Acrobatics & Tumbling

- A&T won its 10th-straight NCATA Championship on Saturday, the sixth time the final meet came against Oregon.
- Came away with a record nine NCATA Event Finals trophies.
- Emily Bott, Jordan Gruendler, Leavy McDonald and Payton Washington were named All-America, while Gruendler was also named All-Academic.
- Washington was named Athlete of the Year, Gruendler the Specialist and McDonald the Freshman.
- Mulkey was named NCATA Coach of the Year.
- Extended its win streak to 50 in a row after a perfect 12-0 season.

Baseball

- Went 2-2 last week with a midweek win over HCU and a victory in the series finale at No. 23 TCU.
- The win over the Horned Frogs marked BU's seventh ranked win under third-year head coach Mitch Thompson and third of 2025.
- The Bears are 19-2 this season when striking out nine or more batters, 18-3 when allowing two walks or fewer, and 16-4 when racking up double-digit hits as a team.
- Baylor has 11 games remaining on its 2025 regular-season schedule, beginning Tuesday, April 29 at Sam Houston before starting a sevengame homestand this weekend against Arizona State.
- BU is currently in 9th place in the Big 12 standings; the top 12 teams in the league will qualify for this year's Big 12 Championship tournament.

Track & Field

- T&F wrapped its second-to-last regular season meet in Orlando at the UCF Knights Invite with 15 top-10 finishes, 10 of those being in the topfive.
- The Bears took five event titles, all being running events in Alexis Brown (100m), Nathaniel Ezekiel (400m), Jasmine Gryne (400mH), Demario Prince (110mH) and Calisha Taylor (400m).
- Nathaniel Ezekiel ran the No. 2 time in the nation at 44.75, cracking inside Baylor's historic Quarter-Mile U top-10 outdoor program marks at tied for ninth. This is the fastest mark in the 400m posted by a Bear since Wil London in 2017.
- BU will wrap its regular season this weekend at the Alumni Muster in College Station from May

Softball

- Baylor went 3-1 last week picking up a midweek win over Texas State before taking the series against BYU 2-1 on the weekend.
- The Bears are now 25-24 on the season and 10-11 in conference play heading into the last series of the regular season.
- BU will face Iowa State for a three-game conference series this weekend in Ames, Iowa.
 From there, the Bears will head to Oklahoma City for the Big 12 Softball Championship.

Men's Golf

- MGOLF concluded its season with a tie for 14th at the Big 12 Championship at Southern Hills Country Club in Tulsa, Okla.
- MGOLF alum Johnny Keefer picked up a threeshot victory in the Korn Ferry Tour's Vertex Bank Championship. The win was Keefer's second as a professional and the first Korn Ferry Tour win by a Bear since Kyle Jones in June of 2020.

Women's Golf

- No. 7 Seed WGOLF will open play at the Norman Regional On Monday, May 5 at The OU Jimmie Austin Golf Club in Norman, Okla.
- BU enters looking for a top-5 finish to earn a school-record fifth-straight trip to the NCAA Championship.

Men's Tennis

- MT heard its name called for the 27th consecutive year to the NCAA Tournament, selected to compete in the College Station Regional.
- The Bears will face off against Nebraska in the first round at 10 am CT on Saturday, May 3.
- The second round of competition is slated for Sunday, May 4 at 2 pm CT.

Women's Tennis

- Baylor was selected as an at-large bid to the Austin Regional of the 2025 NCAA Tennis Championship, opening the tournament against Boise State on Friday morning at 10.
- The selection was the program's 26th all time and the 19th under head coach Joey Scrivano
- With a win on Friday, BU would advance to face the winner of Texas and Grand Canyon on Saturday at 4 p.m. All matches are slated for the Texas Tennis Center.
