Acrobatics & Tumbling

- Broke the BU and NCATA record for attendance with 2351 against No. 2 Oregon.
- Earned its ninth win of the season against Oregon with a 287.795 283.305 decision.
- Earned a record-setting five perfect 10s against the Ducks in 5 Element Acro, 7 Element Acro, Inversion Pyramid, Synchronized Pyramid and Open Pyramid. It was the second time the Bears have earned perfect 10s across an event, the last time also being Pyramid against Oregon (3/12/2015).
- Awaits the seeding for the NCATA Championship, taking place 4/24-27 in Sioux Falls.

Baseball

- Went 2-2 on the week, including a walk-off win over HCU last Tuesday on Travis Sanders' solo home run.
- Logged a 1.25 team ERA this week, allowing just five earned runs (11 unearned).
- Reached 20 wins for the fastest time since 2019, starting this season 20-8 (Started 20-6 in 2019).
- Host Texas State this Tuesday before traveling to Texas Tech for a weekend series on the road.

Track & Field

- Competed in the Pepsi Florida Relays over the weekend in Gainesville, Fla., securing 14 top-10 finishes over the two-day event.
- Four events were won with the women's long jump, triple jump, pole vault and the women's 4x400 relay.
- Alexis Brown became the first Baylor woman to hit 7.0 meters with her 22-11.75 (2.8 m/s) mark in long jump. The graduate ranks sixth in collegiate history outdoors and is only the sixth collegian all-time to break seven meters in any wind.

Softball

- Swept Houston on the road this weekend for the Bears' first series sweep of the season.
- BU has now won five of their last six contests.
- Shaylon Govan led the way offensively with a .571 average, while Lillie Walker excelled in the circle picking up two-complete games and two wins.
- The Bears will face UTSA in a midweek game this week before hosting ACU for a three-game nonconference series this weekend.

Men's Golf

- MGOLF will tee it up for its final regularseason event beginning Saturday at the Aggie Invitational.
- The Bears will tee it up at the Big 12 Championship at Southern Hills in Tulsa, Okla., April 22-24.

Women's Golf

- WGOLF is playing its final Regular Season Event at the "Mo"Morial Invitational at Traditions Golf Club on Monday and Tuesday.
- The Bears will compete at the Big 12
 Championship at the Clubs at Houston Oaks in Hockley, Texas, Tuesday, April 15-17.

Men's Tennis

- Currently on a six match win streak after going 3-0 over the weekend at UCF and versus Oklahoma State and Prairie View A&M.
- The Bears swept in Orlando the No. 17 ranked UCF team 4-0 with a big ranked road win.
- On Sunday, BU took down OSU 4-1 and followed with a big victory over PVAMU 7-0.
- The Bears currently sit second in the Big 12 at 5-1. If they win against Texas Tech on Thursday, the final regular season match in Fort Worth against TCU will be played for a share of the Big 12 title
- Baylor will be honoring their seniors on Thursday night at 6 p.m. against Texas Tech.

Women's Tennis

- Had a 2-0 weekend in Arizona, defeating Arizona 4-0 in Tucson and Arizona State 4-3 in a thriller in Tempe.
- Freshmen Na Dong and Nanaka Sato extended their singles win streaks to 11 and 10 straight, respectively.
- One final regular season match is left at the Hurd Tennis Center on Saturday afternoon, as the Bears play host to No. 37 TCU at 2 p.m.
