STORY LINES

STARTING FIVE

- BU stays on the road for its third-straight game, this time landing in Orlando, Fla., to face UCF at Addition Financial Arena on Wednesday night.
- Baylor has its best start to conference play in the **Nicki Collen** era through eight games with a 6-2 record.
- TCU snapped its 37-game skid against the Bears on Sunday afternoon in Fort Worth, with Baylor nearly mounting a comeback, 80-75.
- BU completed a 10-3 non-conference slate, going perfect at home in the first season of non-con play at Foster Pavilion, with losses coming at Oregon, against Indiana in The Bahamas and No. 1 UCLA in Newark at the Coretta Scott King Classic.
- Baylor's fall from the AP poll marks the 20th instance in the last 388 polls that the Bears have not been ranked in the AP Top 25. Week Nos. 7 and 10 were also just the seventh and eighth time in that span, dating back to January 5, 2004, that Baylor received zero votes following a streak of 347 consecutive appearances broken on January 16, 2023.

SCOUTING THE SERIES

- Baylor and UCF are facing off for just the fifth time ever, with Baylor taking all four of the prior matchups.
- BU has only faced UCF once before in Orlando, but has a pair of appearances at the UCF Holiday Classic (1988, 1992) in the record book. In the game against, then, Central Florida, Baylor won 110-67 on Dec. 31, 1992.
- UCF is still in search of its first conference win of the season, already facing TCU, West Virginia, Arizona, Colorado, Cincinnati, TCU, Oklahoma State and Iowa State.
- Kaitlin Peterson far outpaces the Knights in scoring, averaging 20.7 a game shooting 41.1% from the floor. Peterson's average ranks her 17th nationally and third in the league.
- Head coach Sytia Messer spent eight seasons in Waco as an assistant coach in the Mulkey era (2013-2021) before being named head coach in Orlando in 2022. With BU, Messer won eight conference regular season titles, six conference tournament titles and the 2019 National Championship.

ANOTHER PERFECT NON-CON SLATE AT THE CRIB

- Baylor went 8-0 at home in non-conference play, completing the second-straight and third overall undefeated home non-con schedule in the fourth year of the **Nicki Collen** era.
- BU holds a 19-game win streak in regular season non-con home games, last dropping a Nov. 20, 2022, contest against then-No.19 Maryland, 73-68, at the Ferrell Center.
- 2024-25 held the first non-conference schedule at the new Foster Pavilion, after opening the facility for conference play in 2023-24.

SARAH CLIMBING THE RANKS

- Fifth-year senior **Sarah Andrews**, who has spent all five years in a Baylor uniform, is No. 2 all-time in games played for Baylor, the most in the NCAA era, and No. 6 in games started.
- 153 games played is the second-most in the program, and the most in the 43-year span of WBB as an NCAA-sponsored sport. The overall record of 162 is held by Suzie Snider Eppers from 1973-77 while the Bears competed in the AIAW. Andrews is on-pace to break the all-time record at 163 games in Baylor's March 2 matchup against TCU.
- 121 games started puts her behind Jessica Morrow (2005-09) at 122. National champion Brittney Griner holds the games started record at 148.
- Andrews is also hit her 259th-career 3-pointer against LA Tech for the program record, breaking Odyssey Sims' figure that set in the 2010-14 seasons. Sims' previous record of 258 3-pointers came in 145 games while Andrews hit her 259th in the 141st game.
- Andrews already set the record for 3-pointers attempted, hit last season 659.
- The Irving, Texas, native also recorded her 500th-career assist against Villanova, becoming one of five to reach that milestone completely in a Baylor uniform. Against the Houston Cougars in Waco, Andrews is moved past Didi Richards for lone possession of third-most assists in program history.

BIG SEASON BUGGS

- Junior **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** averages a double-double (13.8 ppg, 10.3 rpg) in 20 games this season with 14 double-digit scoring performances, three with 20+.
- Against UNLV, **Littlepage-Buggs** became the eighth Bear to record a 20-point, 20-rebound game with 21 points and 20 rebounds. She joins Debbie Polk, Maggie Davis Stinnett, Danielle Crockrom, Sophia Young-Malcolm, Brittney Griner, Kalani Brown and NaLyssa Smith, Smith who most recently had a 20/20 game against Iowa State in the 2021-22 season.

