Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T posted a dominating win over No. 7 Azusa Pacific at the Ferrell Center on Saturday.
- The Bears will hit the road to face Missouri State in Springfield on Saturday at 5 p.m.

Baseball

- Baseball posted a 2-2 week that included a trip to the College Baseball Series at Globe Life Field.
- The Bears fell 4-3 in a tight game vs. No. 8 Oregon State on Friday night, getting a two-run homer from Wesley Jordan and 5.1 innings from starter Ethan Calder.
- On Saturday, Baylor posted an 8-6 win over Ohio State, highlighted by homers from Jack Little and Hunter Simmons & a one-run start from Bryson Bales. In Sunday's clash with No. 24 Auburn, the Tigers jumped out to an early six-run lead and held off a late charge that featured an Enzo Apodaca blast in the eighth inning.
- BU's final non-conference week includes a Tuesday tilt with defending WAC Champ Tarleton State, and a 3-game set with LMU.

Equestrian

- No. 10 EQ posted an 11-9 win over No. 2 TCU on Saturday in Waco, its first win over the Frogs since 2022.
- Alexis Rutledge earned MOP for Horsemanship, her second straight MOP honor in the event.
- The Bears venture to Brookings, S.D., to face S. Dakota State and Minnesota-Crookston on Friday and Saturday.

Indoor Track & Field

- Baylor track had a strong showing at the Big 12 Indoor Championships in Lubbock over the weekend, with the women finishing third and the men ninth.
- Nathan Ezekiel shattered his own 400m school record and anchored a winning 4x400 relay.
- Qualifiers will advance to the NCAA Indoor Championships March 14-15 in Virginia Beach.

Softball

- Softball went 3-2 during the Baylor Invite in Waco over the weekend, splitting with Cal Baptist and North Texas and posting a win over Sam Houston.
- The Bears have hit .274 as a team through 20 games with eight homers - including four from preseason All-American Shaylon Govan - and 98 runs scored. BU has a 4.27 team ERA and have fielded at a .975 clip.

Women's Golf

- WG is in the midst of competing in one of the top tournaments of the year, the Darius Rucker Invite in Hilton Head, S.C. After one round on Monday, the Bears sit in 17th with a 20-over 304.
- Freshman Malena Castro led the Bears with a 3-over 74, while Bridget Boczar had a 5-over 76.

Women's Basketball

- In a Big 12 regular-season title clash on Sunday at The Foster, the red-hot Bears fell to No. 10 TCU in a defensive struggle 51-48, with the Frogs winning the league championship.
- It snapped a nine-game winning streak for the Bears that featured a 79-62 win at No. 14 Kansas State on Monday.
- The Bears have earned the No. 2 seed in the Big 12 Championships in Kansas City and advance to the quarterfinals on Friday at 5:30 p.m., and will face either Cincinnati, Arizona State or Iowa State.
- BU owns a No. 16 ranking in the NET and are in prime hosting discussion for the NCAA first and second rounds.

Men's Basketball

- Baylor MBB embarks on its final week of the regular season, starting on Tuesday with a road finale at TCU, with tip-off on ESPN+ at 7 p.m.
- The Bears posted a 71-61 win over Oklahoma State on Saturday at Foster Pavilion, getting a season-high 21 points from Jeremy Roach off the bench.
- Norchad Ormier totaled his 17th double-double of the year and passed Bill Russell for 13th in NCAA history in rebounds (1,618).
- Following the TCU matchup, BU will host No. 3 Houston in the regular-season finale on Saturday at 9 p.m.

Men's Golf

- MG completed round two at the Cabo Collegiate on Monday and sit in 13th place after an 11-over 295 through the first two days.
- The Bears have been led by freshman Vincent Stjernfeldt, who had four birdies in his last eight holes on Monday to shoot an even-par 71.

Men's Tennis

- No. 17 Baylor posted a doubleheader sweep on Saturday at the Hurd Tennis Center, dominating UTRGV 4-0 in the opener before coming back to post a 4-1 win over No. 16 Illinois in the nightcap.
- The Bears have won three straight and four of their last five, which also includes a win over No. 7 Duke in the ITA Indoor Championships.

Women's Tennis

- WT cruised to a weekend conference-opening sweep over Cincinnati and West Virginia and have won 11 of 12 matches to open the year.
- The Bears only have a 4-3 loss at No. 12 Texas as a blemish on the resume and sit at No. 14 in the latest ITA rankings.
- Na Dong and Zuzanna Kubacha lead the team with 12 singles wins each & the doubles pair of Cristina Tiglea and Luibov Kostenko are 7-0 on court 1 in the spring.
