Keaton Thomas (First Team LB), Palmer Williams (First Team P) and Omar Aighedion (Second Team OL).
- Seven players were named to the Dave Campbell's Texas Football
 All-Texas Teams including Omar Aigbedion (OL), Keaton Thomas
 (LB) and Palmer Williams (P) to the first team, while Josh
 Cameron (WR), Lorando Johnson (DB), Sawyer Robertson (QB) and
 Bryson Washington (RB) were tabbed to the second team.

Men's Basketball

- Baylor's Elise McGhee was unanimously chosen as First Team All-Big 12, while Jackie Barrett Frazier, Lauren Briseño and Allie Sczech were named Second Team. named on Dec. 3.
- McGhee was named AVCA All-Southwest Region on Dec. 10. The AVCA All-American list will be revealed on Wednesday, Dec. 18.
- Baylor hosted a program-record 21 home matches in 2024, second to only Nebraska by one match.
- In total, BU hosted 30 matches at the Ferrell Center on the season with non-conference and NCAA tournaments.