• She's set new career-best marks this season in rebounds (20 vs UNLV), assists (five vs New Orleans), steals (five vs Utah Tech), 3-pointers (two vs UIW), and free throws made (10 vs ETAMU). **Buggs** has also tied or set her career best marks in attempts for all three shot categories.

NEAR COMEBACK BID AGAINST THE FROGS

- BU dropped its second consecutive game in a Saturday afternoon contest against No. 9 TCU in Fort Worth, 80-75. The decision gave TCU its first win over the Bears since 1990, snapping a 37-win streak for Baylor.
- Nearly mounting a comeback after being down by as many as 22 points halfway through the third, the bid fell just short to give BU its first road conference loss of the season in the second of two consecutive losses, the team's first skid this campaign.
- With a season-low four turnovers, the second-lowest of the Collen era, the Bears were led by Sarah Andrews with 21 points with five 3-pointers that matched her season best.
- Florida transfer Aliyah Matharu recorded 21 quality minutes in the contest, ending the day +19 in the point differential while on the court after hitting a pair of big threes.

TOOK ON NO. 1

- Baylor faced UCLA in the inaugural Coretta Scott King Classic on Martin Luther King Jr. Day at the Prudential Center in Newark. In the program's 14th game against the top team in the nation, BU fell 72-57.
- After a 15-point scoring run in the first from UCLA, Baylor answered with seven unanswered to get as close as five points from the lead.
- **Yaya Felder** led the scoring efforts for BU with 10, the only Bear in double figures, while **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** was once again the leading rebounder with 10.
- UCLA's Lauren Betts was a block and rebound away from a triple double, with 24 points, nine rebounds and a program-record nine blocks.

BU & UH BATTLE AT FOSTER

- BU got its fifth straight win in a Friday night contest against the Houston Cougars at Foster Pavilion in the first of two games played against the two squads this conference season.
- Baylor held UH to just 27.3% from the floor while the Bears had their worst performance at the arc in the Collen era at 14.3% (3-21).
- **Aaronette Vonleh** led scoring for the second-straight game with 18 and nine rebounds.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** and **Aliyah Matharu** each scored double figures.
- Freshman **Kayla Nelms** had her best game against a Big 12 foe so far, scoring six in eight minutes.

UPSETTING THE UTES

- RV Baylor upset the No. 23 Utah Utes in Waco for the second-straight season, 70-61. With the win, BU moved to 5-1 in conference play, continuing Collen's best start to the league slate in her tenure as a Bear.
- Utah was Baylor's first ranked opponent of the season, giving them their first Top 25 win in their first attempt.
- Playing without **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** who was serving a suspension from ASU, the Bears stepped it up with a 53.7% shooting performance, their first 50%+ of conference play and third over a Power Four opponent, led by **Aaronette Vonleh's** 19 points.
- **Bella Fontleroy** had her second double-double of the season with 17 points and 10 rebounds and also stacked five steals and a pair of blocks on to her impressive stat line. The junior played all but 34 seconds in the game, a new career high for minutes on the court.
- **Jada Walker's** career-high 12 assists propelled her to the Bears' second double-double of the game, paired with 12 points and only a single turnover in 37 minutes.
- **Yaya Felder** had the second start of her Baylor career, going 5-of-8 from the floor for 11 points.
- It was just the second win for BU while being outrebounded, as the Utes outnumbered the Bears, 31-29.

THE DEVILS WENT DOWN IN TEMPE

- BU had five in double figures for the third-straight game in its 78-59 win over Arizona State at Desert Financial Arena.
- **Aliyah Matharu** fell right into place in her first big game for the Bears, scoring 14 points and four rebounds and a pair of 3-pointers.
- **Sarah Andrews** led scoring for Baylor with 16, nailing four triples in 26 minutes of action.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** was 5-of-6 in 13 minutes played, tying the No. 2 mark this season for best field goal percentage (83.3%) with at least five made.

