Acrobatics & Tumbling

- No. 1 A&T wrapped up the regular season with an efficient 286.810-277.680 win at No. 2 Oregon, sweeping the Ducks in the home-and-home series in 2026.
- It marked the 15th straight win over Oregon and the 59th straight win for the Bears.

Baseball

- Baseball won its second consecutive Big 12 Conference series, taking two of three from BYU during the week, also falling in a midweek test vs. Tarleton.
- The weekend wins improved the Bears to 7-5 in league play, sitting three games out of first place and in a three-way tie for fourth place. BU's RPI sits at 44 and will face a stiff test at No. 26 RPI Cincinnati this weekend, which follows a midweek game at UT Arlington.

Softball

- SB went 2-2 over the week that included a win over UIW on Tuesday, before falling in a series with Houston and suffering a Monday night loss at Lamar.
- Baylor played a marathon game on Thursday night vs. UH, highlighted by a complete-game 15-inning performance from Cambree Creager, who suffered the hard-luck loss after throwing 250 pitches, a new program record. It was the longest Big 12 regular-season contest in the conference's history.
- The Bears have four games remaining this week, traveling to UT Arlington on Wednesday and then Kansas for a three-game set in Lawrence.

Men's Basketball

- MBB went 1-1 in the Crown in Las Vegas last week, posting a win over Minnesota on Thursday, before suffering a loss to former league foe Oklahoma in the semifinals on Saturday.
- The Bears wrap up their season with a 17-17 record. Cameron Carr led the team with 18.9 points per game, adding 5.8 rebounds, while freshman Tounde Yessoufou averaged 17.8 points and 5.9 rebounds per game.

Men's Golf

- MG finished third in a 13-team field at the Maridoe Collegiate on Monday and Tuesday in Dallas, Texas.
- The Bears shot a 33-over 897, including an 11-over 299 on Tuesday to wrap up the event, tying No. 7 Oklahoma State for the low final round.

Men's Tennis

- No. 9 MT stretched its win streak to seven straight with a 4-0 week that included wins over No. 39 San Diego, Utah, Midwestern State and No. 67 BYU at the Hurd Tennis Center.
- Sitting a game shy of the top of the league standings, the Bears have a crucial week ahead, facing No. 4 TCU at home this weekend, which follows a match at No. 70 Texas Tech.
- Baylor trails Arizona by a game and sits in a tie with TCU for second place. UofA only has No. 15 UCF and Texas Tech remaining on the schedule, while TCU travels to Oklahoma State before facing BU.

Track & Field

- Track & Field wrapped up the historic Texas Relays in Austin over the weekend, highlighted by the 4x200m relay team setting a program record, the men's and women's 4x400 relays posting season highs and Molly Haywood remaining unbeaten in outdoor pole vault.
- The one-day Baylor Invite is set for April 10 at the Clyde Hart Track & Field Stadium.

Women's Golf

- No. 24 WG is in the midst of competing at The Mo' in Bryan, Texas this week, opening play on Monday.
- The Bears shot an 18-over 306 on the opening day to place sixth in the 16-team field, only five shots behind Tulsa.
- Malena Castro shot a 1-over 73 and is in a tie for fifth after Monday's first round.

Women's Tennis

- No. 34 Baylor went 1-1 over the week with a loss to No. 32 BYU but a 4-3 win over No. 30 Utah.
- The Bears used a doubles point and single points at No. 2, No. 4 and No. 5 to beat Utah on Senior Day.
- Baylor hits the road to conclude the regular season, venturing to Colorado and Texas Tech on Thursday and Saturday.
