**Acrobatics & Tumbling**

- No. 1 A&T won its 11th straight NCATA National Championship with an efficient showing in Azusa, Calif., sweeping through the field.
- Baylor won in the quarterfinals vs. No. 8 Duquesne, No. 4 Fairmont State and No. 3 Quinnipiac to clinch the title.
- BU also won seven event titles on Sunday and saw Payton Washington named Athlete of the Year for the second straight season, Leavy McDonald named Specialist of the Year and Mo Arthur named Freshman of the Year. Coach Fee Mulkey was named National Coach of the Year.

**Baseball**

- Baseball saw its losing streak stretch to six after an 0-4 week that included a sweep at No. 21 Arizona State over the weekend and a midweek loss at Sam Houston on Tuesday.
- The Bears return home for a four-game homestand, hosting UT Arlington on Tuesday and Texas Tech over the weekend. UTA owns a No. 143 RPI and Tech a No. 130 RPI, with the Raiders most recently swept at home vs. Oklahoma State.
- Baylor sports a No. 57 RPI and a 9-12 conference record, sitting in a three-way tie for ninth place in the league standings, with the top 12 teams advancing to the Big 12 Tournament.

**Softball**

- Softball fell in a three-game sweep at the hands of No. 14 Oklahoma State over the weekend but earned a key midweek win over No. 30 RPI ranked Texas State on Wednesday.
- The Bears own a No. 41 RPI entering the final week of the regular-season, which will feature a trip to face No. 5 Texas Tech on Thursday-Friday-Saturday in Lubbock.

**Men's Golf**

- MG ventures to Hutchinson, Kan., to take on the Big 12 Championships on Monday-Tuesday-Wednesday.
- The Bears are led by Jonas Appel's 72.59 stroke average. Appel has had 14 par-or-better rebounds in his 27 rounds in 2025-26.

**Men's Tennis**

- No. 11 MT learns of its postseason fate on Monday afternoon and is poised to host the first and second rounds of the NCAA Tournament at the Hurd Tennis Center on May 1-3.
- The Bears are projected to rank No. 10 and as one of four host sites in Texas, including TCU, Texas and Texas A&M. SMU, Tulsa and Texas A&M-Corpus Christi are projected to be in the Waco Regional.

**Track & Field**

- Track & Field hosted its final home meet of the 2026 spring season over the weekend, the annual Michael Johnson Invitational.
- The Bears swept the 4x400m relays on Saturday and finished with seven event titles in the two-day meet.

**Women's Golf**

- No. 26 WG finished seventh in the 14-team field at the 2026 Big 12 Championships in Dallas over the weekend. The Bears topped five ranked teams with its seventh-place finish.
- The Bears shot a 20-over 884 as a team.
- Bridget Boczar led three Bears with top-25 finishes, posting a 3-over for a 16th place showing. Yurang Li (24th) and Malena Castro (24th), also finished in the top 25.

**Women's Tennis**

- No. 37 Baylor learns of its postseason fate on Monday afternoon.
- The Bears are projected to be ranked No. 38 and be the second of the last four in the NCAA Tournament.
- Three host sites are potential landing sports for the Bears, including at Texas, Texas A&M and Oklahoma.