COLLEN'S FIRST OT DUB

- **Nicki Collen** secured the first overtime win of her Baylor tenure in an 81-76 victory over the Arizona Wildcats at the McKale Memorial Center in Tucson.
- Entering 0-3 in OT games in the Collen era, BU got its first win in overtime since a March 27, 2021, contest over Michigan.
- Baylor held Arizona to one offensive rebound off 31 misses, marking the fewest allowed since at least the 2000-01 season. In those 25 years, BU never held its opponents to less than three offensive rebounds, the last coming against West Virginia on March 4, 2023.
- BU went into half with a 13-point lead and led by as much as 17 with just over two minutes to go in the second quarter, but the Wildcats used a 61.5% scoring performance in the second half compared to the Bears' 38.7%.

- **Jada Walker** paced the Bears in scoring for the second time, putting up 16 points with nine assists and six rebounds.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** outscored and rebounded Arizona in the overtime period, getting eight points and three rounds compared to their five points and one rebound.

A WARM WELCOME BACK FOR THE BUFFS

- A 76-62 win welcomed the Colorado Buffaloes back to the Big 12 Conference in the team's second conference win of the year and the ninth straight over the Buffs.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** led the Bears for the fifth time in scoring and 12th time in rebounding for her seventh double-double of the season.
- In her first game against her former team, **Aaronette Vonleh** got 15 points and a trio of steals.
- All five starters tallied double figures in BU's 46.6% shooting performance.

COWGIRLS STIFLE THE BEARS AT HOME

- Baylor suffered the worst loss of the **Nicki Collen** era against Oklahoma State in the conference home opener on New Year's Day at Foster Pavilion.
- In just the third loss at the year-old facility, BU shot 32.4% from the floor with **Yaya Felder** (16 pts) and **Jada**

Walker (12) being the only Bears finding double-figure points on the afternoon.

- OSU shot 77.3% in the second half to go up as much as 25 points, while Felder was 3-of-4 from beyond the arc.

DOWNED THE JAYHAWKS IN LAWRENCE

- Baylor won its 19th conference opener since the 2000-01 season and ninth on the road in a 20-point victory over the Kansas Jayhawks at Allen Fieldhouse in the program's first pre-Christmas conference game since women's basketball was sanctioned by the NCAA.
- **Sarah Andrews** nailed five 3-pointers to put up 19 points on the night to give the Bears their seventh-straight win.
- BU tied season-best stats in turnovers (8) and blocks (11).
- Baylor held Kansas to 32.8 from the floor, but the Jayhawks picked up 23 points (23-of-30; 76.6%) from the free throw line.

(DOUBLE U)NLV

- Baylor downed UNLV at Foster Pavilion before the finals break, 71-64.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** became the eighth player to record a 20/20 game with 21 points and 20 rebounds, with a new career high mark in rebounds.

- BU used a 16-point run to pull away from UNLV in the third quarter for an 11-point lead, the largest of the game.
- **Sarah Andrews** passed the 1,500 career point mark with 18 on the day, as **Aaronette Vonleh** recorded a third 20-point game in 27 minutes.

BU BY 72 OVER TEXAS SOUTHERN

- Baylor held Texas Southern to just 29 points, the third sub-30 point effort by an opponent in the **Nicki Collen** era, at 12-of-19 (.174) from the floor. 17.4% was the worst shooting performance by a Baylor opponent since playing McNeese in Dec. 2020. The Tigers sunk only four field goals per quarter through the third, and was 0-of-16 from the floor in the fourth with just two free throws.
- It was the first time in the Collen era that BU did not allow a 3-pointer. Baylor was one of three Big 12 teams (first since 2011) and one of 13 teams nationally since at least 1999-00 to hold an opponent to a .000 3-point shooting percentage with the opponent taking at least 21 3-pointers.
- BU won the game by 72 points, the biggest win since an 80-point defeat of McNeese last November.

SEEING TRIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLES AGAINST THE LADY TECHSTERS

- It was the first time since Feb. 18, 2023, that Baylor ended the evening with three double-doubles: **Jada Walker** (14p/10a), **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** (13p/12r) and **Bella Fontleroy** (10p/10r).
- **Walker's** double-double was only the second of her career, dating back to Nov. 13 2022 when Kentucky played Coastal Carolina.
- **Sarah Andrews** took the 3-point program record with the 259th triple of her career with 8:15 left in the fourth quarter.
- A 19-0 run in the second quarter put the Bears out of reach from LA Tech, their best run of the season, after the Lady Techsters brought the game within three with an eight-point run.

