Men's Basketball

- MBB split a pair of games last week, posting a 94-79 win at Oklahoma State on Tuesday in Stillwater, before falling vs. No. 25 Kansas in Lawrence on Friday night.
- The Bears now face a two-game homestand, hosting No. 12/12 Texas Tech on Tuesday night at 8 p.m., before hosting TCU on Saturday at Foster Pavilion.
- In the win at OSU, Tounde Yessoufou had 23 points to lead the Bears, with Michael Rataj adding 19 points and seven rebounds. Cameron Carr had 17 points on 12 shots in 27 minutes and Obi Agbim played 40 minutes and had 15 points and four assists. Isaac Williams IV chipped in 14 points in 27 minutes. The Bears shot 59.3% from the field, including a 22-of-30 stretch in the first half that featured 9-of-14 3-pointers made.
- Carr leads the team with 20.5 points and 5.1 rebounds per game. Yessoufou averages 18 points and six rebounds.

Men's Tennis

- No. 16 MT opened its 2026 season with a 3-1 mark last week that included a 5-2 loss at No. 8 San Diego, and a home tri-sweep over Lamar and Wisconsin.
- The Bears will host a doubleheader on Saturday, with Abilene Christian at 12:30 p.m. before a rivalry clash with SMU at 6 p.m. Baylor and SMU will meet for the second straight year as the to are co-hosts of the ITA Indoor National Championships, earning a bye to the final field of 16.
- Alexandru Chirita, Luc Koenig and Connor Van Schalkwyk each had three singles wins to lead the Bears on opening week.
- In the rankings, Devin Badenhorst (eight), Van Schalkwyk (17), Chirita (44), Drew Hedgecoe (95) and Zsombor Velcz (108) are all listed in singles.

Track & Field

- Baylor track & field opened its 2026 indoor season in Lubbock, Texas, at the Corky Classic over the weekend.
- Tiriah Kelley highlighted the event with a 22.56 time in the 200m, breaking the school record and posting the fastest time in the world on the year.
- Freshman Landon Freeman had a high jump total of over seven feet, the first 7-foot high jumper for BU since 2000.
- The Bears take on the Ted Nelson Invite on Friday and Saturday in College Station. The men's 4x400-meter relay for the meet has been renamed the Clyde Hart 4x400 in honor of legendary Baylor coach Clyde Hart, who passed in November.

Women's Basketball

- No. 14 WBB stretched its winning streak to six games with a 3-0 week that featured two road wins in Utah and a home win over Kansas.
- The Bears are now 17-3 and tied for first in the Big 12 with a 6-1 mark. Of their three losses on the year, those opponents are a combined 54-5. BU sports a NET ranking of No. 26.
- Baylor will return home for a two-game homestand at Foster Pavilion, hosting UCF at 7 p.m. on Wednesday, before welcoming Houston and new head coach Matthew Mitchell on Sunday at 2 p.m.
- Taliah Scott has averaged 20.5 points and 3.1 rebounds per game to lead the Bears, while Darianna Littlepage-Buggs sports 10.1 points and 10.7 rebounds per game. Bella Fontleroy averages 9.3 points and 5.5 rebounds per outing. Jana Van Gytenbeek owns a sparkling 129-55 assist-turnover ratio while leading the offense.

Women's Tennis

- No. 25 WT opened the season with a pair of wins in the Hawkins Indoor Tennis Center over the weekend, posting a 4-3 result over Illinois and a 6-1 win over Tulane on Sunday.
- The Bears claimed the doubles point with wins on court 1 and court 2 vs. Illinois, before singles wins on court 2, 3 and 5 to clinch the match with a 4-0 result. Illinois finished off the singles results with wins on the remaining three courts. BU cruised to a 6-1 win over Tulane on Sunday, claiming all but court 5.
- ITA Kickoff Weekend looms for the Bears in Austin, with Baylor set to face Cal on Saturday, and either Texas or Arizona on Sunday.
- Na Dong leads the Bears with a No. 40 singles ranking, one of three BU standouts ranked in the top 100.
