Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T defeated No. 8 Iona on Saturday by 19.735 points.
- The Bears tied or had season-highs in Compulsory Toss, Open Pyramid, Salto Toss, Trio Tumbling and Quad Tumbling passes.
- Felecia Mulkey was honored for her 100th BU win, which was on 3/8 on the road against Missouri State.
- Baylor will host No. 10 Saint Leo this weekend with post-meet autographs.

Baseball

- Baseball opened the week with a 13-4 win over UT Arlington on Tuesday, using a six-run second inning to fuel the rout.
- The Bears ventures to face No. 12 Arizona in a three-game series starting on Friday.
- Baylor went 2-2 last week, with a midweek win over Texas State, a 19-3 run-rule win in San Marcos, before posting a win in the series finale vs. Kansas State, who won its first five conference games of the conference slate.

Equestrian

- The Bears are the No. 3 seed in the Big 12 Championship, taking place in Burleson at TCU's Bear Creek Farms from March 28-29
- Baylor will face No. 2 seed Oklahoma State starting at 10am on Friday

Track & Field

- Baylor Track & Field continued its outdoor season with the first home meet of the year, the Clyde Hart Classic on Saturday.
- BU earned 12 first-place finishes and set a new program record, from freshman thrower Igor Olaru.
- The Bears now venture to Baton Rouge, La., to participate in the Battle on the Bayou, on Friday and Saturday.

Softball

- Baylor fell in its midweek game on Tuesday vs. UT Arlington, 6-2.
- The Bears now host UCF, a team recently in the top-25 polls, starting on Friday at 6:30 p.m. at Gettnerman Stadium.
- Last weekend, the Bears went 1-2 at No. 13 Oklahoma State, which featured a 1-0 win on Friday night in Stillwater.

Women's Basketball

- No. 14/15 Baylor wrapped up its 2024-25 season with a 28-8 record and a second-place Big 12 finish, posting a 1-1 finish in the NCAA Tournament in Waco.
- The Bears snapped a 30-game winning streak for Grand Canyon on Friday afternoon in the first post-season game hosted at the Foster Pavilion.
- Baylor then faced No. 25/25 Ole Miss for a trip to the Sweet 16 on the line, falling 69-63.
- Darianna Littlepage-Buggs finished her season averaging a double-double with 13.8 points and 10.0 rebounds per game.

Men's Basketball

- MBB concluded its season with an 89-66 loss to Duke in the Round of 32 of the NCAA Tournament
- With its opening-round win over Mississippi State, the Bears joined Gonzaga and Houston as one of just three teams to win an NCAA Tournament game in each of the last six NCAA Tournaments
- Baylor won 20 games for the seventh-straight season and the 13th time in the last 14 years
- The Bears finished with a .747 free-throw percentage, it's best since the 2004-05 season

Men's Golf

- MGOLF coming off it's fourth-place finish at the Hackler in early march, Bu returns to the Lone Star State for the Maribor Collegiate in Dallas, beginning on Monday, March 31.

Women's Golf

- WGOLF wraps up play at the Spring Charles Schwab Women's Collegiate on Tuesday, it's first of two-straight tournaments in Texas.

Men's Tennis

- The No. 15 Bears went 1-1 last week to open conference play, sweeping No. 32 Arizona State, 4-0, before a 4-1 loss to No. 15 Arizona on Sunday. BU also posted a 7-0 win over UT Dallas on Sunday night.
- The Bears will travel to No. 50 Utah on Thursday and No. 57 BYU on Saturday.

Women's Tennis

- Baylor cruised to a pair of conference wins over the weekend on the road, posting a 4-1 win at Iowa State and a 4-2 win at No. 43 Kansas that saw the Bears rally after losing the doubles point.
- Baylor returns home for a pair this weekend, hosting Kansas State and No. 34 Oklahoma State at the Hurd Tennis Center.