BEARS BATTLE 4 ATLANTIS

- Baylor went 2-1 over three days in the 2024 Battle 4 Atlantis for third place in the eight-team tournament, defeating Southern Miss and Villanova with a loss to Indiana.
- The Bears clinched third place with a 73-62 win over the Villanova Wildcats. In the game, BU had its best shooting performance of the year at 58.7% going 27-for-47, led by **Aaronette Vonleh** having an 8-for-11 night in the paint to total 19, the best of her early Baylor career.
- Villanova started at a perfect 6-for-6 from three but the Bears surged late to outscore the Wildcats 20-9 in the fourth quarter. It was the first time in over a year that BU allowed 10+ 3-pointers in a game (last vs. Harvard on Nov. 19, 2023)
- Taking the second loss of the season to an unranked team, Indiana defeated BU, 73-65, in the semifinal round. Baylor matched its worst shooting performance of the then-six-game season at 33.3% but suffered after going 16-for-26 from the charity stripe.
- Indiana had a strong first quarter that produced a 17-0 run with nine points in the quarter from Shay Ciezki.
- Baylor opened the tournament with a dominant 101-55 win over Southern Miss in just the third 100+ point game of Collen's stint with the Bears. BU tied the No. 2 mark in program history for the most 3-pointers game at 15 (record of 17 was set against McNeese in Nov. 2023). Six Bears lent a hand from deep, as **Bella Fontleroy** and **Sarah Andrews** each had four, **Yaya Felder** had three, **Waiata Jennings** had two and **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** and **Jada Walker** each had one.

DOWN TO THE WIRE AT MKA

- Baylor suffered its first loss of the season at Oregon, 76-74, in Eugene.
- Down 62-48 at the start of the fourth quarter, the Bears outscored the Ducks, 26-10, in the first nine minutes of the final frame, but Oregon's four points in the last minute from **Deja Kelly** and **Elisa Mevius** secured the win for the home team.
- **Jada Walker** scored 24 on the evening to lead the green and gold, shooting 9-for-20 from the field in 36 minutes with another team-leading four steals.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** had her fifth straight game in double figures and got her first double-double of the season, 20th of her career.
- **Sarah Andrews** scored 13 in 36 minutes with six assists, her best since last season's contest (7) against Oklahoma State at Foster Pavilion.

A QUARTER FROM BUGGS IN THE SEASON OPENER

- Junior **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** turned in 25 points in Baylor's season opener against Incarnate Word in 31 minutes.
- Buggs drained the first 3-pointer of her career late in the third quarter before sinking her second in the fourth.
- **Bella Fontleroy** set a career-best mark at 14 boards, with nine coming in the second half.
- **Jana Van Gytenbeek** and **Aaronette Vonleh** also ended the night in double figures.
- **Jada Walker** tied her assists career mark with 10.
- BU outrebounded UIW 47-22, 15-4 on the offensive glass.

OLD KIDS ON THE BLOCK

- For the first time in the Nicki Collen era, Baylor's roster features more returners than newcomers.
- Only lost two starters: Aijha Blackwell and Dre'Una Edwards.
- With a combined 117 games played under Collen the season prior returning for Year Two (22-23) and 171 returning for Year Three (23-24), this season's roster will feature 226 games played last year under Collen, an over 30% year-over-year increase.
- 80% of last season's scoring returns for 2024-25, up from 56% in Year Three and 57% in Year Two.

BEARS IN THE 1K CLUB

STORY LINES

- Baylor's active roster holds five student-athletes who have eclipsed the 1,000-career point mark at the Division I level.
- **Sarah Andrews** (1,623 pts - all at BU), **Aliyah Matharu** (1,480 pts - 51 at BU), **Yaya Felder** (1,339 pts - 476 at BU), **Jada Walker** (1,246 pts - 523 at BU) and **Aaronette Vonleh** (1,240 pts - 281 at BU). **Madison Bartley**'s career ended in a medical retirement at 1,096 points in January.
- NJCAA transfer **Waiaa Jennings** scored 1,227 career points in a two-year stint at Collin College, upping the total to seven across collegiate competition.

