**Acrobatics & Tumbling**

- No. 1 A&T cruised to a win over No. 9 Duquesne on Senior Day at the Ferrell Center on Saturday.
- The Bears have now won 58 straight meets and will conclude the regular season at No. 2 Oregon on April 6.

**Baseball**

- Baseball went 4-0 over the week, including a sweep at Houston to improve to 5-4 in league play.
- The Bears host four straight at Magnolia Field at Baylor Ballpark this week, including a midweek test vs. a stout Tarleton State squad and three vs. BYU, who took a series from Oklahoma State last weekend.
- Tyce Armstrong reached double digits in homers over the weekend in Houston, and has 10 bombs and 35 RBI, hitting .294.

**Equestrian**

- No. 10 EQ wrapped up its 2025-26 season with a loss at No. 6 Oklahoma State, 11-9 in the first round of the Big 12 Championships in Stillwater.
- Baylor won the flat event vs. OSU, for its sixth straight win in flat.
- Lauren Reid was named Big 12 Flat Rider of the Year and earned all-league honors in fences and flat. Morgan McCarthy also earned all-flat honors and Lauren Jorgensen was named to the all-fences team.

**Softball**

- SB went 1-3 over the week, with a midweek win over UT Arlington, before falling in three games at No. 13 Arizona over the weekend.
- The Bears enter a home series with Houston owning a No. 27 RPI. BU faces UIW in midweek on Tuesday and the Coogs on Thursday-Friday-Saturday.
- Amber Toven leads the Bears with a .374 average with five homers and 29 RBI.

**Men's Basketball**

- MBB opens post-season play in The Crown in Las Vegas on Wednesday, facing Minnesota at 9:30 p.m. on FS1.
- The Bears are part of an eight-team field that includes Colorado, West Virginia, Creighton, Minnesota, Oklahoma, Rutgers and Stanford. The winner of BU-Minnesota will face the winner of Colorado and Oklahoma on Saturday.

**Men's Golf**

- MG faces a stiff field in the Maridoe Collegiate at the Maridoe Golf Club in Dallas on Monday-Tuesday.
- The Bears are one of 13 teams in the field, that includes four top-20 teams, including No. 7 Oklahoma State and No. 9 Arizona State.
- Last year, BU finished sixth in the Maridoe Collegiate, led by a top-20 finish from Jonas Appel.

**Men's Tennis**

- No. 8 MT went 3-0 over the week and stretched its win streak to four straight, with league wins over No. 39 Oklahoma State in Stillwater, and vs. No. 12 UCF, also besting Creighton on Sunday night.
- Devin Badenhorst leads the Bears with a No. 14 national ranking in singles.

**Track & Field**

- Baylor hosted the annual Clyde Hart Classic over the weekend in Waco.
- Baylor swept the 4x100 relays to highlight the meet.

**Women's Golf**

- WG wrapped up a stay at the PING ASU Invitational on Monday and Tuesday with a fourth-place finish in Tempe, Ariz.
- Baylor was led in the final round by a six-birdie effort from Silje Ohma, who was 5-under on the back 9 to finish in the top 15.

**Women's Tennis**

- The No. 37 Bears fell vs. No. 23 TCU in Fort Worth, 4-1 on Saturday.
- Zuzanna Kubacha won her singles match on court 2, 6-1, 6-0 for the lone point for the Bears.
- A non-conference test vs. No. 46 San Diego on Tuesday and a two match league test vs. BYU on Thursday and Utah on Saturday looms for the Bears.
