### STORYLINES

#### LEADING OFF

- Baylor Baseball returns home for a midweek matchup against Stephen F. Austin on Tuesday night before heading to another premier weekend tournament in the 2026 BRUCE BOLT College Classic in Houston on Feb. 27-March 1.
- BU is coming off an 0-3 weekend at the 2026 Round Rock Classic in which the Bears dropped a very tight 3-1 contest against No. 7 Oregon State, a one-run ballgame to Purdue, and took a 5-1 loss to No. 18 Southern Miss.
- Baylor's middle infield duo of redshirt junior shortstop Travis Sanders and sophomore second baseman Pearson Riebock were each named to the All-Tournament Team after a strong offensive and defensive weekend. The pair combined on four double plays while both racked up three hits each and scored a combined three runs.
- On Opening Day, redshirt senior 1B Tyce Armstrong became the second player in NCAA history to hit three grand slams in the same game, joining Louisville's Jim LaFountain who did so on March 24, 1976.
- BU returns 20 players from its 2025 roster, including three position player starters (Johnson, Sanders, Riebock), and welcomes 17 newcomers. Baylor has 19 underclassmen (Fr., R-Fr., So., R-So.) on its 2026 squad.
- 30 players on the 37-man roster are in their first or second years with the program.

#### TUESDAY NIGHT TUSSLE

- Baylor is 33-0 all-time against Stephen F. Austin, including a 3-0 mark against the Lumberjacks under fourth-year head coach Mitch Thompson.
- The Bears are off to a 1-0 start in midweek ballgames and against in-state foes so far this season.
- Last year, BU went 11-1 in midweek games and has now won 17 of its last 18 midweek matchups, dating back to March 26, 2024..
- Baylor is 28-11 in midweek games during the Thompson Era.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- Baylor is coming off an 0-3 weekend at the 2026 Round Rock Classic, where the Bears faced stiff competition including a pair of ranked opponents.
- BU was held in check by Oregon State's Preseason All-American ace pitcher Dax Whitney, who struck out 17 Bears in seven scoreless innings of work. Even still, the Bears tied the ballgame in the eighth before a two-run flared single gave the Beavers breathing room in the ninth inning.
- On Saturday, Baylor got out to a 5-0 lead against Purdue on the backs of Ethan Calder's stellar start, where he went five scoreless with five punchouts. However, the Boilermakers racked up 10 hits over the final four innings to come from behind and steal a 6-5 contest.
- In Sunday's tournament finale, BU couldn't take advantage of 12 free passes allowed by Southern Miss and left 13 men on base, despite efforts to work out of jams on the mound.
- Baylor's 4-0 start to its season was just the third 4-0 start since 2019 (2019, 2025, 2026).
- Since 2016, the Bears have won six of their last 11 Opening Weekend series.

#### BY THE NUMBERS

- Baylor has won the free pass battle (BB + HBP) 66 to 23 over its opponents through the first seven games of 2026.
- BU has committed just four errors defensively; it's .984 fielding percentage ranks third in the Big 12.
- The Bears have stolen 15 bases through seven games this year, their most at this point in a season since 2011 (18).

#### BIG INNINGS IN THE BEGINNING

- Of the 18 innings that Baylor has scored runs in, 9 have been crooked numbers (3+ runs).
- The Bears have scored in the first inning in four of their seven games so far (5 vs. NMSU, 3 vs. NMSU, 2 vs. TXST, 1 vs. Purdue).

**THE TYCE IS RIGHT**

- Redshirt senior 1B Tyce Armstrong became just the second player in NCAA history to hit three grand slams in the same game when he did so on Opening Day (Feb. 13) against New Mexico State.
- Armstrong tied the BU single-game program record with three home runs and his 12 RBIs topped Shea Langeliers' previous record of 11 (set on June 1, 2019, vs. Omaha).
- Armstrong and Louisville's Jim LaFountain are the only players in college baseball history to hit three grand slams in a single game. LaFountain did so on March 24, 1976, as part of a four-home run game that included two grand slams in the same inning.
- No player in Major League Baseball history has ever hit three grand slams in one game; in fact, only once has it ever happened where a team has hit three grand slams in one game -- the 2011 New York Yankees on August 25 against the Oakland Athletics.
- Armstrong's feat went viral on social media that night and he made an appearance on MLB Network's "Hot Stove" with Robert Flores and Harold Reynolds on the following Monday morning.
- Armstrong came to the plate with the bases loaded two more times against NMSU, delivering a sacrifice fly on Saturday and getting hit by a pitch on Sunday to add to his RBI total.
- Armstrong was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week, Perfect Game National Player of the Week, NCBWA Co-National Hitter of the Week and the 1B on Baseball America's National Team of the Week.