YAYA HONORED IN PARADISE

- **Yaya Felder** was named to the Battle 4 Atlantis All-Tournament Team with 42 points in the three games, averaging 14 per game.
- Shooting lights-out from three, **Felder's** 69.2% from behind the arc ranked first in the tournament, going 9-for-13. Nine threes were third behind Ball State's Madelyn Bischoff (13) and Columbia's Riley Weiss (10).
- **Felder** had a big day in the Bears' loss to the Hoosiers, scoring 20, her Baylor-high and most since ending her career at Ohio with five-straight games at 20+ points. The senior joins six others in posting 20+ points at the Battle 4 Atlantis.
- Five threes against Indiana tied for the best single-game performance in the tournament from deep, ending as one of five with five threes made in a game.

MID-YEAR ADDITION FROM THE SEC

- **Aliyah Matharu** joined Baylor as a mid-year transfer after stops at Mississippi State, Texas and most recently, Florida.
- The Washington, D.C., native was No. 2 in the SEC scoring ranks last season with 570 points, averaging 19 per game.
- Matharu was an Honorable Mention All-Big 12 pick at Texas and was named SEC Freshman of the Week twice her first season at Mississippi State.

VAN GYTENBEEK, A KAY YOW SERVANT LEADER

- **Jana Van Gytenbeek**, who announced a season-ending ACL tear sustained during the first game of the season, was awarded the Kay Yow Servant Leader Award in its first season.
- The award honors student-athletes of great character who put the needs of others before their own, who uplift others and who do it with grace and humility. They are nominated by their coach and exemplify Coach Yow's spirit to reflect her resolve, grace, generosity and servant's heart.
- Van Gytenbeek joined Derek Smith on the Baylor Sports Media Network as the analyst for the Coretta Scott King Classic, when the Bears took on No. 1 UCLA.

NETTY IN THE PAINT

- Waco welcomed Colorado transfer **Aaronette Vonleh** to the Bears' roster for the 2024-25 season.
- Netty joined Baylor after an All-Pac-12 stint with the Buffaloes that featured the 2023 Most Improved Player honor and led Colorado in points scored in 2024, averaging 14 points per game.
- She is Baylor's sixth-consecutive Big 12 Preseason Newcomer of the Year, the program's 11th all-time, and shares the honor with TCU's Hailey Van Lith.
- Also featured on the All-Big 12 Preseason Team was **Sarah Andrews**, helping Baylor join K-State as the only schools with multiple mentions.
- In Netty's first game in the green and gold, the senior turned in 16 points in just shy of 21 minutes. Shooting 6-of-8 from the field, the Oregon native sunk her third-career 3-pointer, making one in each season at Colorado.
- Vonleh had just the fifth double-double of her career in Game No. 3 against East Texas A&M, tabbing 18 points and 11 rebounds.
- Netty scored her Baylor-best point total against LA Tech with 21 and had a career high rebound total against New Orleans with 12.

BIG-BRAINED BEARS

- BU had its best semester in the classroom outside of a COVID term during the Fall 2024 course schedule, posting a 3.26 GPA.
- 10 Bears posted higher than a 3.0 and four were honored as Academic Champions by the Baylor Athletics Student-Athlete Center for Excellence.

INJURY WOES

- The Bears' roster holds three players sidelined due to injury at this point in the 2024-25 season.
- **Ines Goryanova** was redshirted for her true freshman season while rehabbing a knee injury sustained before coming to Waco to begin her collegiate career.
- **Jana Van Gytenbeek** announced a season-ending ACL tear sustained during the first game of the season on social media on November 10, 2024.
- **Madison Bartley** announced her medical retirement on social media on January 24, 2025, due to "an ongoing medical issue."

ON THE DOTTED LINE

- Head coach Nicki Collen signed Marcyayla Johnson on National Signing Day out of Tulsa, Okla.
- The Booker T. Washington HS soon-to-be graduate is rated four stars by 247Sports and is ranked 38th nationally. She is 11th among shooting guards and the sixth-best player out of Oklahoma.
- espnW HoopGurlz ranked Johnson 41st in the Class of 2025.

NUMBERS TO WATCH

- BU has two players chasing 500 career rounds: **Aaronette Vonleh** is lacking 35 and **Bella Fontleroy** needs 37.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** is 35 points away from being BU's sixth active player with 1k points at the DI level.

