Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T posted a 277.45-249.94 win over No. 10 Saint Leo on Saturday night at the Ferrell Center, stretching its win streak to 46 meets.
- BU had a perfect 10 in both the compulsory toss and open pyramid, the first perfect scores in those categories of the year.
- The Bears will host No. 2 Oregon on Saturday in their regular-season finale at 5 p.m. on ESPN+. The NCATA National Championship is in Sioux Falls, S.D., on April 24.

Baseball

- Baseball went 3-1 during the week, which included a midweek beatdown of UT Arlington, before posting a series win at No. 12 Arizona over the weekend.
- Baylor posted an 8-5 win on Friday and a 6-3 win on Saturday, led by a dynamite bullpen performance in each game.
- It marked the first series win over a ranked foe since topping No. 23 Texas Tech in 2024 and its first road series win over a ranked opponent since topping No. 5 Tech in 2021 in Lubbock.
- The Bears own a No. 37 RPI entering the week, which features a midweek test against a stout Houston Christian (17-8) team, before welcoming Houston (15-12, 3-6) for a three-game set.

Equestrian

- No. 9 EQ suffered a narrow loss to No. 5 Oklahoma State in the first round of the 2025 Big 12 Championships in Fort Worth, 11-9.
- The NCEA bracket will be revealed on Tuesday in advance of the national championships in Ocala, Fla., on April 17-19.

Track & Field

- Baylor wrapped up its second outdoor match of the year with nine top-10 finishes in the Battle on the Bayou in Baton Rouge over the weekend.
- The Bears saw the first day of competition cut short due to weather but were highlighted by a strong 100m time from Michaela Francois, who has the ninth-fastest time in the NCAA this year.
- Two-sport athlete Mason Dossett had a sixth-place finish in the 110m hurdles and Kaylah Braxton posted a 10th-place finish in the 100m hurdles.
- The tradition-laden Florida Relays looms for the Bears, hosted by UF in Gainesville, Fla., on Friday and Saturday.

Softball

- The Bears had a strong weekend and went 2-2 during the week, posting a series win over UCF with wins on Friday and Saturday.
- BU suffered a midweek loss to UT Arlington on Tuesday, before bouncing back with a 1-0 win over the Knights on Friday and a 3-2 win on Saturday.
- Lillie Walker starred in the circle, throwing seven shutout innings on Friday night and then went a complete game on Saturday as well, allowing just two runs - one earned - in the win.

Men's Golf

- MG, coming off its best finish of the year at the Hackler, will compete in the Maridoe Collegiate, starting on Monday in Dallas.
- Zach Heffernan plays the No. 1 spot for the Bears, after posting a top-20 finish in the Hackler last time out.
- The event is 36 holes on Monday and concludes on Tuesday.

Women's Golf

- WG finished 15th at the Charles Schwab Women's Collegiate on Monday-Tuesday in Fort Worth.
- BU was led by Silje Ohma, who finished 23rd and Sera Hasegawa posted a 37th place finish.
- The Bears will next play in The Mo, in Bryan, starting on April 8.

Men's Tennis

- The No. 15 Bears swept its two-match swing through Utah, posting a 4-2 win over No. 50 Utah on Thursday, before a 4-2 win at No. 57 BYU on Saturday. Both wins were comebacks that saw the Bears rally after losing the doubles point.
- BU's win at BYU was exceptionally challenging because the Cougars only have four courts, which saw the two singles courts finished before the Bears could compete on courts 5 and 6, which saw Luc Koenig complete the win with a 6-3, 6-4 win on court 6.
- The Bears have a key matchup vs. No. 19 UCF in Orlando on Thursday, before hosting No. 26 Oklahoma State on Sunday.

Women's Tennis

- The No. 22 Bears went 1-1 over the week and sport a 7-3 record in conference play.
- Baylor posted a 4-0 win over Kansas State on Friday, before suffering a 4-0 loss to traditional powerhouse, No. 26 Oklahoma State on Sunday.
- A two-match road swing through Arizona awaits the Bears this week, featuring a pair of top-40 matchups vs. No. 38 Arizona on Friday and No. 35 Arizona State on Sunday.