**PRESEASON PICKS**

- The Bears are led by Preseason All-Big 12 shortstop Travis Sanders, who hit .335 with eight home runs and 25 RBIs in 2025. Sanders was voted to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team by the league's head coaches as one of five infielders, regardless of position, but was also tabbed as the conference's top shortstop by three outlets: The Diamond Report, Just Baseball and Perfect Game.
- Additionally, sophomore infielder Pearson Riebock was picked to The Diamond Report's Preseason All-Big 12 Second Team and freshman outfielder Brady Janusek was tabbed to the same publication's Preseason All-Big 12 Freshman Team.
- Head coach Mitch Thompson was also projected as the Preseason Coach of the Year in the Big 12, per The Diamond Report.
- BU was predicted to finish 8th (The Diamond Report), 10th (D1Baseball) and 11th (Big 12 Coaches) in the conference in a trio of preseason polls.

**THE 2026 SLATE BY THE NUMBERS**

- Baylor will play a combined 22 games against 11 NCAA Tournament teams in 2026, including three conference champions from a year ago.
- 14 30-game winners headline the 2026 campaign, including six teams that won 40 or more games last season.
- 52% of this year's schedule features opponents that finished 2025 with a top-75 RPI.
- Six of Baylor's 2026 opponents were ranked in a preseason Top 25 poll: Oregon State, Southern Miss, Ole Miss, Texas, West Virginia and TCU.
- An additional six teams on the schedule also received votes in at least one poll: UTSA, Kansas State, Oklahoma State, Cincinnati, Arizona State and Texas Tech.
- Baylor's schedule is projected to be the 23rd-most difficult in the nation by College Splits, which ranks 10th in the Big 12.

**BREAKING DOWN THE BEARS**

- Baylor returns 20 players from its 2025 roster and welcomes 17 newcomers.
- The Bears have 19 players on the roster who will be playing their first or second season (including redshirt years) of college baseball.
- Additionally, 30 players on this year's team are in their first or second year with the program.
- By position, the Bears are carrying three catchers, six infielders, two first basemen, six outfielders, three two-way players, 13 right-handed pitchers and four left-handed pitchers.

**DAV DAY**

- Redshirt junior RHP Lucas Davenport was named Baylor's Opening Day starter and made his first-career start at the Division I level on Friday, Feb. 13, against New Mexico State.
- The native of Prosper, Texas, turned in a solid performance earning the win after 4.2 scoreless innings with six strikeouts. He walked three and allowed just two hits.
- In 2025, Davenport ate up innings as a bulk reliever and threw 42.1 frames across 16 relief appearances.
- He led BU with four wins as part of a 4-2 record with a 4.25 ERA out of the bullpen in 2025.
- Davenport struck out at least two batters in 12 of his 16 appearances.
- Before coming to Baylor, Davenport was the ace of the 2024 national title-winning Blinn College squad.
- He was named the NJCAA Tournament's Most Outstanding Pitcher after throwing a complete game against Northwest Florida State in the national championship game, tossing 135 pitches and striking out eight batters without allowing a walk.

**CALLING ON CALDER**

- One of the most experienced, reliable, and versatile arms on the Baylor pitching staff, senior LHP Ethan Calder is off to another great start for the Bears in 2026.
- He has thrown a team-leading 8.2 innings so far this year, has not allowed a run, and owns a 10:3 K:BB ratio.
- Calder began the 2025 season as BU's Friday night starter, but shifted to the Sunday role in late April.
- He started last season red-hot with wins in three of his first four starts, highlighted by one of the most dominant Opening Day performances in program history.
- Calder picked up Big 12 Co-Pitcher of the Week honors after his outstanding Opening Day start, in which he tossed five innings and allowed just one run on two hits and a walk, while striking out 13 against Youngstown State in 2025.
- His 13 strikeouts were the most by a Bear on Opening Day since at least 2003, and the most by a Bear in any start since Logan Verrett fanned 14 on March 11, 2011, in a complete game against Louisiana Tech.

## 2026 BAYLOR BASEBALL GAME NOTES

- Calder followed up his Opening Day brilliance with seven shutout innings against Gonzaga, tying a career-high.
- In 2025, Calder made all 15 starts for the Bears and struck out 64 while walking just 18 in a career-high 73 IP.
- Calder's 3.29 career strikeout-to-walk ratio entering the 2026 season is the sixth-best mark in Baylor history.
- He ranked 8th in the Big 12 with a 3.56 K:BB ratio last year and placed 4th in the league with 2.22 BB/9.