MAINSTAY IN THE PRESEASON RANKS

- Baylor opened the season ranked 12th in the nation by the Associated Press. The Bears' ranking in the AP poll was the 20th consecutive appearance in the preseason release. Among Big 12 schools, BU landed second in four league foes in the top 25.
- The Big 12 coaches picked the Bears to finish third in the conference with two first-place votes.

KEEP WATCH

- Baylor landed three players on five preseason watch lists, announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club, the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame and the Los Angeles Athletic Club.
- **Sarah Andrews** earned spots on the Naismith Trophy Women's College Player of the Year watch list and the Ann Meyers-Drysdale watch list for the best shooting guard in the country.
- **Andrews** is one of nine watch list members from the 16-team Big 12 Conference. Iowa State and Kansas State each are represented by two student-athletes on the list.
- **Darianna Littlepage-Buggs** took her second-straight spot on the preseason list from the Katrina McClain Award for power forwards.
- **Aaronette Vonleh** landed among the top 20 for the Lisa Leslie Award for the best center in the nation.
- **Jada Walker** and **Yaya Felder** also received votes for the Naismith Starting 5 awards, but did not rank in the top 20.
- **Andrews** and **Littlepage-Buggs** were also named to the 50-player Wooden Award Preseason Watch List for the Wooden All-American and Most Outstanding Player Awards

BEARS ON THE TELLY

- Baylor was selected for seven national broadcasts in 2024-25: at Oregon (BTN), vs. Villanova (ESPNU), vs. UCLA (FOX), at TCU (ESPN2), Iowa State (FOX), at K-State (ESPN2) and TCU (FS1).
- Foster Pavilion will be showcased twice against Iowa State (Feb. 22) on FOX and against TCU (March 2) on FS1.

HEAD COACH NICKI COLLEN • 4TH SEASON



Nicki Collen was introduced as the fifth Head Coach in Baylor women's basketball history on May 5, 2021. She enters her fourth season at the helm in 2024-25 after a contract extension to 2030 that was announced in July.

In her first season with the Bears, Collen recorded the most wins by a rookie head coach in the country with 28. She helped lead

the Bears to their 12th-straight Big 12 regular-season title and their 11th-straight top-two seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Collen implemented her system, which featured more perimeter shooting. Baylor went from the bottom of the list nationally to just outside the top 50 in 3-pointers made. In her first season, the Bears set new program records for 3-pointers made (233) and attempted (678).

From her introductory press conference, the Naismith Coach of the Year semifinalist said the Bears would be playing their best basketball late in the season, and she was right. Baylor became the first team to defeat a ranked opponent twice in a three-day span since 1999 when the Bears downed Texas two times to open the month of February. Two weeks later, exactly a month after sitting at the bottom of the conference standings with an 0-2 record, BU was back atop the league's leaderboard.

Collen implemented the 1-0 mentality that paid off with a 25-point win at No. 8 Iowa State in front of a nearly soldout crowd of 13,000 raucous fans which clinched the conference crown. Baylor became the first team since Texas Tech in 2000 to start a Big 12 season 0-2 and go on to win the league.

After her first season ended in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, Collen saw three of her players be selected in the 2022 WNBA Draft, tying a program record. Two of them - NaLyssa Smith (No. 2) and Queen Egbo (No. 10) marked the first duo to be taken in the top 10 in program history.

Collen's first recruiting class was ranked No. 9 nationally by ESPN HoopGurlz.

In year two, Collen mentored two all-conference selection, two unanimous Big 12 All-Freshman Team picks and the unanimous Big 12 Freshman of the Year, Darianna Littlepage-Buggs. Littlepage-Buggs earned eight Big 12 Freshman of the Week awards during the 2022-23 campaign, becoming the first BU rookie to earn it eight-or-more times in program history. Additionally, she ranked second in the Big 12 all-time in freshman of the week honors.

The Bears secured 20 wins for the 23rd-straight year, which is the second-longest active streak among Division I programs behind UConn's 30-straight 20-plus win seasons. Collen led Baylor to its 19th-straight NCAA Tournament appearance in 2022-23 and 21st overall, as the Bears erased an 18-point deficit to win their opening-round game against Alabama.

