Who Should Apply

For consideration, applicants must:

1. Currently be enrolled in a minimum of 12 semester hours
2. Completed a minimum of 36 hours at Baylor University
3. Have an overall GPA of 2.8
4. Be financial aid eligible for the academic year that the scholarship is awarded.
This is a need-based award. For funds to be distributed, you must have a 2025-2026 FAFSA on file.

How to Apply

The application and scholarship materials are due by January 6, 2025.

Requirements

In addition to submitting the scholarship application, receipt of the scholarship funds will be contingent upon the following requirements:

1. A typed essay of at least 300 words and no more than 500 words. The essay should be double-spaced and properly referenced with citations.

Essay Topic:

Who at Baylor has been a role model, support system, or partner in your academic or personal pursuits and how have they inspired you to give back to your community or culture?

2. A scanned unofficial copy of your transcript.
3. Participate in a 30-minute interview with the scholarship selection committee. Interviews will be conducted on campus in the spring semester.

Scholarship Details

The Dr. Vivienne Malone-Mayes Scholar must maintain at least a 2.8 grade point average, make satisfactory academic progress towards a degree, and continue to demonstrate commitment to leadership and service. Recipient must participate in the Achievement Awards hosted by the Baylor Black Alumni Alliance in the fall semester immediately following their selection as a Dr. Vivienne Malone-Mayes Scholar.