## MAKING THE JUMP

- Senior RHP Cade Hansen is making the jump to Division I from Division III Wisconsin-Whitewater, where he was the ace of the 2025 national championship-winning Warhawks squad.
- Hansen went 12-1 in 2025 with a 2.68 ERA.
- In 2025, he threw three complete games, including one shutout, and struck out 84 batters in 84 innings with just 13 walks.
- Hansen got the nod as Baylor's Sunday starter on Opening Weekend: 4.0 IP, 5 H, 3 ER, 0 BB 2 SO.

## EXPERIENCE AT THE PLATE

- Baylor boasts five hitters in its projected 2026 lineup that have hit over .300 in a full Division I season: Fifth-year senior OF Ty Johnson, redshirt senior 1B Tyce Armstrong, redshirt junior INF Travis Sanders, sophomore INF Cade Dodson and sophomore INF Pearson Riebock.
- Sanders hit .335 last year and leads all returning Bears, while Riebock follows closely at .306 from a year ago.
- Despite a .261 average in 2025, Johnson hit .313 for Baylor in 2024.
- Armstrong was an All-WAC Second Team performer at UT Arlington a year ago after hitting .319 with a career-high 12 HR.
- Dodson put up an outstanding freshman season for the Mavericks at a .324 clip with 69 total knocks.

## FOUNTAIN OF YOUTH

- Baylor has nine true freshmen on its 2026 roster and an additional four redshirt freshmen who sat the 2025 season to retain eligibility.
- Through the first two weeks, 15 Bears have made their Baylor debuts (8 hitters, 7 pitchers), including 8 true or redshirt freshmen who have gotten their first-career action.
- Among them, outfielder Brady Janusek has garnered preseason praise as D1Baseball's No. 53 Freshman to Watch.
- Janusek's first-career hit was a solo home run; he went 4-for-13 with a triple, a HR, and 3 RBIs in the first week.

## BEARS IN THE BIGS

- Four former Bears made appearances on MLB rosters in 2025 -- Cody Bradford (TEX), Shea Langeliers (ATH), Nick Loftin (KC) and Max Muncy (LAD), as part of the 48 former Bears all-time to play in the bigs.
- In 2025, Muncy became the first Bear in program history to win three World Series titles.

## SNED EFFECT

- Baylor introduced Sean Snedeker as the program's new pitching coach on June 12, 2024. The 32-year coaching veteran made an immediate impact and helped Baylor rank inside the top-30 nationally in four different categories in 2025: BB/9 (3.23, 7th), WHIP (1.33, 22nd), K:BB Ratio (2.57, 27th) and ERA (4.52, 29th).
- Prior to joining the Bears ahead of the 2025 season, "Sned" spent the previous seven seasons at Lamar. Before that, Snedeker made stops at Oral Roberts (2013-17) and Duke (2007-12) after a 13-year career in professional baseball. At each of those three previous stops, Snedeker led a pitching staff to a top-10 ERA ranking nationally, including Lamar in 2024 (3.74, 2nd) and 2023 (3.96, 6th), Oral Roberts in 2017 (3.06, 6th) and Duke in 2008 (3.71, 6th).
- During his time at the college level, Snedeker has produced 40 MLB draft picks, seven All-Americans, five conference pitchers of the year and 30 all-conference selections, most recently in 2025 with BU closer Gabe Craig.

## THE DREAM TEAM

- Head coach Mitch Thompson has assembled an all-star cast of assistant coaches and support staff members, bringing home former Baylor greats Zach Dillon and Jim Blair, as well as familiar faces in Darin Thomas and Brian Furlong.
- Dillon, a 2005 Baylor graduate, was hired as Thompson's hitting coach and recruiting coordinator. The starting catcher on the Bears' '05 College World Series team, Dillon later served as the volunteer assistant coach for BU in 2012. As a player, he was an integral part of three NCAA Tournament squads, two NCAA Super Regionals, and the CWS berth in 2005. He was a two-time All-Big 12 selection and was named the 2006 Big 12 Player of the Year, as well as a semifinalist for the Johnny Bench Award.
- Blair, a member of Thompson's first recruiting class at Baylor, is a 2000 Baylor graduate who owns the program's longest hitting streak, a 31-game stretch that lasted over parts of two seasons.
- Thomas, the director of baseball operations, served as the head coach at UT Arlington for the last 15 years before joining his longtime friend, Mitch Thompson, in Waco. He won over 400 games as the Mavericks' head man.
- Furlong, the director of player development, is a longtime friend of Zach Dillon's and teamed up with the Bears after four seasons as the pitching coach at Xavier.