Collen's Bears ended year three with a trip to the Sweet 16, highlighted by seven wins over AP-ranked opponents, the most among Big 12 programs. At the beginning of the 2023-24 season, the Bears compiled the second-best start in program history, behind only 2012's 40-0 season, totaling 14-straight non-conference wins. BU then opened the new Foster Pavilion on Jan. 3, 2024, with a strong 71-50 defeat of then-No. 23 TCU in the first conference game of the season.

BU extended the fourth-longest active NCAA Tournament appearance streak in the country to 20-straight with two wins to advance out of the Virginia Tech Regional.

Collen came to Baylor from the WNBA's Atlanta franchise, where she spent the last three seasons at the helm for the Dream. Her rookie season in Atlanta resulted in a 23-11 season in 2018, where she earned WNBA Coach of the Year honors and helped the franchise to the WNBA Playoff Semifinals.

Prior to her arrival in Atlanta, she spent two seasons under former head coach Curt Miller of the Connecticut Sun, helping the franchise improve from fifth in the East Division to second from 2016 to 2017, respectively.

"I am thrilled to be the head coach at Baylor University. I believe it is the top job in the country for women's basketball," said Collen. "I am excited to begin working with this extremely talented team and I am grateful for the unwavering support of President Livingstone and Mack Rhoades. The success of this program speaks for itself, and I will begin working today to ensure Baylor women's basketball continues to be a program that excels at the highest levels."

Collen's collegiate coaching career spanned for nine seasons prior to her WNBA arrival. She spent two seasons as an assistant at Colorado State from 2000-2002, one season at Ball State from 2002-2003, one at Louisville from 2003-2004, three at Arkansas from 2011-2014 and two at Florida Gulf Coast from 2014-2016.

Her teams' combined record in nine seasons as an NCAA Division I assistant was 214-74, good for a .743 win percentage. As an assistant, Collen guided four different squads to the NCAA Tournament, reaching the second round in three of those seasons.

She spent six of her nine seasons as an assistant under her husband, Tom Collen's head-coaching tenures at Colorado State, Louisville and Arkansas. She also coached under Tracy Roller at Ball State and Karl Smesko at Florida Gulf Coast. Collen helped the FGCU program to a 64-9 record and the school's first NCAA Tournament win in her two-year tenure.

In her nine seasons at the collegiate level, Collen coached three All-Americans and saw three players selected in the WNBA Draft.

Collen's collegiate playing career began at Purdue in 1993-94, when the Boilermakers made an NCAA Final Four run with a 29-5 overall record and a 16-2 mark in the Big Ten. Her sophomore season, Purdue made another deep run with an Elite Eight appearance to go with a 24-8 overall record. She transferred to Marquette, where she tallied 421 assists in her final two seasons, averaging 7.0 per game in her last 60 collegiate games. She helped the Golden Eagles to two-straight NCAA Tournament appearances in 1997 and 1998.

Nicki and her husband Tom have three children, Connor, Reese and Logan.

PAUL AND ALEJANDRA FOSTER PAVILION



The Paul and Alejandra Foster Pavilion along with the Jay & Jenny Allison Development Center is the new home for Baylor's championship-winning Men's and Women's Basketball teams, having played 35 seasons inside the historic Ferrell Center. The Pavilion is a state-of-the-art contemporary field house seating 7,500 fans, located along the banks of the Brazos River on the west side of Interstate 35. Inside, fans are closer to the court to create a true home court advantage.

The Foster's location on the banks of the Brazos allows for the community to be a part of the building's foundation. As a stop on the Riverwalk, the pavilion will be woven into the established traditions of the Waco community. Our fans can enjoy time at local businesses before taking in a game. Just across the interstate from the new Mark & Paula Hurd Welcome Center, this transformative building bolsters the Baylor campus landscape.

The benefit of the new pavilion seating is a more dynamic fan experience. At a capacity of 7,500, fans feel closer to the action and make a dynamic impact on the competition. The new elevation will allow fans to directly access their seat from the concourse, whether you are in premium or standard seating. Fans with premium seating will have access to the Courtside or Sideline Club. The Foster Pavilion will house an exclusive premium entrance, unique to those with premium seating. The Courtside Club is reserved for Champions Row ticket holders. The Sideline Club is located underneath the Club and Loft seats.

The concourse will feature new concession opportunities as well as unique vendor activations. Fans will be welcomed by an energetic atmosphere, cultivated by both the Baylor and Waco communities.

The project scope of the Foster Pavilion & Development Center includes:

- A 223,547-square-foot facility
- Capacity for 7,500 fans including standing-room-only areas for approximately 500 spectators
- Two separate premium club spaces at a combined 8,500 square feet
- Two 2,000-square-foot video end boards
- Visiting locker rooms with the flexibility to accommodate two to four teams
- The Jay & Jenny Allison Development Center for Baylor's championship women's and men's basketball teams, including:
 - Private entrance and elevator, separate practice courts, dedicated locker rooms and team lounges
 - Office facilities for each coach and administration
 - Shared sports performance-related spaces, including strength and conditioning, athletic training/treatment, hydrotherapy, nutrition and more
- Enhancements for the arena to support additional events, such as concerts, performances and public events, including stage rigging, full catering kitchen and cooking capability, additional dressing rooms for performers and related offices

Ground was broken on the state-of-the-art Foster Pavilion on May 2, 2022, with the playing floor installed on November 6, 2023. The inaugural men's basketball game came against Cornell on Tuesday, January 2, 2024, with BU winning 98-79. The inaugural women's basketball game was played on Wednesday, January 3, 2024, against TCU, BU winning 71-50.

- Baylor is 276-2 all-time when shooting 50 percent or better from the field and 40-0 when shooting 60 percent or higher. The Bears' last loss when shooting over 50 percent was to No. 22 Michigan on 11/27/22.
- 379 of Baylor's wins since 2010-11 have been by 10 or more points, and only 28 times in that span has its winning margin been five or fewer points.
- Since the 2010-11 season, Baylor is 49-10 vs. Top 25 opponents at home.
- Baylor is 365-116 (.761) vs. Big 12 opponents in the regular season all-time.

THE BAYLOR BEARS REGIME

2019 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2018-19 Bears became just the third women's program in NCAA history to win three titles when Baylor beat Notre Dame, 82-81, April 7 in Tampa, Florida. **Chloe Jackson's** go-ahead scoop layup with under five seconds left propelled her to NCAA Final Four Most Outstanding Player honors to go along with a team-high 26 points in the game. The Bears rode the wave of two All-American posts with **Kalani Brown** and **Lauren Cox**, each earning multiple all-America honors. The pair led Baylor to its 10th regular-season and tournament championship in the Big 12 and **Kim Mulkey** was honored as national coach of the year by the USBWA, the Associated Press and the WBCA.

2012 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The 2011-12 Bear season was as perfect as it could be. En route to claiming its second NCAA Championship in seven years, Baylor ran the table, posting an unprecedented 40-0 mark and claiming both Big 12 Conference crowns. **Brittney Griner** and Mulkey swept player of the year and coach of the year honors, earning WBCA, USBWA, Associated Press, Naismith and Big 12 Conference recognition. Baylor was ranked No. 1 wire-to-wire in both polls and raced through conference play with a Big 12-record 18-0 mark. Griner and **Odyssey Sims** were named consensus All-Americans, while **Destiny Williams** was a WBCA All-America honorable mention honoree.

2005 NCAA CHAMPIONS

The squad posted a 33-3 record and claimed the Big 12 Conference title with a 14-2 mark. En route to the program's first NCAA Championship, the Bears defeated three No. 1 seeds. **Steffanie Blackmon** and **Sophia Young** were both named All-Americans. In addition to earning Big 12 Coach of the Year honors, **Mulkey** received the New York Athletic Club's prestigious Winged Foot Award.

NCAA TOURNAMENT STAPLE

The Bears have made 20-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances and 22 overall. Those appearances have resulted in three national championships (2005, 2012, 2019), four Final Fours (2005, 2010, 2012, 2019), 10 Elite Eights and 16 Sweet Sixteens.

BIG 12 DYNASTY

- Baylor women's basketball has won a league-leading 24 Big 12 Conference titles -- 13 regular season and 11 tournament championships.
- Baylor has run the table in the conference four times (2012, 2013, 2018, 2019). It has only happened six times in Big 12 history (Oklahoma: 16-0 in 2006; Nebraska: 16-0 in 2010).
- Baylor has advanced to the Big 12 Championship game 15 times in program history.
- The Bears have won six of the last 11 Big 12 Championship titles, last besting No. 17/20 West Virginia, 76-50, in the 2021 final.
